Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – The Lady Yotes won their third-straight home game and extended a surge with their fourth overall win in five games after a 1-9 start to the season; Haylee Burnham earned CCC Player of the Week honors after averaging 22 points per game in wins over Warner Pacific and Concordia; C of I's weekend opponents each hoisted a CCC game-high 41 three-point attempts against the Yotes zone defense, converting just 28-percent of the shots.

Concordia – In 13 games this season, five different players have led the team in scoring in 2014-15. Sierra Dean and Lexi Campbell lead the team with four game-high point totals with Dean scoring a season-best 24 points against Southern Oregon on Dec. 5.

Corban – Corban travels north on Friday and Saturday for games against Warner Pacific and Concordia. The Warriors look to bounce back after a couple of tough losses this past weekend.

Evergreen – Sadee Jones, a 5-6 senior post, has recorded a total of six double-doubles this season, including two straight and three of the last four games (she missed making it four-for-four by one rebound). She averages 14.5 points and 9.5 rebounds for the Geoducks.

Eastern Oregon – For the first time since the Coaches' Preseason Top 25 Poll, the Eastern Oregon University Mountaineers find themselves ranked No. 24. EOU ranks second in the NAIA in scoring margin (23.8), and assists per game (19.5)

Northwest Christian – Six different players are averaging at least eight points per game for the Beacons in 2014-2015. Chandler Gabrio and Melyssa Weber currently lead the team, averaging 9.1 points per game.

Northwest – The NU women travel to take on two tough opponents this weekend in Oregon Tech (RV) and No. 16 ranked Southern Oregon on their home courts. The young Eagles are starting just one senior in their line-up and freshman, Hannah Carlson, is their third leading scorer with a 10.1 ppg average.

Oregon Tech – The Oregon Tech Lady Owls evened their Cascade Conference mark to 3-3 with a pair of road wins last week. The Owls play their next three games at home, including both Northwest and Evergreen this Friday and Saturday with a showdown versus rival Southern Oregon set for January 17 at Danny Miles Court. Karly LeVeque leads Tech in scoring at 11.4 ppg with Megan Whestone grabbing a team-high 7.3 rebounds per contest.

Southern Oregon – Sophomore wing Autumn Durand is coming off a big weekend in which she averaged 13.5 points and nine rebounds. Alexi Smith scored a career-high 26 points on Friday at NCU, and Saturday's game at Corban was the first time all season that one of SOU's three post players didn't score in double figures.

Warner Pacific – Jordan Wilcox is #1 in the CCC and #3 nationally in three pointers made (56).
