## Around The NAIA West

**British Columbia** - UBC head coach Terry McKaig enters his 17th season at UBC (15 as an NAIA program). UBC returns four All-NAIA West team members from last year: Bryan Pawlina, who was also the NAIA West Pitcher of the Year, shortstop Tyson Popoff, also a Gold Glove winner, outfielder Jerod Bartnik and starting pitcher Sean Callegari.

**College of Idaho** - Yotes opened the season with a perfect 4-0 trip to California, including a Monday doubleheader sweep of GSAC power, Biola...transfers Chase Miller and Mitch Skaggs each had seven RBI on the weekend, while C of I pitchers had a combined 2.25 ERA.

**Concordia** - Concordia starters turned in a pair of quality starts on Monday in the team's season opener at Pacific Lutheran. Jason Snodgrass struck out five while allowing just four hits in six innings of work in the opener while Harrison McGhee matched Snodgrass with six frames of action in the nightcap where McGhee notched seven strikeouts in a one-hit performance against the Lutes.

They hit the road for the first time this weekend as they travel to Hayward, Calif. to take on NCAA Div. II CSU East Bay for a three-game non-conference set.
