KYLE HIEBERT OF MISSOURI STATE, KERRY ABELLO OF PENN STATE LEAD ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA® DIVISION I MEN'S & WOMEN'S SOCCER TEAMS

AUSTIN, Texas – Defender Kyle Hiebert, a graduate student at Missouri State University, and Pennsylvania State University senior defender Kerry Abello headline the 2020-21 Academic All-America® Division I men's and women's soccer teams selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) and announced Monday.

Hiebert has been named the 2020-21 Academic All-America® of the Year for Division I men's soccer, while Abello earned the distinction of 2020-21 Academic All-America® of the Year for Division I women's soccer.

A native of La Salle, Manitoba, Hiebert is pursuing a graduate degree in accounting. He owns a 4.0 GPA in his graduate course work after also earning a 4.0 as an undergrad. Hiebert earns his fourth Academic All-America® honor after being named to the first team in 2018 and 2019, and to the third team in 2017. During the spring 2021 season, Hiebert led the Bears to a Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) tournament title and a bid to the NCAA Tournament. He started all 14 games on the backline for Missouri State, en route to being named the MVC Defensive Player of the Year and the MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Hiebert is a two-time United Soccer Coaches (USC) All-American, earning first team honors this past season. He was a MAC Hermann Trophy semifinalist along with being named the USC Scholar Player of the Year. Hiebert concluded his career by starting 68 consecutive games for the Bears.

Abello, a senior from Batavia, Illinois, carries a 4.0 GPA while double majoring in science and Spanish. It is her third Academic All-America® recognition, earning first team accolades in 2019 and second team honors in 2018. As team captain she helped guide Penn State to the 2021 Big Ten regular-season championship, her third as a Nittany Lion. She was also honored as a Senior CLASS second-team All-American. Abello is a Schreyer Honors College Scholar and a member of the Penn State Presidential Leadership Academy. She has played nearly every position during her four seasons at Penn State, where she has made 53 starts and scored 15 goals with nine assists in 74 career games.

Eight of the 33 members of the Academic All-America® Division I men's soccer teams boast a perfect 4.0 GPA in their undergraduate work or graduate school. The 11 members of the first team have an average GPA of 3.85, with the entire men's team holding a collective average GPA of 3.78.

Joining Hiebert as a repeat selection on the Academic All-America® Division I men's soccer team is fellow teammate **Michael Creek**. It is Creek's third Academic All-America® honor after being named to the first team in 2019 and the third team in 2018. **David Grana** (Saint Joseph's University) also earns his third Academic All-America® award following selections to the second team in 2018 and third team in 2019. Other repeat selections from 2019 include - **Andrew Thomas** (Stanford University), **Joel Harrison** (University of Michigan), and **Zach Maas** (Utah Valley University).

Eleven of the 33 members of the Academic All-America® Division I women's soccer teams sport a perfect 4.0 GPA in either undergrad or graduate school. The 11 members of the first team have an average GPA of 3.96, with the complete 33-member women's team averaging a 3.88 GPA.

Along with Abello, the Academic All-America® Division I women's soccer teams have four other repeat performers from last year's teams – **Caroline Chipman** (University of Georgia), **Hannah Webb** (Oklahoma State University), **Madison Haley** (Stanford University), and **Victoria Tran** (U.S. Naval Academy).


