## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - C of I won the season series with Northwest Nazarene for the 11th-straight year, sweeping all three games...Nickayla Skinner broke the school record for doubles in a game with three, while Katie Rowe went 6-for-9 with five runs scored in the three games. Skinner added two wins in the circle, going 2-0 with a 0.70 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

**Concordia** - Four Concordia starters are hitting over .300 so far this year with freshman infielder Taylor Bussey leading the way with a .385 clip. With eight hits in 19 at bats, Bussey's average jumps to .421 with runners on base.

**Corban** - None Provided

**Eastern Oregon** - EOU returns to action this week as they scrimmage Clackamas Community College. EOU returns to action on March 14 when they open up CCC action at Northwest.

**Northwest** - The NU softball team hopes to return to the field after numerous rainouts and cancellations this season. Last weekend's doubleheader with Walla Walla was canceled making it the 11th and 12th games not played so far this season. The Eagles travel to northern California next week and will play doubleheaders on March 10 and 11 at Simpson during NU's spring break.

**Northwest Christian** - None Provided

**Oregon Tech** - Weather has forced the Owls to miss 11 games so far this season. Tech (4-4) will once again look for four games in the Bay Area when they travel to Atherton to take on Menlo College and Antelope Valley University this Friday and Saturday. Tori Weatherford is pacing the Owls with a .423 batting average, including a team-high 14 rbi and 11 hits. Cassidy Olson has two of the Owls' four wins in the circle, as the senior has tossed 30.2 innings with 15 strikeouts.

**Southern Oregon** - After a 31-day layoff, the Raiders were shut out twice Tuesday at Simpson and fell to 1-5. In all of their losses, they've been blanked or scored one run. SOU opens at home Saturday with another doubleheader against Simpson.
