## Around The NAIA West

**British Columbia** - None Provided

**College of Idaho** - Yotes split series with Antelope Valley and head into NAIA West opener with OIT with a 9-7 record. C of I pitchers allowed just 9 runs in the UAV series.

**Concordia** - Six of CU's 10 pitchers that have made an appearance this season have more strikeouts than innings logged. The sophomore duo of Harrison McGhee and Austin Hadley lead the way with McGhee tallying 28 strikeouts in 26 innings and Hadley 26 K's in only 16.1 innings.

**Lewis-Clark State** - With the forecast calling for rain and lots of it in Vancouver, B.C, the series between Lewis-Clark State and British Columbia will be held at Harris Field this weekend. This is the third time this season that the Warriors and Thunderbirds have had a meeting altered. The two teams were supposed to play in the Guardian Tournament in early February but it was snowed out. And last Sunday, rain cancelled their meeting in the title game of the Porter Park Classic in Portland, Ore. In the only meeting between the two teams this year, a cold and rainy contest in Portland, British Columbia topped the Warriors 2-0. With league play about to commence, the No. 2 Warriors (9-2) and Thunderbirds (7-3) hold the two best overall records in the nine-team NAIA West division.

**Menlo** - Menlo baseball returns home for the first time since February 1 as they open up NAIA West play on Friday against Concordia. Since beginning the season 7-0, Menlo has face a gauntlet of challenging Southern California opponents and looks to get back to their winning ways in conference this weekend.

**Oregon Tech** - With a doubleheader cancelled Wednesday versus Montana State-Billings, Oregon Tech will take a 5-13 mark into NAIA West action this Saturday and Sunday at College of Idaho. Ethan Schlecht leads the Owls in hits with 20 and a .317 batting average. Pitcher Austen Taylor has had some great outings and sits at 2-2 with a 2.87 era, including 22 strikeouts in 31.1 innings.
