## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Lady Yotes set a school record with 18 made three-pointers vs. Warner Pacific, the second-highest total ever in CCC history...the 106 points was the third-highest scoring total in program history and most points scored since 1997.

**Concordia** - Junior center Caitlin McCutcheon was named the NAIA DII National Player of the Week on Tuesday, becoming the first CCC player to earn the award in at least six years...The Cavs posted a road sweep College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon for the first time since Dec. 30-31, 2010 when CU defeated the Mountaineers in La Grande, Ore., 93-90 and turned around to defeat the Coyotes 69-66 in Caldwell, Idaho.

**Corban** - None Provided

**Eastern Oregon** - EOU had its 33 game home court winning streak snapped last Saturday, when Concordia defeated EOU at Quinn Coliseum. Brittney Newcomb and Maloree Moss lead the NAIA in Free throw percentage and Assist to Turnover ratio. Newcomb is hitting 91.5 percent of her free throws, while Moss holds an assist to turnover ratio of 2.9. EOU is one win away from having 20 plus wins in 10 of 14 years under the direction of Coach Weissenfluh. It would be the third straight year with 20 plus wins.

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks have won four of their last five games and look to continue the strong play this weekend as they travel to Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon.

**Northwest** - The Eagles' five game winning streak will be challenged this weekend when they head south to take on Southern Oregon and OIT. NU upset the then No. 19 Owls in overtime in Kirkland and lost 101-94 to the Raiders at home in January. Senior point guard Domi Mendezona surpassed the 1,000 career point mark on Saturday at Evergreen and has 1,022 points in her 4 years at NU so far this season.

**Northwest Christian** - None Provided.

**Oregon Tech** - Two road wins in Cascade Conference play over the weekend, and a 21-4 overall mark, didn't seem to help the Lady Owls, as Oregon Tech fell one spot to the No. 21 position in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. The Owls will host two of the hottest teams in the CCC this weekend at Danny Miles Court with Evergreen State on Friday night. The Geoducks have won 4 of the 5. Saturday night Northwest comes to town for the 5th annual "Pink Out" game. The Eagles have won 6 of 7 including an 87-78 overtime win over the Lady Owls on January 10th.

**Southern Oregon** - The Raiders were hardly tested in road wins at Corban and Northwest Christian and have now won four conference road games for the first time in five years. Allison Gida averaged 17.5 points and seven rebounds, leading SOU in scoring for the fourth and fifth times in seven games. The Raiders, in fourth place, are 1/2 game behind Northwest and one game behind Oregon Tech with games against both coming up in the next two weekends.

**Warner Pacific** - WP dropped to 2-10 in CCC play after a pair of losses at EOU and C of I last weekend. The Knights gave up more than 100 points for the first time in 10 years in the loss at College of Idaho.
