Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – C of I makes the tough trip to Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon, a year after sweeping the road swing for the first time since the 2002-03 season.

Concordia – Senior Tyler Velasquez tops the CCC in steals at 3.2 per game and is ranked No. 3 in assists at 5.5 assists per game. Velasquez has recorded at least five steals on five different occasions, including a season-best seven thefts against Lewis & Clark. He has handed out at least five assists in 8 of 12 contests this year.

Corban – Corban travels to play Evergreen on Friday and Northwest on Saturday in two key CCC matchups. The Warriors are most recently coming off of an 82-56 blowout win over CSU-Maritime on Sunday.

Evergreen – Junior Alix Hernandez, a 6-1 forward, has led the Geoducks in rebounding in each of the team's nine games this season. He averages a team-best 7.7 rebounds and is third in scoring with an average of 13.2 points per game.

Eastern Oregon – EOU defeated Multnomah, 101-83, last Saturday, De'Sean Mattox led the Mountaineers with 44 points in the victory. On Monday, Mattox was named CCC Red Lion Player of the Week.

Northwest Christian – None submitted

Northwest – Northwest U resumes conference play this weekend at home when they welcome Northwest Christian on Friday and Corban on Saturday at 7:30 p.m. NU is looking for their first CCC win after going 0-2 on their opening weekend of play.

Oregon Tech – Lavar Moore leads the Conference in scoring and is 5th in the Nation at just over 23 points per game. Friday night will be the 81st meeting between College of Idaho and Oregon Tech with the Yotes holding a 45-35 edge over the Hustlin' Owls.

Southern Oregon – In their nonleague win at U.C. Merced, the Raiders assisted 31 of their 34 baskets behind 6-foot-8 senior forward Tim Weber. Weber, who has already recorded the first two triple-doubles in Brian McDermott's 19 years as head coach, came up just short of a third with 11 points, 15 assists and nine rebounds. His 15 assists were the third-most in school history and the most by anyone since 1991.

Warner Pacific – After two non-conference wins last weekend, the Knights face a huge CCC test at Concordia on Friday. Doug Thomas registered his first double-double of the season versus Whitman with 20 points and 11 rebounds.
