

# Brad Underwood Basketball Camps

## PARENT/CHILD CAMP

June 10–11

Open to any and all parents/guardians, boys and girls ages 6 years to entering the eighth grade in Fall 2017

- Parent/child working together on basketball skills
- Parent/child contests
- Interaction with the Illini coaches, staff and players

**COST:** \$195/resident pair, \$95 each additional camper, \$165/commuter pair, \$80 each additional camper

**CHECK IN:** 4:30-5:30 p.m., the first day of camp

**CHECK OUT:** 12:00 p.m., the second day of camp

## DAY CAMP

June 12–14

Open to any and all boys entering grades 3–8 in Fall 2017

- Instruction by Illini coaches, players and selected coaches
- Basic fundamental development
- 1 on 1, 3 on 3 play, and team games
- Daily contests, games

**COST:** \$150 commuter (Bring your own lunch), \$165 commuter (lunch included)

**CHECK IN:** 8:30–10:00 a.m., the first day of camp

**CHECK OUT:** Closing ceremony at 4:00 p.m. on the last day of camp

## SENIOR HIGH TEAM CAMP

June 16–18

Open to any and all boys Senior High School teams in Fall 2017

- Emphasis is on team games and instruction by your school staff and Illinois staff
- Camper must be on a team that is attending camp in order to apply
- NCAA initial eligibility seminar

**CHECK IN:** 2:00–4:00 p.m., the first day of camp  
There is a required all camp meeting at 4:30 p.m.

**CHECK OUT:** The conclusion of the tournament on the last day of camp

**RESIDENT TEAMS:** Tuition is \$205 per camper, including \$50 deposit (minimum of eight campers per team). Tuition includes meals, lodging, and camp t-shirt.

**COMMUTER TEAMS:** Tuition is \$180 per camper, including \$50 deposit (minimum of eight campers per team). Tuition includes a camp t-shirt, lunch and dinner.

**DEPOSIT:** A \$50 per player deposit/non-refundable cancellation fee (minimum of eight campers) is required to reserve a place in camp. This deposit is applied toward the remaining balance. The remainder of tuition is payable on or before the first day of camp.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:** Any action deemed detrimental to the health and safety of oneself, other campers or to property will result in immediate dismissal from camp without a refund.

**CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE:** To confirm your team's attendance at Team Camp, either mail in a team deposit and pre-camp application form or register online. A more detailed information and confirmation packet will be sent to you later. A phone call does not guarantee a spot in the camp.

**FIRST AID:** A staff of First Aid Providers will be on duty 24 hours a day.

**STAFF:** Each team is required to be accompanied by one coach (schools with multiple teams must provide multiple coaches). Any additional staff members who accompany the team will be charged for their room and board.

**FORMAT:** Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 7 games and awards for each division champion. Camp format provides a variety of opponents, several late-game situations and differing styles of play with certified officials and awards for each division champion.



## INDIVIDUAL CAMP

June 18–21

Open to any and all boys ages 8 to entering grade 12 in Fall 2017

- Campers grouped by age (and ability)
- 10 to 1 camper to coach ratio
- Fundamental teaching stations/lectures
- Competitive team contests/drills
- Daily team league games/contests
- Quality instruction from Illinois staff, players and select coaches from throughout the U.S.

