College of Idaho - Lady Yotes dropped their season opener to Biola, 1-0, despite Nickayla Skinner's 35th career game with 9-or-more strikeouts...C of I will try to play this weekend at the Northwest Cup in Portland.

Concordia - For the sixth straight season, Concordia will host the Northwest Cup at Hood View Park in Clackamas, Ore. Including the Cavaliers, nine teams are set to play 21 games over a three-day span this weekend. The Northwest Cup will represent the season opener for the Cavs, who were forced to cancel six games at the Simpson Tournament last week.

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - EOU is under the direction of first year head coach Betsy Westermann. Softball opens up its season on Feb. 21 when they travel to Caldwell, Idaho to play in the College of Idaho Invite. EOU opens up against Northwest Nazarene.

Northwest - The Eagle softball team hopes to resume action after weather caused cancellation of their six games in the Simpson Tournament in Redding, Calif., over the weekend. NU made it as far as Salem on Friday after a more than 10 hour trip from Kirkland and made the decision to return home. NU travels to Portland this Saturday for a doubleheader with Lewis & Clark and then stops in Tacoma on the way back to play Puget Sound on Sunday.
