LA GRANDE, Ore. - It's playoff time in the Cascade Conference as the 2014 CCC Men's Basketball Championship presented by U.S. Bank begins tonight on campus sites.

Eighth-seed Eastern Oregon heads down I-84 to top-seed College of Idaho in the first game of the tournament. Seventh-seed Oregon Tech remains in Portland to take on second-seed Concordia in a rematch of last Friday night.

Sixth-seed Northwest Christian tries to make it three wins this season over third-seed Southern Oregon when the Raiders play host to the Beacons. The final game features Northwest traveling to PDX to take on Warner Pacific.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes to host Eastern Oregon in CCC quarterfinals, looking to end a nine-game postseason losing streak – dating back to 2005-06...C of I with their third longest win streak in program history (12 games)... behind the 13-game streak in 1982-83 and the 18-game streak in 1954-55...Josh Wilson recorded back-to-back double-digit assist games, the first time a C of I player had achieved the feat...the 67 first-half points by the Yotes Friday vs. ESC was their most since 71 vs. Patten in 1995-96.

Concordia - None Provided

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - None Provided

Evergreen - The Geoducks ended the 2013-14 season with a conference record of 3-15. The three wins matches the previous two seasons CCC win totals combined.

Northwest - None Provided

Northwest Christian - The Beacons have qualified for the CCC post-season for the first time since 2010. NCU is 1-3 in the post-season since joining the NAIA in 2007, their lone victory coming in the 2009 quarterfinals against Warner Pacific.

Oregon Tech - Oregon Tech, who is making 21-straight postseason appearances, takes a 16-14 overall mark to Concordia University in the quarterfinal round of CCC tournament play. Oregon Tech is the seventh-seed, while CU enters as the second-seed. The Owls handed the Cavaliers their first home loss of the season just last weekend by a 68-64 final.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders, who entered the final week of the regular season as the top shooting team in the CCC, had consecutive disastrous shooting nights against Warner Pacific (3-for-34 3pt) and Concordia (7-for-37 3pt) to lose back-to-back games for the first time this season. Now they face a must-win CCC quarterfinal game against Northwest Christian, which scored two comeback wins against them this season.

Warner Pacific - After a pair of home wins over SOU and OIT, the Knights secured home quarterfinal game and will host Northwest. Sean Gaines played his best game of the year versus the Owls hitting 10 of 11 shots on the way to 23 points.
