Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – Lady Yotes open up league play Friday hosting Northwest and Evergreen...game vs. NU is the third-straight CCC game between the teams in Caldwell, as the Yotes and Eagles finished the 2013-14 regular-season in Idaho, then met in the CCC Championships quarterfinals – also in Idaho. C of I's preseason opponents are a combined 51-24 this season, one of only three CCC teams to schedule opponents with a combined winning record.

Concordia – None submitted

Corban – The Warriors travel to Eugene on Friday for their season-opening CCC game against Northwest Christian University. Tipoff is scheduled for 5:30 p.m.

Evergreen – With a 4-0 record and off to its best start since opening the 2008-09 season with five consecutive wins, Evergreen opens conference play with road games at defending champion Eastern Oregon on Friday and at College of Idaho on Saturday.

Eastern Oregon – EOU looks to rebound after suffering two straight losses in the Caldwell Best Western Inn and Suites Lady Yote Classic. EOU is currently 6-3 on the season. Kassy Larson leads the Mountaineers in scoring, as she averages 15.5 points per game.

Northwest Christian – The Beacons enter CCC action this weekend with a 4-3 record. NCU hosts Corban on Friday in the conference opener. The Warriors bring a 14-6 lead in the all-time series but the Beacons have won three of the last four games.

Northwest – NU opens Cascade Conference play this weekend traveling to Caldwell to play the College of Idaho on Friday and then head to La Grande to take on Eastern Oregon on Saturday night.

Oregon Tech – The No. 25 ranked Oregon Tech women's basketball team takes a 10-1 mark into Cascade Collegiate Conference when the Owls travel to Portland to take on Warner Pacific and Concordia this Friday and Saturday. Karly LeVeque and Tess Armstrong lead the offensive charge at 11.8 and 11.6 points per game with Megan Whetstone averaging 7.5 rebounds per contest.

Southern Oregon – SOU took its first loss of the season on Tuesday, an exhibition at Fresno State, but still go into CCC play with a 7-0 mark and a No. 13 ranking -- an eight-spot improvement over the preseason. Four Raiders are averaging in double figures, led by Alexi Smith (13.6) and Kristen Schoenherr (13.0), as the team averages 88 points.

Warner Pacific – Warner Pacific heads into the opening weekend of CCC play with a 5-5 record. Jordan Wilcox leads the Knights at 17.2 points per game and is #2 in the NAIA with 35 three pointers made.
