Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - None Provided

Concordia - In 14 contests, Concordia has played in just two five-set matches so far this season with the Cavs going 0-2 in those matches. The Cavs fell in five to then No. 19-ranked The Master's College and at home against NCAA DII Seattle Pacific University.

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - The Mountaineers held steady in the third edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. EOU is currently on a nine match winning streak. Eastern Oregon recorded a season high 14 blocks against Corban University on Friday, Sept. 19th. Eastern Oregon ranks eighth in the nation in assists per game (12.76) and kills per game (13.83). Casey Loper leads the Mountaineers and ranks seventh in the NAIA in kills with 243.

Evergreen - Riding a three-match losing streak, the Geoducks will look to get back on track this weekend when they travel to Saint Martin's on Wednesday night before heading down to Northwest Christian and Corban for CCC play.

Northwest - None Provided

Northwest Christian - NCU will look to bounce back from a two-loss weekend as they return home to face Evergreen on Friday and Northwest on Saturday. The Beacons are 11-4 all-time against the Geoducks and have won five of the last six meetings. NU holds a 9-6 lead in the all-time series, but the Beacons have defeated the Eagles three straight times.

Oregon Tech - Oregon Tech, which tied last year's win total with a split in Portland last week, will take a 15-4 overall record and 3-2 mark into matches with College of Idaho, who is currently receiving votes in the NAIA national poll, and No. 11 rated Eastern Oregon this Friday at 7 p.m. and Saturday at 5 p.m. at Danny Miles Court.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders wore their first conference loss Saturday at Concordia, but still managed to move up a spot to No. 14 when the NAIA Top 25 was released Tuesday. Paulla Pinheiro had a big road trip with 31 kills and 17 digs for the Raiders, who come home this weekend to face No. 11 Eastern Oregon and College of Idaho.

Warner Pacific - After winning two matches in a row, the Knights have hit a rough patch with three straight losses. Janessa White is #4 in the CCC in kills per set (3.47).
