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Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes play a pair of home games this week, meeting rival Northwest Nazarene and facing Rocky Mountain.

Concordia - With 20 straight wins, Concordia has a chance to tie its school record for consecutive wins. Tied for the third longest streak in NAIA history, the Cavaliers won 22 straight contests in 2002 and again in 2008. The current streak is tied for the fifth longest in NAIA history. Mobile (Ala.) holds the national record with 46 straight wins (1997-98) while Azusa Pacific's 23-game winning streak from 1998 is the second longest in NAIA history.

Evergreen - Already 1-0 on the young season, the Geoducks hit the road this weekend, traveling to Montana to take on Carroll on Sunday and Great Falls on Monday.

Northwest - None Provided

Northwest Christian - When the Beacons take to the pitch for the first time, they will be fueled by nine returning players and eight newcomers. With the addition of three players from Solano Community College, NCU now has five Falcon alumni on the roster.

Oregon Tech - The Oregon Tech women's soccer program split a pair of games in Lancaster, Calif. to open the 2014 campaign and take a 1-1 record into their first home game of the season with Trinity Lutheran College. The Owls fell to University of Antelope Valley by a 3-0 score and went on to defeat Arizona Christian College 2-1 behind a two goal effort from sophomore forward Tarryn Miyamura (Mililani, Hawaii). The Owls will also play William Jessup University on Labor Day in Redding, Calif.
