Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – The Lady Yotes will play five of their final seven games of the season on the road, including the next three. Elisha Hensey has 197 career assists, nearing C of I's top-ten record book in that category.

Concordia – With 10 wins already this season under first-year coach Sean Kelly, Concordia is closing in on matching its highest win total over the last three seasons as the 2012-13 club finished the year at 11-17. With a 10-9 overall record, the Cavs are on pace to record just its fourth winning season since 1993-94, the year the CCC became an official NAIA conference.

Corban – The Warriors are still in contention for first place in the CCC following a weekend sweep of Northwest and Evergreen. Corban travels to play Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech this weekend in two must-win games for the Warriors.

Evergreen – Senior post Sadee Jones leads the Cascade Collegiate Conference and ranks fourth nationally with 11 double-doubles (all points-rebounds) this season. She has double-doubles in five consecutive games and in seven of the last eight.

Eastern Oregon – The EOU women's basketball team returned to the Coaches' Top 25 this week as they are ranked No. 25 in the nation. The Mountaineers hit the road this weekend as they travel to Portland, Ore. to face Warner Pacific and Concordia.

Northwest Christian – Junior Sami Pitts hit a school-record tying 6 three-pointers on Saturday night in NCU's victory over Northwest. She has hit 34 treys this season and she now ranks fifth in NCU history with 66 career three-pointers.

Northwest – The Eagles continue to suffer setbacks to their roster as they lost their third starter of the season last week when junior Charity Degman was lost for the year with a knee injury prior to leaving on their road trip. NU hosts New Hope Christian on Friday in a non-league game and then welcome Evergreen to the NU Pavilion for their only CCC game of the week.

Oregon Tech – The Lady Owls host Northwest Christian University on Friday in the 6th Annual "Pink Out" event at Danny Miles Court. Oregon Tech holds a 13-3 record in the all-time series and a five-game win streak over the Beacons. Tech will take on Corban University on Saturday where the Owls hold a six-game win streak over the Warriors. Tech enters the week with a 17-6 overall mark and sits in fourth place in the Cascade Conference standings at 6-5. Karly LeVeque leads the Owls at 11.7 points with Tess Armstrong adding 10.1 points per contest. Megan Whetstone is grabbing a team-high 6.9 rebounds to go with 8.8 points per game.

Southern Oregon – Junior point guard Ashley Claussen is averaging 19.2 points and 7.2 assists in SOU's last four games, making four 3-pointers in each of them. Prior to this stretch she was averaging 8.3 points and 4.6 assists.

Warner Pacific – None submitted.
