Around The NAIA West

British Columbia - The Thunderbirds are coming off a four-game sweep of Oregon Tech in Vancouver. The two teams had to play a tripleheader of seven-inning games on Sunday because rain cancelled the second game on Saturday. There's a chance of more rain this weekend in Vancouver, when UBC hosts Menlo in a four-game series at Thunderbird Park. Pitcher Conor Lillis-White had a complete game, seven-inning one hitter against Oregon Tech. He lowered his earned run average to 0.59 in 30.2 innings of work.

College of Idaho - None Provided

Concordia - Since making his debut on March 7 after missing the first 13 games of the season, outfielder Cole Pittman has posted CU's top batting average at .346. Pittman has recorded at least one hit in 11 of the 14 games in which he has appeared. Seven of the lefthanders' 18 hits have gone for extra bases for a team-leading .615 slugging percentage.
