Corban - Corban finished with 97 steals (in 107 attempts), breaking the school record of 95 bases stolen by the 2010 team. The Warriors finished the season with 49 home runs, led by Courtney Castronovo with 10. A total of 11 different players hit homers for the Warriors in 2014.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons broke a 14-year old school record this weekend, finishing the season with 63 stolen bases. The record of 60 had remained since 2000.
