British Columbia - UBC recorded 24 hits in Tuesday's 20-6 win at Redlands (Calif.), the third most in school history. Outfielder Sebastian Wong made his debut as a pitcher on Tuesday, throwing the final two innings. Will conclude California trip with games against Westmont (Wednesday and Thursday) and Menlo (Friday). Third baseman Kevin Biro is hitting .526 and leads the team with six RBI's in four games. Rookie Vinny Martin also has six RBI