**COST:** \$360 resident, \$295 commuter

**CHECK IN:** 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., the first day of camp

**CHECK OUT:** 12:00 p.m. on the last day of camp

## BRAD UNDERWOOD FIGHTING ILLINI HEAD COACH

- Brad Underwood was hired as Fighting Illini men's basketball coach in March 2017. He's the 18th head coach in program history.
- Underwood arrives at Illinois from Oklahoma State, where he led OSU to a 20-win season and NCAA Tournament appearance. The Cowboys had one of the most exciting and prolific offenses in the country, standing eighth in the NCAA in scoring (85.7 points per game) and leading the nation in adjusted offensive efficiency in the current kenpom rankings. The Cowboys ranked eighth nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (.402) and fourth in the country in offensive rebounding percentage (.383).
- Oklahoma State finished fifth in the Big 12 with a 9-9 conference record in a season where the Big 12 was rated as the best conference in the nation. That was a dramatic improvement for the Cowboys, who went 3-15 in league play a year ago. Oklahoma State came on strong during the second half of the season, winning 10 of 11 games from Jan. 21-Feb. 25, which included a pair of five-game winning streaks.
- Underwood arrived in Stillwater following a dominant run at Stephen F. Austin where he led the Lumberjacks to Southland Conference regular season and tournament titles in each of his three seasons. Underwood compiled an 89-14 record at SFA, tied with Brad Stevens (Butler, 2008-10) for the most wins by a head coach in his first three seasons at an NCAA school.
- He led SFA to a 28-6 overall record and NCAA Round of 32 appearance in 2016. The Lumberjacks rolled past No. 3 West Virginia in the first round, 70-56, before narrowly missing a trip to the Sweet 16 with a 76-75 defeat to No. 6 Notre Dame in the second round.†
- That Stephen F. Austin squad was efficient on both sides of the ball, ranking 57th nationally on offense and 38th on defense. The Lumberjacks averaged 80.2 points accompanied by high-pressure defense that forced the highest turnover rate in the country (.259).
- Prior to taking over at Stephen F. Austin, Underwood served the 2013 season as associate head coach at South Carolina under Frank Martin.

He went to Columbia with Martin after serving on his bench for five seasons as an assistant at Kansas State, with his final season elevated to associate head coach. Underwood spent his first year at K-State in the role of director of operations for then-head coach Bob Huggins.

- Underwood has had two head coaching stints in the junior college ranks, compiling a 70-24 record at Daytona Beach (2003-06) and a 62-60 mark at Dodge City (1988-92). In between those opportunities, Underwood was entrenched in the state of Illinois for 10 seasons, as an assistant coach for Jim Kerwin at Western Illinois from 1992-2003.
- Underwood is a 1986 graduate of Kansas State. He played for the legendary Jack Hartman, K-State's all-time winningest coach. Former Illinois head coach Lon Kruger also played and coached for Hartman at Kansas State. Underwood began his college career at Hardin-Simmons, where he later entered the coaching ranks as a graduate assistant. Hardin-Simmons was the first college job for Lou Henson, the Fighting Illini's all-time winningest coach, and whose name permanently adorns the court at State Farm Center.
- Underwood and his wife, Susan, have three children - Tyler, Katie and Ashley.

## CAMP FEATURES

**RESIDENCE HALL:** Overnight campers and coaches are housed in Bromley Hall. All facilities are within walking distance of Bromley Hall.

**TOTAL INVOLVEMENT:** By the Illini coaches, staff and Fighting Illini players.

**CAMPERS GROUPED:** By age, height, and ability levels.

**SPORTS MEDICINE STAFF MEMBERS:** First Aid Providers are always available at each court side.

**COURT AVAILABILITY:** We utilize the state-of-the-art Ubben Basketball Complex, U of I Armory, Campus Recreation Facilities, and newly renovated State Farm Center.

**NCAA EDUCATION:** All camps will include an NCAA education session.

**OTHER CAMP FEATURES:** While at camp, a camp store is available to all campers and parents. The camp store has a variety of Illinois basketball apparel for your purchase. It is open at registration, during the week, and at check-out. Each night during the overnight camps, pizza and soda are sold upon the campers' return from the gym.

**CANCELLATION/REFUND/NSF POLICY:** ALL refund requests need to be submitted in writing using the 'Refund Request Form' found on the website or by calling the camps office (217-244-7278). Your camp cost, less a \$50 non-refundable cancellation fee, is refunded without question if you cancel at least one week prior to the registration date. At any time after that date, refunds (less the \$50 non-refundable fee) are made for medical reasons only and a signed statement from your physician must accompany the written request. If a cancellation request is not received by the last day of instruction, a refund is not issued. Campers who must leave during camp due to an illness or injury verified by our medical personnel will receive a refund (written request is necessary). Refunds are not given to campers who voluntarily leave camp or who are sent home for disciplinary reasons. **REFUNDS, FOR ANY REASON, ARE NOT ISSUED AFTER AUGUST 31, 2017.** NSF Checks submitted to the office are subject to a \$30 return check fee. This fee is assessed in addition to the face value of the check.

**CAMPER DESCRIPTION:** *Commuter Camper* is defined as a camper that is not staying in the residence hall. This camper participates in all camp activities. They must provide their own transportation to and from camp each day. Lunch is included in the commuter fee for those camps where meals are served. Additional meals included in the commuter cost vary from camp to camp. Passes for the remaining meals are available for purchase anytime at the front desk of the residence hall. *Resident Camper* is defined as a camper staying overnight for the duration of camp. All meals are included.
