Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes split four matches in Montana at the Big Sky Challenge before opening CCC play on Tuesday at home against EOU. This week, the Yotes travel for road matches at NW and ESC

Concordia - The Cavaliers started CCC play with a pair of wins on the opening weekend end for the fourth straight season. Last season, Concordia started league play with seven straight wins.

Corban - Corban Volleyball plays in its first home match of the 2014 campaign on Friday when it hosts Warner Pacific College at 7 p.m. The Warriors then host Concordia University the following day at 5 p.m.

Eastern Oregon - The Mountaineers went 10-1 in non conference play. Finished up non conference play with a sweep against Walla Walla U last Wednesday.

Evergreen - The Geoducks host a trio of ranked opponents this week as No. 11 Pacific Lutheran (DIII) visits Evergreen on Wednesday night. No. 23 Eastern Oregon and No. 18 College of Idaho come to Olympia this weekend for Cascade Conference play.

Northwest - The Eagle volleyball team hopes to rebound from two opening CCC conference losses when they host two tough CCC opponents in the College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon on Friday and Saturday. The youthful Eagles only have two seniors on the squad this season.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons head into the weekend still looking for their first-ever win against Concordia (RV). The Cavs are 16-0 over the last eight seasons. NCU is 9-9 against Warner Pacific and will look to take the series lead for the first time. Northwest Christian has won 7 of 8 since 2010.

Oregon Tech - Oregon Tech hosts a round-robin tournament with Simpson and New Hope Christian University on Saturday, September 13th before traveling to Simpson for a non-conference match on Sunday. The Owls resume CCC action the following weekend in Portland.

Southern Oregon - SOU jumped back into the NAIA Top 25 for the first time since 2011 at No. 16 on Tuesday. They began their Cascade Conference slate with home sweeps of Corban and Northwest Christian, as Motade Atanda totaled 30 kills on 50 swings and 25 digs to earn Red Lion Offensive Player of the Week recognition. They'll attempt to extend their win streak today against a hot Oregon Tech squad, which they've defeated on 22 straight occasions.

Warner Pacific - Warner Pacific rebounded from a tough loss at home to Evergreen by defeating Northwest in four sets. The result broke a 15 match losing streak in CCC contests.
