## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - None Provided

**Concordia** - Caitlyn McCutcheon has grabbed at least 10 rebounds in five straight games. McCutcheon has the third-best 'double-double' total in the CCC with 11 instances this season.

**Corban** - None Provided

**Eastern Oregon** - For the tenth time in 14 years under Head Coach Anji Weissenfluh, the Mountaineers have won 20 plus games. Brittney Newcomb leads the NAIA in free throw percentage as she is shooting 91.0 percent from the free throw line this season. Newcomb also ranks fifth in the nation as she is averaging 23.1 points per game. EOU has been ranked in the Top 25 for the past eight weeks.

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks can finish anywhere from second to sixth place as they head to College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon this week. Evergreen is currently 7-2 in road games this weekend.

**Northwest** - None Provided

**Northwest Christian** - Tuesday's win over Concordia puts NCU in good position for the eighth and final playoff spot in the CCC tournament. The Beacons are currently tied in the win column with the Cavaliers and since they swept CU this season they own the tie-breaker if that is how they were to finish.

**Oregon Tech** - Kassi Conditt Ranks 4th in NAIA DII in Blocks per Game (3.286) and the team Ranks 4th in NAIA DII in Assist/Turnover Ratio (1.297).

**Southern Oregon** - The Raiders will finish the regular season by attempting sweeps at Warner Pacific and Concordia, and with two wins will clinch their first home playoff game in five seasons. Kristen Schoenherr's streak of consecutive games with 10-plus points was stopped at 24 in Saturday's 87-54 loss at Oregon Tech, but she still ranks fourth in the league in scoring (15.7), third in field-goal percentage (57.2) and 20th in rebounding (4.9).

**Warner Pacific** - The Knights were eliminated from playoff contention after a 71-58 loss to Corban on Tuesday. Kristen Swim has seen more court time for WPC, resulting in a season high 15 points last weekend at Northwest.
