PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Offensive Player of the Week - Maverick McIvor, WKU

McIvor led the WKU (1-0, 1-0 CUSA) offense in the 41-24 season-opening win over Sam Houston on Saturday. The quarterback accounted for four touchdowns in his Hilltopper debut. He threw for 401 yards and three touchdowns on 33-51 passing and added a 4-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter to help close out the Week Zero win. McIvor's touchdown passes were 26 yards to Matthew Henry, 9 yards to K.D. Hutchinson and 22 yards to Marvis Parrish. McIvor completed eight passes of 15+ yards and had six completions of 20+ yards in the win. He was also named the East-West Shrine Bowl Monday Morning Quarterback.

Defensive Player of the Week – Jaylen Lewis, WKU

Lewis helped lead a solid defensive effort in WKU's season-opening 41-24 victory over Sam Houston on Saturday. The transfer safety posted four tackles in the game, including two solo stops. He also recorded an interception in the fourth quarter that helped the Hilltoppers close out the Week Zero conference win.

Special Teams Player of the Week - Cole Maynard, WKU

Maynard made a statement with a booming 71-yard punt in WKU's season-opening 41-24 win over Sam Houston on Saturday. The 71-yard boot was the first 70-plus yarder a Hilltopper punter has recorded since the 2012 season, and the kick was downed at the Sam Houston four-yard line. Maynard, who was included on the Ray Guy Award Preseason Watch List prior to the season opener, finished the night with five punts totaling 250 yards – an average of 50 yards per punt – with two traveling 50-plus yards.

Freshman of the Week - Marvis Parrish, WKU

Parrish had a strong showing in his college debut. The true freshman running back accounted for 110 all-purpose yards, finishing second on the team. After earning the start in his first game, Parrish led the team in rushing with 52 yards on 12 attempts and caught six passes for 58 yards and one touchdown. His touchdown was a 22-yard reception on a pass from Maverick McIvor that put the Hilltoppers ahead 34-24 with 4:47 to play in the third quarter.

Offensive Lineman of the Week – Laurence Seymore, WKU

Seymore helped the Hilltopper offense rack up 506 yards of offense in the 41-24 victory over Sam Houston on Saturday. The starting left guard helped the Hilltoppers to 401 yards through the air with his 88.7 pass blocking grade, the third-highest of any guard in Week Zero. He was the highest graded Hilltopper offensive lineman over his 87 snaps in the win, according to PFF.

QUICK HITTERS

CUSA ADDS NEW MEMBERS

Conference USA enters 2025 with a 12-team composition, having welcomed Delaware and Missouri State to the fold on July 1, 2025. Each team enjoyed success in quality FCS leagues in 2024 as the Blue Hens went 9-2 in the CAA, while the Bears went 8-4 in a loaded Missouri Valley - which produced FCS National Champion North Dakota State.

NEW FACES

The league features six new coaches in 2025. Firstyear members Delaware (**Ryan Carty**) and Missouri State (**Ryan Beard**) are fresh on the scene, while FIU's **Willie Simmons**, Jax State's **Charles Kelly**, Kennesaw State's **Jerry Mack** and Sam Houston's **Phil Longo** enter year one at returning members. Only LA Tech's **Sonny Cumbie** and WKU's **Tyson Helton** have held their post longer than three seasons.

WEEKDAY CUSA

The 2025 season marks the return of Weekday CUSA after two successful seasons of the mid-week scheduling model as part of Conference USA's new television deal with partners CBS Sports Network and ESPN. Eight of last season's weekday games were decided by single digits and seven games saw more than 60 total points scored, setting the stage for plenty of excitement in this year's 18-game schedule.

GUESS WHO'S BACK, BACK AGAIN

CUSA led all G5 conferences in average returning production (54%) in this year's returning production report from ESPN's **Bill Connelly**. The league featured five teams that are set to return the most talent among FBS in Kennesaw State (5th, 73%), Liberty (15th, 66%), Missouri State (17th, 66%), Delaware (20th, 65%) and New Mexico State (21st, 65%).

PERFECTLY BALANCED, AS ALL THINGS SHOULD BE

In 2024, Conference USA was the only FBS conference in which each member won at least two conference games, underscoring the league's balance and competitiveness from top to bottom. Every matchup carried postseason implications and showcased the league's depth. As the 2025 season kicks off, that parity sets the stage for another unpredictable and wide-open title race across CUSA.

BRINGING THE HENERGY

Delaware feels well-positioned for its move to the FBS, leaning on experienced administration and a culture built on doing things the right way and prioritizing the student-athlete experience. On the gridiron, the Blue Hens won more than 70 percent of their games (26-11) in the previous three seasons before making the jump. Delaware features a deep, veteran defense and a couple core pieces on offense in QB **Zach Marker** and RB **Jo Silver**.

