**Lewis-Clark State** - The No. 2 Warriors emerged from their series victory over Western Oregon with a record of 7-1, and will head to Oregon this weekend to compete at the Porter Park Classic, hosted by Concordia. At the tournament, the Warriors will face MSU-Billings, whom the Warriors swept in Lewiston on Feb. 15-16, British Columbia and the host Cavaliers. The Warriors were scheduled to face UBC and CU to open the season at the Guardian Tournament at Harris Field, but it was snowed out.

**Menlo** - Menlo senior right-hander Daniel Chavez has continued his dominant start to the season, earning a tough-luck no-decision for his seven innings of work over the weekend against UBC. Chavez is 3-1 on the season allowing just 18 hits while striking out 25 in 29 innings pitched. He's eighth in the country in wins (3) and 11th in innings pitched per game (7.125). Weather pending, Menlo will travel to Southern California this weekend for a four-game set with The Master's College.

**Oregon Tech** - Oregon Tech takes a 4-10 record to Salem where the Owls and Corban face off for a pair of non-conference doubleheaders this Friday and Saturday.
