In the first round, College of Idaho and Menlo race off in the first round, with the winner advancing to play top-seed UBC in the final game of the day. Also meeting on the first day will be Concordia and Corban. The winner of the tournament earns an automatic berth to the NAIA Opening Round.

Also in action will be No. 2 and NAIA World Series host Lewis-Clark State. The Warriors head to Oregon for non-conference action against Western Oregon and Linfield.
