Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - None Provided

Concordia - With a 3-1 win over Cal State San Marcos last Saturday, Concordia won its season opener for the fifth straight season. Making their third start appearance at the Biola University Summer Slam, the Cavaliers will play four matches on the road this week. Concordia went 2-2 last season at the Biola Tournament after a 0-4 stretch in the 2011 edition.

Corban - The Corban volleyball team enjoys road trips to California, Washington, and southern Oregon before playing in its first contest at the friendly confines of the C.E. Jeffers Sports Center. In addition to 10 freshman joining the Warriors this year, senior Karisa Legg rejoins the team as a player after serving as an assistant coach for the squad in 2013.

Eastern Oregon - EOU volleyball opened up the season ranked No. 23 in the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches Preseason Top 25 Poll. EOU travels to Spokane, Wash. to take part in the Sport Travel Northwest Invitational this weekend.

Evergreen - The Geoducks, picked sixth in the CCC preseason poll, open up the 2014 season this weekend in Spokane as part of the Sport Travel Northwest Invitational at The HUB Sports Center.

Northwest - The NU Eagles open their season this week in Spokane at the Sports Travel Invitational. Their first 12 matches of the year will be on the road as they then travel across the country to Daytona Beach, Fla., for the Embry Riddle Labor Day Tournament and continue on the road when they open CCC play at Concordia and Warner Pac on 9/5 and 9/6.

Northwest Christian - Interim Head Coach Kelly Rosin picked up her first victory with the Beacons this week with a sweep of New Hope. In that match the Beacons collected 17 service aces, including a record-tying 10 from sophomore Cassidy Winters. Winters had 9 aces in her entire freshman season.

Oregon Tech - Oregon Tech is on the brink of opening up the 2014 fall sports campaign when the Owls volleyball team opens play on Wednesday, August 20th in Angwin, Calif. in a pair of matches versus Pacific Union College. The Owls meet West Coast Baptist at a neutral site before a pair of matches at UC-Merced on Saturday, August 23rd, close out the five-match road trip.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders open their season Thursday and Friday at the scene of their rough start last year, the Biola/Red Lion-Anaheim Summer Slam, where they dropped four straight matches against nationally-ranked teams. A year older now, they feature last year's Northwest Region Freshman of the Year in Lauren McGowne, versatile all-conference outside hitter Paulla Pinheiro, and the two middles who topped the CCC in hitting average during CCC play, Nikki Keller and Emma Gasman.