LYGHTZ OUT LEADERSHIP

FIU quarterback **Keyone Jenkins**, nicknamed "Lyghtz Out," enters his third season poised for a breakout. The CUSA Preseason Offensive Player of the Year is becoming a vocal leader that first-year head coach Willie Simmons needs to lead the offense. At the CUSA Football Kickoff, Simmons was quoted as saying "I think my biggest recruiting win in all my years was being able to keep Keyone."

GROUND-POUND GAMECOCKS

Jacksonville State has rushed for multiple touch-downs in 11 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the FBS. The longest such streak in Conference USA history is a 14-game run by TCU spanning 2003 and 2004. Last season, both Liberty and Jacksonville State had a game with at least 400 rushing yards against an FBS team. Only six other FBS schools had such a game in 2024 with CUSA joining the AAC as the only conferences with multiple teams (Army & South Florida).

MACK'S MAKEOVER

Kennesaw State is set to undergo a full reset under head coach Jerry Mack, who brings a tempo offense to replace the Owls' familiar ground-and-pound approach. Despite a litany of newcomers, a big-bodied wide receiver in Christian Moss (6'3") is excited for the opportunity to shine in a higher-powered offense.

EARN EVERYTHING

Liberty head coach **Jamey Chadwell** is stressing an "Earn Everything" mentality to the Flames after they stumbled a year after earning a Fiesta Bowl appearance in 2023. His staff has adoped an underdog mentality after they became the hunted last season. The approach, which even included making them work out of the visitors locker room, resulted in better camarederie coming out of spring ball.

BOOST TO THE BULLDOGS

LA Tech's offense is sure to get a boost with the return of **Tony Franklin** as offensive coordinator after he served in the same role from 2010-12. In Franklin's last season as OC, the Bulldogs led FBS in scoring (51.5), total offense (577.92) and first downs (31.5) per game. Also set to see a jump in production is quarterback **Evan Bullock**, who threw for 2,104 yards and 14 touchdowns in his freshman season.

GOING FOR THE TRIFECTA

MTSU quarterback **Nicholas Vattiato** has a chance to become the first CUSA quarterback to rack up more than 3,000 passing yards in three-straight seasons since North Texas' **Mason Fine** (2017-19). Vattiato has thrown for 3,092 yards in each of the last two seasons while completing passes at a 65.6 percent clip. He currently ranks 11th on the league's career completion percentage leaderboard (65.9). Vattiato is one of the five active FBS quarterbacks with at least 7500 passing yards in the FBS. Vattiato is the only one of those five to have all those yards come with his current school.

MO STATE MOMENTUM

Missouri State's continuity under head coach Ryan Beard has the Bears eyeing another big step after the team rattled off an eight-game win streak and lit up scoreboards in 2024. Offensive coordinator **Nick Petrino's** unit racked up 306.2 yards per game through the air (5th nationally), 424.8 total yards per game (17th) and 34.8 points per outing (13th). Mo State returns seven starters on offense, including quarterback **Jacob Clark**, who ranked fourth nationally in passing (300.3) and 11th in passing touchdowns (26) in 2024.

DESERT AIR RAID

First-year NM State offensive coordinator **David Yost** brings a pass-happy offense to the NM State, led by incoming signal-caller **Logan Fife** and sophomore wide receiver **TJ Pride**. Yost owns more than 35 years of collegiate coaching experience and has a history of mentoring quarterbacks including Justin Herbert, Jordan Love, Blaine Gabbert and Chase Daniel.

SAM HOUSTON AIR-KATS

Under first-year head coach Phil Longo, expect the Bearkats to air it out as he's made himself known for having a very vertical offense. In his first stint at Sam Houston as an offensive coordinator, he was named the national Coordinator of the Year in 2016 when he directed Jeremiah Briscoe to the first of consecutive Walter Payton Awards in 2016.

SET THE FOUNDATION

While year one under head coach Scotty Walden didn't go as planned, UTEP still found some momentum with a pair of shootout wins over the final three weeks of the season. With five returning starters on each side of the ball, the program feels a better sense of continuity and chemistry going into year two.

HIGH-FLYING HILLTOPPERS

Since the beginning of the 2021 season, WKU has thrown for 18,960 yards, more than 2000 more than any other FBS team in that time (Ohio State – 16536). The Hilltoppers' 337.4 passing yards per game over that span also lead the FBS (USC – 315.4).

BLADES' BLOODLINE

FIU defensive back **Brian Blades II** is carving out his own path in the FIU secondary while upholding a star-studded family legacy. His father Brian was a Pro Bowl wideout with the Seahawks, while uncles Bennie and Al were standout defensive backs at the University of Miami. Bennie was a unanimous All-American for the Hurricanes and is a member of the College Football Hall of Fame.

ALL-AMERICAN ANCHOR

Liberty offensive lineman Aaron Fenimore, a Freshman All-America selection in 2024, led the Flames in offensive snaps (825) and ranked second among CUSA centers in offensive grade (73.7). A member of the CUSA Preseason Watch List and Outland Trophy Watch List, he is poised to lead Liberty in the trenches and establish himself as one of the top centers in the nation.

