Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes recorded back to back three-set sweeps on their road swing through Washington, including a record-setting 25-4 set win at Northwest (fewest points ever allowed in a rally scoring (25-or-30) set).

Concordia - Stretching back to last season, Concordia has won seven straight regular season CCC matches. Concordia has four players inside the CCC's top 15 block artists. Ranked No. 2 in the CCC, freshman Nicole Barth leads the way at 1.47 blocks per set and is followed by Brianna Hogan (4th, 1.21 bps), Jenessa Taylor (11th, 0.78) and Brenna Huwe (14th, 0.75).

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - Casey Loper earned her third Player of the Week of the Week for the third time this season. EOU went 3-0 last week with victories over College of Idaho, Evergreen and Northwest. It was their first victory at College of Idaho since 1996.

Evergreen - After sweeping past DIII no. 11 Pacific Lutheran last Wednesday, the Geoducks struggled against powers Eastern Oregon and College of Idaho but Evergreen will look to rebound this Friday as they travel up to Kirkland to take on Northwest in their only match of the week.

Northwest - The Eagles are still looking for their first CCC win as they play host to Evergreen in Kirkland on Friday at 7 p.m.

Northwest Christian - NCU sophomore Cassidy Winters continues to be ranked among the top servers in the country. Averaging 0.8 aces per set, she leads the CCC and is fourth in the nation.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - The Raiders moved up one spot to No. 15 in the NAIA rankings this week after their 23rd straight win over Oregon Tech, though the Owls did take them to five sets for the first time since 2008. This week they'll travel to Warner Pacific and Concordia, and the latter beat them twice last year.
