Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Yotes climbed to #6 in the latest NAIA Top-25 poll, their highest ranking since the 2005 season...C of I has won eight games in a row.

Concordia - Concordia played its first overtime game of the season on Tuesday, defeating Corban 77-73 on its home court. The Cavaliers lost their last five overtime games with their last win in extra sessions coming on Nov. 26, 2010 with an 84-81 win on the road against California Maritime.

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - EOU enters makes its final road trip of the regular season as the Mountaineers travel to Corban and Northwest Christian. Eastern Oregon currently holds the eighth spot in the CCC standings. The Mountaineers rank fifth in the nation in blocks per game (4.67).

Evergreen - The Geoducks return to Olympia for the final time this season, hosting Warner Pacific and Concordia this weekend. Evergreen then hits the road next weekend, traveling to College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon.

Northwest - The Eagle men hope to snap their 2-game losing streak last weekend when they host Concordia and Warner Pacific on Friday and Saturday in their final regular season home stand. Saturday night will be senior night for three graduating seniors: Ryan McIntosh, Brett Skogstad and Michael Greene. Greene surpassed the 1500 career points mark against SOU on Friday and now has 1,529 career points. The team had a memorable 18 hour bus trip to Ashland on Thursday and Friday through the snow in Portland and the Willamette Valley.

Northwest Christian - Spencer Coleman (18 ppg), Austin Kuemper (17.4 ppg), and Coleton Baker (16.8 ppg) are combining to average 52.2 points per game, which is the highest for any "big three" in the conference.

Oregon Tech - Saturday will be the 221st meeting between SOU and OIT, the series dates back to 1950. Oregon Tech leads the overall series 147-73. Danny Miles is 106-30 against his alma mater and 40-13 versus SOU Head Coach Brian McDermott.

Southern Oregon - After finishing up their home schedule at 12-2 with wins over Northwest and Evergreen, the Raiders will play their final three regular season games on the road. The trek starts Saturday in Klamath Falls, where they will try for their sixth straight win against Oregon Tech -- a streak they haven't accomplished in series history. Eric Thompson is the CCC Red Lion Player of the Week for the second time this season after averaging 26 points and 9 rebounds over the weekend and has now scored 25-plus on 10 occasions.
