Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes open the 2014 season on Friday afternoon, hosting nationally ranked Rocky Mountain.

Concordia - Concordia will open its season with three straight matches against ranked opponents. The Cavaliers open the year at home against No. 6-ranked Hastings College (Neb.) and will then host No. 23-ranked Rocky Mountain College (Mont.). The Cavaliers continue on to host No. 10-ranked Concordia University (Calif.) before facing the defending CCC champions of Corban University in Salem.

Corban - None Provided.

Evergreen - The Geoducks open up the 2014 schedule on Thursday evening when they host Johnson & Wales (Colo.). The August 28th start date is the latest first match for the Geoducks since 2009, when they hosted British Columbia to open the season, also on the Aug. 28.

Northwest - None Provided.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons posted a perfect shutout of Multnomah last week, holding the Lions without a single shot attempt. The 6 goals scored by NCU were a school record, as were the three assists posted by CCC Defensive Player of the Week Aaron Chesnut.

Oregon Tech - The Oregon Tech men's soccer team opened up the 2014 season with a decisive 5-1 road victory over Simpson University. It would be the first road win for the Owls in three years. Menlo, however, put a frown on the Owls' faces two days later, taking out Tech 6-0. Oregon Tech next travels to Pacific University on Thursday, September 4th and Linfield College on Friday, September 5th before hosting Northwest University in Cascade Conference action in mid-September.

Warner Pacific - Under the direction of 26th year head coach Bernie Fagan, the Knight men make their season debut this weekend versus Johnson & Wales.
