

Parking

Parking for cars and vans will be located in a grass field at the course. Bus parking will be at Lakeway Driving Range on Route 415.

Concessions

Concessions will be available at the course under a blue tent near the finish line.

T-Shirts

T-shirts will be available for sale at the course. Short-sleeve - \$12 Long-sleeve - \$15

Athletic training

Two certified athletic trainers will be on duty at the meet. Robin Jackson, Misericordia ATC, will serve as head trainer. Taping will be provided, but teams should bring their own supplies. Ice and water will be available near the finish line area.

Facilities

Staging Areas, Locker Rooms, Restrooms and other facilities

Teams can set-up team headquarters between the start/finish lines. The staging of teams should be on the inside of the course barriers.

Portable restrooms will be available near the start/finish area.

Awards

The top 10 finishers in each race earn MAC First-Team All-Conference and receive a medal. MAC Second-Team All-Conference (11-20) receive certificates.

Plaques are presented to the winning teams and Runners, Coaches and Rookies of the Year. The top finisher is runner of the year; the top first year runner is rookie of the year. The same person may win both.

All award winners are expected to attend the ceremony in school-issued uniforms or warm ups.

Pictures will be taken of championships teams, award winners as well as a group picture of allconference athletes.

Rookie, Runners and Coaches of the Year will participate in a video interview before or after the awards ceremony.

Results / Scoring

NCAA rules apply with a seven-person displacement. Incomplete teams will not count in team displacement, but individuals may win awards. A camera records the contestants crossing the finish line.

Results will be posted on the timer's trailer near the finish line. After results are posted, teams have 30 minutes to appeal results (Rule 4.62.).

Course Overview

The women's 6,000 meter and men's 8,000 meter courses are challenging courses with gentle rolling hills mixed with slight uphills and downhills.

We ask you to remind parents, fans, and friends that no pets are permitted at the course.

See the following two pages for specific course maps.

Women's 6K Course

The runners start in the bottom field and run through the field to an earth bridge crossing. Runners make a left turn across the field at about 800 meters. About 200 meters after the first left, they make a left turn down the hill towards the mile mark. At the mile mark, they make a left turn up a dirt/gravel hill and eventually make a right turn to start a 1000 meter loop. Once completing the loop they will make a right turn following the running path that zig zags all over the top fields of the course. The 2nd mile is roughly 300 meters after the right turn made following the 1000 meter loop and the 3rd mile is before travel downhill towards the pond on their way to the finish.



Men's 8K Course

The runners start in the bottom field and run through the field to an earth bridge crossing. The runners will travel 800 meters before they make a right turn to the follow the running path that zig zags within the fields. The 1 mile mark is located at the red barn on the course, the 2 mile mark is located directly across the 2nd earth bridge crossing. Once going through the 2nd mile you follow the path around the field and head through the start line to start your 2nd loop. During the 2nd loop, the 3 mile mark is located about 300 meter from the intersection at which you make a right on to the running path. During the 2nd loop the runners make a right turn into a back field for a 400 meter loop to make the course 8,000 meters. The 4 mile mark is located in the back loop. From that point, you will follow the running path towards the 2nd earth bridge and follow the path around the field. Runners will then run through the starting line again towards the finish line.

Women's Championships

With four returning first-team All-MAC placers, Elizabethtown College is the favorite to claim its sixth consecutive MAC Women's Cross Country championship, Saturday, October 27 at Misericordia.

The Blue Jays are currently ranked fourth in the Mideast region, according to the USTFCCCA rankings.

Junior **Traci Tempone** is the defending MAC champion and won the Misericordia Invitational on this course earlier this season. She is joined by classmates **Eileen Cody** and **Megan Patton** who finished third and fifth, respectively, a year ago.

Senior Taryn Shank finished 10th last year for the Blue Jays.

Senior Jessica Dillner was 17th a year ago and is the top returnee for Messiah, last year's runner-up.

Lebanon Valley was third last year and is led by junior **Cynthia Adams**, who finished eighth as a sophomore. **Dana Stockdale** also returns for LVC after placing 14th last season. Stockdale was the 2011 MAC Rookie of the year.

DeSales, fourth last year, returns a pair of second-team All-MAC honorees in juniors **Sarah Braun** (13th) and **Cara Guth** (15th).

Misericordia University hopes to take advantage of its home course. The Cougars are led by senior **Marina Orrson**, the MAC runner-up a year ago.

Lycoming's Michelle Herman finished 18th in 2011.

Men's Championships

Elizabethtown enters the 2012 MAC Men's Cross Country championships in search of its fourth straight team title.

Ranked sixth in the Mideast region, the Blue Jays must contend with two regionally-ranked rivals in Widener (7th) and DeSales (8th).

Elizabethtown returns junior **Steve Welsh**, the third-place finisher from a year ago, along with classmate Aaron Focht who placed 13th.

Widener is led by 2011 MAC Rookie of the Year **Chris Garrity**, who finished ninth as a freshman. The Pride's **Ryan Gallagher** returns for his senior season after finishing 16th last season.

DeSales returns three second-team All-MAC runners from last year. Junior **Bryan Megee** was 12th while sophomore **Nate Noll** was 15th and junior **Dan Beck** placed 20th.

Lebanon Valley's Eliot Bonds was eighth a year while Misericordia sophomore A.J. Limongelli was 11th.

During 2012-13, the Middle Atlantic Conferences celebrate MAC 100 to honor a century of intercollegiate competition as one of the oldest intercollegiate athletics associations in the United States.

Founded on December 10, 1912, the MAC has evolved into the only intercollegiate sports umbrella organization in the country that includes the Middle Atlantic, Freedom, and Commonwealth Conferences.

The first conference competition occurred on May 20, 1913 with a track & field meet at Lafayette College. Since then, 57 institutions have competed in 25 sports and won 21 NCAA team championships.

Currently 18 schools, spanning four states, have 6448 student-athletes competing in 23 sports for 36 conference championships.

As the MAC enters its second century, the presidents and athletic administrators have positioned the conference into the strongest, most cohesive structure since its founding.
