Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – Coyotes extended their home win streak to 24 games with two double-digit victories over NU/ESC, extending their school-record best start to 13-1. Joey Nebeker had his third double-double of the season vs. ESC, with Josh Wilson pulling down a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Northwest, all 14 C of I players scored at least two points – the second time this season this has occurred.

Concordia – None submitted

Corban – None submitted

Evergreen – The Geoducks average a tick over 10 turnovers per game while their foes have averaged 18 per contest. That difference, 7.714 turnovers per game to be exact, ranks the Geoducks No. 1 in all of NAIA Division II basketball. Their 1.458 turnover-to-assist ratio ranks No. 7 in the country, and their 41 percent accuracy from three-point range puts them at No. 8 in NAIA Division II hoops.

Eastern Oregon – EOU hosts Multnomah on Saturday, Dec. 13 in a non-conference action. The Mountaineers defeated Evergreen, 90-84, and Northwest, 100-82, to open CCC action last week. EOU was led by CCC Red Lion Player of the Week Bryan McGriff, who averaged 29 points per game last week.

Northwest Christian – None submitted

Northwest – The NU men will play a non-league game with Quest University from B.C., this Saturday night at home and then travel to Seattle on Monday night for an exhibition game with NCAA Division I Seattle U. from the WAC. This year's game is being played in the Connolly Center on campus and not the Key Arena.

Oregon Tech – Lavar Moore is the second highest leading scorer in the Cascade Conference averaging just over 22 points per game.

Southern Oregon – The outcomes of SOU's first CCC road trip were nothing new; the Raiders have now won five of six at Concordia and lost six straight at Warner Pacific. The overtime win over the Cavaliers made the Raiders 3-1 this season against ranked opponents, with all four games being played away from home. Joel Spear's career night of 22 points on 4-for-4 outside shooting and seven assists spurred that win.

Warner Pacific – The Knights are winning with defense this season, holding opponents to a conference low 62.5 points per game and .381 shooting percentage.
