Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes travel to Nampa on Friday for their Canyon County rivalry match at Northwest Nazarene after going 1-3 at the Biola Summer Slam, with their lone win coming against No. 7 ranked Midland.

Concordia - Concordia went 1-3 last week at the Biola University Summer Slam. The Cavaliers joined No. 7-ranked Midland University (Neb.) as the only teams to take a set against the No. 8-ranked host team from Biola. This week, the Cavs will play three straight teams from the NCAA DII Great Northwest Athletic Conference before opening the CCC season on Sept. 5 against Northwest University.
