LA GRANDE, Ore. - Long bus rides and ice roads dominated last weekend in the Cascade Conference but with a full slate of CCC action this week, all 10 teams hope that Mother Nature cooperates.

Eastern Oregon and College of Idaho have already clinched a CCC tournament spot as they head west to Northwest Christian and Corban this weekend.

Evergreen will look to clinch a third-straight CCC tournament bid this weekend as they host Warner Pacific and Concordia, who will also visit Northwest while in Washington.

The final game pits Southern Oregon traveling to Oregon Tech in a battle for second place.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Chakala Carthen was named NAIA Player of the Week, the second C of I women's basketball player in program history to earn the honor (Alyson Pincock in 2001).

Concordia - With a 66-64 win against Corban on Tuesday, Concordia carries its longest winning streak of the season into a road match at Northwest on Friday. The Cavs opened its 2012-13 campaign with four straight wins.

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - EOU is one win away from having 20 plus wins in 10 of 14 years under the direction of Coach Weissenfluh. It would be the third straight year with 20 plus wins. Eastern Oregon is one of four teams who have clinched a spot in the 2014 Cascade Collegiate Conference Tournament. Brittney Newcomb leads the NAIA in free throw percentage as she is making 91.0 percent of her free throws.

Evergreen - The Geoducks are one win away from clinching their third straight trip to the CCC tournament. Evergreen is 7-2 on the road this year, with road games at College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon still remaining.

Northwest - The NU women will be playing their final regular season home games this weekend in the NU Pavilion when they host Concordia on Friday and Warner Pacific on Saturday. Friday night will be "Pink Out" Night as the team hopes to raise donations and build awareness of breast cancer. Saturday night, five Eagle seniors will be honored: Domi Mendezona, Sanda Milovic, Alyssa Dario, Alivia Johnson, and Ashley Coila.

Northwest Christian - With 4 games remaining in the regular season, NCU will make a final push to qualify for the post season. Currently NCU sits in ninth place, one win behind Concordia, who NCU defeated earlier this season and faces again next Tuesday.

Oregon Tech - Saturday is the 27th meeting since the return of women's hoops 11 years ago between OIT and SOU. The Owls lead the 26 game series over rival Southern Oregon University 14-12.

Southern Oregon - SOU clinched its fifth 20-win season in seven years over the weekend with convincing home wins against Northwest and Evergreen State. Carly Meister had 20 points and a career-high 16 rebounds Saturday, and in her last four games is 24-for-34 from the field. The Raiders have won five of six going into Saturday's pivotal rivalry game at Oregon Tech.
