Eastern Oregon - EOU won its least two games by a combined score of 28-2 as they swept Walla Walla University in a doubleheader Tuesday night. Brittnee Carman-Rice is currently on a seven game hitting streak, which is the longest for the Mountaineers this season. EOU softball is currently setting with a 17-17 record. The Mountaineers haven't finished a season with a record of .500 or better since 2005

Northwest Christian - Junior Randi Kostner continues to lead the Beacon offense, batting .333. She leads the team with 28 hits, 17 runs, 8 stolen bases, and 5 doubles.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - The Raiders ended their eight-game road swing over the past eight days with a 4-4 record -- sweeping at Corban and Eastern Oregon, and getting swept at the hands of College of Idaho and Northwest Christian. Senior catcher Julia Willison hit three home runs with 13 RBI over that stretch to earn player-of-the-week honors and currently leads the CCC in batting average (.413) and on-base percentage (.558).
