Cardinale Stadium

Cardinale Stadium is a 6,000-seat soccer-specific venue located in the middle of the Monterey Peninsula on the campus of Cal State Monterey Bay in Seaside, Calif.

Formerly home to the Fort Ord Warriors, a semi-pro American football team composed of military service members, Monterey Bay Football Club invested over \$11 million in renovations to transition Cardinale Stadium into its newest era.

The stadium is lined by the region's iconic Monterey cypress trees and has been the home of the Cal State Monterey Bay men's & women's soccer teams since it opened on May 7, 2022

This will be the second time Cardinale has hosted a CCAA Soccer Championship (women, 2023).

Cal State Monterey Bay provides over 7,500 students an extraordinary opportunity to learn on a residential campus just one mile from the shores of the beautiful Monterey Bay. Our diverse student body receives personal attention in small classes while pursuing degrees in 25 undergraduate and nine graduate majors.

Founded in 1994 on the former site of Fort Ord by educators and community leaders, CSU Monterey Bay faculty and staff build on that legacy as we explore innovative ways to meet the needs of a new generation of students while simultaneously powering the Monterey County economy.

CSUMB serves students from the entire state of California, with 38 percent of the undergraduates come from Monterey, San Benito and Santa Cruz counties. Cal State Monterey Bay prides its on making higher education accessible to traditionally underserved and low-income populations. Seventy-two percent of our students receive some form of financial aid. Fifty-three percent of our students are among the first generation of their family to go to college. And with 52 percent of the students living on campus, CSUMB is one of the most residential universities in the CSU.

One thing that makes Cal State Monterey Bay different from any other campus in the country is our location. Not only is CSUMB just one mile from the beach, but it is also on the site of a former Army base.

Going to school on an old Army base can be pretty cool. For example, the Visual & Public Art Department has made an amazing studio and gallery space out of old motorpool buildings. You'll find many bits and pieces of this history all over campus – unique and surprising reminders of Monterey Bay's military past.

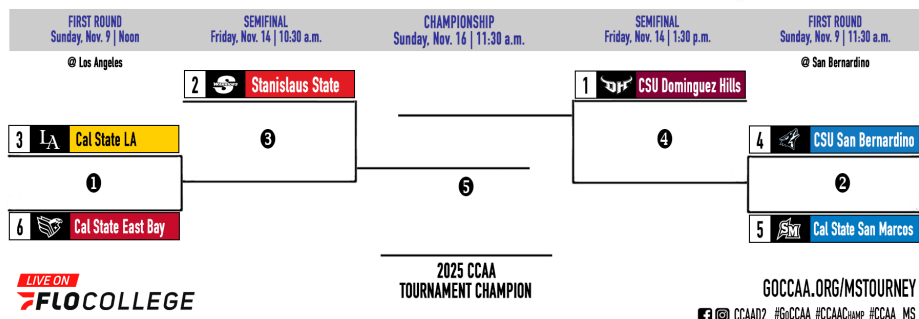

## CCAA's MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVE HELPS BRING AWARENESS TO AN UNSPOKEN ISSUE

Mental Health Awareness is important to everyone, and in the CCAA we are working to help spread awareness and destigmatize mental health.

The Mental Health Initiative program was started within the conference in 2024-25 and is in collaboration with the CalHOPE Courage Award to help spread knowledge of this important message. The first-ever CCAA Mental Health Initiative Day was held on Oct. 25, 2024 with the Fall athletic teams, including members from all 20 cross country teams at the CCAA Championships, who came together and held signs they each personally filled out about "Why is Mental Health Important?"

The idea was championed by the conference's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC). The conference SAAC members have continually emphasized the need to spread awareness of this topic and bring conversations into the open. This was the first step in what they hope is a series of actions to help destigmatize mental health, especially in athletics.

In the CCAA, we believe that awareness is the first step in tearing down some of the stigmas around Mental Health. By working with SAAC and the CalHope Courage Award, we aim to continue this initiative in future years, ensuring that all CCAA student-athletes have the opportunity to discuss their own mental health and encourage others to do the same.

ABOUT THE CCAA

The California Collegiate Athletic Association has been the nation’s most successful Division II intercollegiate athletic conference since its establishment in December 1938.

The 12-member league is home to some of the nation’s finest NCAA Division II athletic programs in Cal Poly Humboldt, Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State Dominguez Hills, Cal State East Bay, Cal State LA, Cal State Monterey Bay, Cal State San Bernardino, Cal State San Marcos, Chico State, San Francisco State, Stanislaus State, and UC Merced.

CCAA institutions compete in seven women's and six men's conference-sponsored sports. Fall sports include men's and women's cross country, men's and women's soccer and women's volleyball. Men's and women's basketball are contested in the winter, and baseball, men's and women's golf, men's and women's outdoor track & field and softball comprise spring competition.

CCAA members have won 157 NCAA Championships (103 men, 54 women) all time, far and away the most of any Division II conference. Since 2000, CCAA institutions have earned 24 national championships in 10 sports. During that span, eight members have earned at least one title highlighted by back-to-back championships for UC San Diego women's soccer (2000, '01) and Cal Poly Pomona women's basketball (2001, '02). In 2011, the Cal State Monterey Bay men's golf team finished at the top of the national leaderboard while UC San Diego softball also claimed the NCAA crown, marking a memorable May. Cal State San Bernardino volleyball ran the table in 2019 and hoisted the hardware with an undefeated season. Cal State LA has claimed national championships with men's soccer capturing the title in 2021 and the volleyball team in 2023. The Cal Poly Pomona women's soccer team won the most recent NCAA Championship in the fall of 2024.

The CCAA has undergone several changes in Conference membership since charter members UC Santa Barbara, Fresno State, San Diego State and San Jose State came together to form the league in 1938. Over the past 80-plus years, a number of institutions have been members of the CCAA, including Cal State Bakersfield, Cal State Northridge, Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, Chapman, Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State, Pacific, Pepperdine, Sonoma State, UC Riverside, UC Davis and Grand Canyon University. Most recently UC San Diego departed the conference to join the Big West (DI) on July 1, 2020. The CCAA Commissioner’s Office is located in Aliso Viejo.
