## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - None Provided

**Concordia** - Concordia boasts 10 different players that have hit at least one home run this spring. The freshman duo of Taylor Bussey and Meghan Luebbert lead the team with Bussey belting six roundtrippers to Luebbert's five.

**Corban** - None Provided

**Eastern Oregon** - None Provided

**Northwest** - None Provided

**Northwest Christian** - NCU is averaging over 4.5 runs per game, well ahead of the 2.8 runs per game they scored in 2013. The Beacons are just 15 runs away from eclipsing their total from last year.

**Oregon Tech** - Lady Owls moved up to No. 17 in the Latest NAIA Top 25 coaches poll making the biggest move up from No. 22. The Owls will head to Portland, Ore. and Kirkland, Wash. for games with Concordia and Northwest this weekend.

**Southern Oregon** - Sweeps of Eastern Oregon and College of Idaho last week had the Raiders off to their best start in Cascade Conference play (7-1) in five years before they ended a 12-game homestand with two losses to Oregon Tech. Now they'll head north for their first CCC road trip at Northwest and Concordia. In her last four appearances Sydney White has allowed three earned runs in 22 innings with 25 strikeouts, and Ashley Lowe is 13-for-27 in her last eight games.