NEXT LEVEL TOPS

WKU is the only non-power conference program and one of just 19 schools overall to have a player drafted in the first three rounds in each of the last four NFL Drafts. The Hilltoppers have had five players drafted in the last four drafts, most recently Upton Stout going 100th overall to the 49ers in 2025.

BACK FOR THE BLUE

In year two under head coach and defensive playcaller Derek Mason, the Blue Raiders are poised to improve on that side of the ball with four of the top six tacklers back from 2024. The leading returning tackler - linebacker Parker Hughes - racked up 69 tackles in just nine games last season. Some other familiar stoppers include defensive end Anthony Bynum (60), safety John Howse IV (51) and defensive tackle Shakai Woods (42).

SAME SCRIPT, NEW CHAPTER

With the arrival of quarterback Maverick McIvor and offensive coordinator Rick Bowie from Abilene Christian, WKU is hoping to replicate a record-setting 2021 campaign, the last time they brought in a quarterback/offensive coordinator duo from the FCS ranks in Zach Kittley and Bailey Zappe. That year, Zappe set FBS single-season records in yards (5,987) and touchdowns (62).

CUSA place four student-athletes on The Athletic's annual "Freaks List," which highlights some of the most physically gifted college football players.

Julian Gray, R-Sr., RB, Liberty - The 5-11, 205-pound gadget player has a vertical of 42.6 inches and was clocked at 22.26 mph. He's also squatted 575 pounds, bench pressed 335 and power cleaned 320.

Zeiqui Lawton, R-Sr., DL, Sam Houston - The 6-1, 265-pound clocked a 4.70 40, vertical jumped 32.5 inches and clocked 21 mph. He benched pressed 425, squatted 535 and did a sumo deadlift of 585.

K.D. Hutchinson, Jr., WR, WKU - The 5-6, 180-pounder did 20 reps on the bench press at 225 pounds and squatted 450. He vertical jumped 41 inches and hit 22.5 mph on the GPS.

Omiri Wiggins, Jr., RB, LA Tech - Wiggins had 527 yards and four touchdowns in his debut season. The 5-10, 206-pound Wiggins squatted 585 pounds, vertical jumped 40 inches and hit over 22 mph.

BOWL SYNOPSIS

CUSA BOWL OVERVIEW

Conference USA is in the final year of the league's six-year cycle of the bowl lineup, concluding with the 2025 season. The conference is guaranteed seven bowl appearances in each year of the cycle and will have associations with up to 16 different bowls.

As part of the new bowl cycle, CUSA will annually send teams to the Bahamas Bowl against a Mid-American Conference opponent, and to the R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl, against a Sun Belt Conference school. The league has participated in all 10 Bahamas Bowls and has placed a team in the New Orleans Bowl 20 times in its first 24 years.

The league continues its relationship with the Radiance Technologies Independence Bowl. CUSA is guaranteed to send a team to the Shreveport, Louisiana-based bowl in 2025, while holding a secondary agreement with the bowl in the other years of the cycle.

The conference's remaining guaranteed selections in the cycle (either four or five per season) will include the 68 Ventures Bowl (Mobile, Alabama) or from among 11 games which are owned and operated by ESPN Events. A backup opportunity also exists for the Quick Lane Bowl after ESPN and/or Independence Bowl slots have been filled.

THE PLAYOFF

The CFP will once again utilize a 12-team format for the 2025 season. Guaranteed bids will be awarded for the top five conference champions in the CFP rankings, and at-large bids will be given to the seven highest-ranked remaining teams. The four highest-ranked conference champions will receive first-round byes, and the remaining teams will play each other in the first round at the home fields of the better seeds, matched in the standard format of 5-12, 6-11, 7-10 and 8-9. The championship will continue to be held at a separately determined neutral site. First round games will occur in December, quarterfinal games on or around New Year's Day, semifinal games at least one week later, and the championship game one week after the semifinals.

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE

A selection committee will choose the 12 teams for the playoff based on their performance during the regular season, including, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, championships won, and other factors.

THE ROTATION

New Year's Six bowl games will be introduced in the quarterfinal round. The semifinals will be played in bowls on a rotating basis while the nationally championship host site is determined through bids by prospective host sites.

For the 2025-26 season, the Cotton Bowl (Dec. 31), Orange Bowl (Jan. 1), Rose Bowl (Jan. 1) and Sugar Bowl (Jan. 1) will host quarterfinal games, while the Fiesta Bowl (Jan. 8) and Peach Bowl (Jan. 9) will host semifinals. The College Football Championship will be held on Monday, Jan. 19 in Miami Gardens, Fla.

CUSA AND THE COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

As a member of the College Football Playoff, Conference USA will be a part of one of the College Football Playoff bowls if it has the highest rated champion from among the American Athletic, CUSA, Mid-American, Mountain West and Sun Belt Conferences.
