Eastern Oregon - Eastern Oregon went 3-1 this past weekend in CCC action. EOU swept Northwest on Sunday and defeated Concordia Monday morning in a makeup game from Saturday. The only loss for EOU was on Saturday when Concordia beat EOU. Mariebeth Watanabe leads EOU in hitting as she is hitting .398 on the season, which is fifth best in the CCC.

Oregon Tech - Lady Owls have won 13 of 14 games and are in the middle of a scheduled 16 game road trip that will end this weekend at College of Idaho as the No. 24 Yotes host the No. 16 Owls on Saturday April, 12 in Caldwell.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders ended a season-long home run drought by busting out for five in a sweep at Corban. Julia Willison hit two of them -- a three-run shot and a grand slam -- and in conference play has a .464 batting average and a .628 on-base percentage. SOU, which had gone without a homer in 36 of 37 games dating back to last year, is 9-3 in the CCC for the first time since 2009.
