Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – Lady Yotes struggled last weekend in Montana, dropping games at Montana Tech and Rocky Mountain...road remains tough for the squad, heading to Salt Lake City for games against Montana Western and NAIA Division I Westminster.

Concordia – The Cavaliers will play a pair of exhibition matches this week against NCAA DI foes in the University of Washington (Nov. 5) and the University of Portland (Nov. 11). Concordia officially opens its first season under new head coach Sean Kelly on Nov. 16 against New Hope Christian College.

Corban – None submitted

Evergreen – Under the direction of first-year head coach Jennifer Schooler, the Geoducks opened their season last Saturday with an 86-44 win over Walla Walla. Three players - Sadee Jones, Brittany Gray and LaNiecia Weatherspoon - recorded double-doubles in the victory.

Eastern Oregon – EOU defeated Walla Walla, 119-43, last Thursday night. EOU is currently ranked No. 25 in the NAIA Coaches' Top 25 Poll. EOU return to action on Sunday, Nov. 9 at 4:30 p.m. against Walla Walla University.

Northwest Christian – First-Year Head Coach Heath Alexander brings his squad onto the court for the first time this weekend in the Bill Holtz Warrior Classic in Rocklin, Calif. The Beacons play host William Jessup on Thursday and follow up with Pacific Union on Saturday. NCU is 11-6 all-time against WJU, but the Warriors have won three straight. The Beacons are also 2-0 all-time against Pacific Union.

Northwest – NU has a busy schedule this week as they play an exhibition with Seattle University on Wednesday night and then depart on Thursday for Southern California and two games with Hope International and Biola, both from the GSAC on Friday and Saturday.

Oregon Tech – The Oregon Tech women's basketball team moved to 3-0 with a pair of wins at the Southern Oregon University Classic in Ashland over New Hope (69-36) and UC-Merced (69-59). The Owls next travel to the William Jessup University Classic to take on Pacific Union College on Thursday and host WJU on Friday before opening up their home campaign on Tuesday, November 11th versus Simpson University.

Southern Oregon – Alexi Smith and Autumn Durand have been in double figures all three games for the Raiders, who are putting up 89 points per contest and shooting 52 percent. Smith is averaging 16, Durand 13.7 and Kristen Schoenherr 13.3. They'll play exhibition games this weekend at NCAA Division II foes Metro State (Colo.) and Regis (Colo.).
