Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – The Lady Yotes look to improve on their 1-1 league record with road games at OIT and Southern Oregon. C of I has won at least one game on the long trip every year since 2006, sweeping the trip during a four-year span from 2008-09 to 2011-12

Concordia – Lexi Campbell moved up to third in NAIA in free-throw shooting at 94.3 percent (33 of 35). Campbell has each hit at least one 3-pointer in all but one game this season and has not missed a free-throw since her first attempt against Western Oregon on Nov. 18, a streak of 28 consecutive makes.

Corban – Corban heads north to take on Evergreen on Friday and Northwest on Saturday in two pivotal CCC games. The Warriors split this last weekend in Walla Walla, defeating Whitman College 65-63 on Sunday.

Evergreen – Evergreen women's basketball student-athletes earning the CCC Red Lion Player of the Week award is getting to be a regular thing this season. Brittany Gray, named this week, joins teammates LaNecia Weatherspoon and Sadee Jones on the list. Never before - and this dates back to the 2002-03 campaign - has the Evergreen women's hoops program been represented on the player of the week list three times in a season. Former Geoduck standout Jennifer Solberg earned the award two times in the 2007-08 campaign and remains the only player in program history to do so.

Eastern Oregon – EOU went 2-0 last weekend in the LC State Classic. EOU defeated Simpson University, 90-74, on Saturday. The next day, EOU defeated NAIA Division I No. 13 Lewis-Clark State, 64-50. For their performance, EOU was named the CCC Adidas Team of the Week.

Northwest Christian – None submitted

Northwest – The Eagle women are 1-1 in conference play as they host Northwest Christian on Friday and Corban on Saturday in the NU Pavilion.

Oregon Tech – The Lady Owls lead the NAIA (Div. II) in scoring defense per game 44.00, Total rebound defense 31.00, and Field Goal Pct Defense .308.

Southern Oregon – The Raiders rediscovered their shooting touch in a pair of nonleague wins at Cal Maritime and Pacific Union last weekend, going 19-for-39 from 3-point range. Bree Park was 9-for-12 from outside, and Alexi Smith notched her fifth double-double of the season with 13 and 10 at PUC.

Warner Pacific – After two close losses to start conference play, the Knights will attempt to earn their first CCC win of the season at Concordia on Friday. Head coach Matt Gregg is closing in on 100 wins for his career. WP's win last weekend at Multnomah put the 7th year coach at 97 victories.
