Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes improved to 11-0 this season at home...C of I is off to their best start since starting 20-5 during the 2003-04 season, the last time they won the CCC title...Yotes tied a school record with 12 blocked shots vs. Concordia.

Concordia - Last week, the Cavaliers lost back-to-back games for just the second time this season. With 532 points this season and 2,054 for his career, senior Adam Herman became the first Concordia player to reach 2,000 career points. Herman has a 19.8 points per game average which ranks second all-time in CU's record books behind former Cavalier Shaun Hartley who averaged 21.6 points from 1988-90.

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - Tony Eackles Jr. gave EOU its first two game conference winning streak of the season last Saturday, when he hit his fall away jumper with 5.5 seconds left on the clock to beat Concordia. The two wins last weekend is the first time EOU has won two conference games in a row this season.

Evergreen - The Geoducks will look for their first season sweep on Friday night but it won't be easy as they head into a loud Danny Miles Court at Oregon Tech. Evergreen will then head to Southern Oregon on Saturday.

Northwest - The Eagles head south for one of their toughest road trips of the season to Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech. NU pulled out a double overtime victory over the Owls and a won close contest with the Raiders in Kirkland in January. Michael Greene is now just 9 points away from the 1500 point mark after his 24 point performance against Evergreen on Saturday. He is now No. 2 on the NU all-time scoring list behind former Eagle All-American Aaron Sawyer ('07, 2,074 pts.).

Northwest Christian - None Provided.

Oregon Tech - The Hustlin' Owls are ranked 1st in Division II in Total 3-Pt FG Made (259), 2nd in Division II in 3-Pt Fg Made per Game (10.360) and 2nd in Assist/Turnover Ratio (1.662)

Southern Oregon - Another weekend made for another tough loss for the 18th-ranked Raiders, who have lost three of their last six -- two in overtime and another at the buzzer -- after falling in OT Saturday at Northwest Christian. Eric Thompson moved into second on SOU's career scoring list with 14 points in Friday's win at Corban, then dropped 28 points and 10 rebounds Saturday at NCU. The Raiders host No. 19 Northwest Friday in the NAIA Game of the Week.

Warner Pacific - After winning 5 in a row, the WPC men have now lost three straight to fall to 6-6 in CCC play. Ryan Parks is leading the CCC in three pointers made (77), a number good for #7 in the NAIA.
