Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – Lady Yotes look to end four-game losing streak with match-up at nationally-ranked EOU. C of I is 5-1 this season when opponents fail to score 59 points in a game.

Concordia – The CCC's top assister at 5.8 per game, Janae Klarich moved up to No. 2 in the NAIA DII in overall assist/turnover ratio. The senior has given out 94 assists this season while committing just 20 turnovers for a 4.6 a/t ratio.

Corban – The Warriors host Concordia and Warner Pacific this weekend. Corban will look to solidify its spot in the CCC standings with a pair of wins. Tipoff is set for 5:30pm both nights.

Evergreen – Evergreen, currently occupying fourth place in the CCC standings, plays four of its final six conference games at home. Current CCC statistics show senior post Sadee Jones ranked first in rebounding and second in scoring.

Eastern Oregon – Eastern Oregon looks to improve on the longest winning streak in women's hoops on Friday when they host College of Idaho at 5:30 p.m. PT. Fans coming to Quinn, wear white and help EOU whiteout Quinn. Senior, Kassy Larson ranks tenth in the NAIA in field goal percentage, as she is shooting 55 percent from the field.

Northwest Christian – A big weekend is ahead for NCU, hosting Warner Pacific and Concordia. Sitting in a tie for seventh, the Beacons are just 1 ½ games out of fourth place with their eye on hosting a CCC playoff game for the first time in school history.

Northwest – The Eagle women earned a split in their games last weekend with a win over New Hope Christian and a loss to Evergreen at home. NU is still adjusting to the loss of three starters and younger players are stepping in and filling in the spots.

Oregon Tech – The Oregon Tech Lady Owls (17-8, 6-7 CCC) travel to Washington for games at Evergreen State on Friday and Northwest Saturday. The Owls and the Geoducks are currently tied in the win column and for the fourth and final home playoff spot in CCC postseason play. Karly LeVeque leads the team in scoring at 11.7 ppg with Megan Whetstone grabbing a team-best 6.8 rebounds.

Southern Oregon – SOU remained undefeated at home last week and Lynn Kennedy earned wins Nos. 199 and 200 as a Raider in wins over Corban and Northwest Christian. Ashley Claussen has scored in double figures six straight games, making 22 3-pointers during that stretch.

Warner Pacific – The Knights won their first home CCC contest of the year, defeating College of Idaho inside C.C. Perry Gym last Saturday. At 3-9 in the league standings, WP is still two games out of a playoff spot with six to play.
