COMMONWEALTH CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S SOCCER



PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Eric Taylor (Widener / Jr., MF / Besalem, Pa.) scored twice last week for the Pride. He netted a goal and an assist in a 2-0 victory over Albright on Saturday. Earlier in the week, the junior added a goal against Lebanon Valley in a closely fought 2-1 setback.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Chris Watson (Arcadia / Fr., GK / Levittown, Pa.) earned a pair of 1-0 shutout victories over Alvernia and Lebanon Valley in his first two collegiate starts last week. The freshman recorded a total of 14 saves during the week. Watson recorded eight saves in a 1-0 overtime win against Alvernia and then collected six more saves in a 1-0 win against Lebanon Valley. Arcadia is currently tied for third with 10 points in the Commonwealth Conference.

WOMEN'S SOCCER



PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Rachel Cummings (Lebanon Valley / Jr., MF / Avis, Pa.) led the Dutchmen to two shut-out wins over Widener and Arcadia. The junior totaled three goals and six points from the midfield. Against Widener, Cummings scored two goals on just three shots in the team's 7-0 victory. On the road at Arcadia, she scored the game's only goal in a 1-0 win. Cummings finished the week with three goals on four shots for a .750 shot percentage.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Emmie Santoleri (Lebanon Valley / Fr., D / Eppers, Pa.) anchored the Dutchmen's backline by allowing no goals against two Commonwealth Conference opponents in Widener and Arcadia. The freshman assisted on a game-winner against Arcadia in a 1-0 victory. Santoleri restricted the opponent's attack all week to limit the Lebanon Valley goalkeeper's workload—only needing to make five saves over two games.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Margaret Wentzel (Alvernia / So., F / East Earl, Pa.) was a big part in Alvernia's offensive surge as the Crusades notched a pair of 4-0 wins, including the first conference loss for No. 14 Lebanon Valley. Wentzel totaled five goals and 10 points. Against Albright, the sophomore scored two goals in a 4-0 win. Against No. 14 LVC, Wentzel scored a hat trick, including the game-winner.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK – Erin Wunsch (Alvernia / Sr., GK / West Lawn, Pa.) took part in two shutouts over Albright and No. 14 Lebanon Valley last week, giving the Dutchmen their first loss in conference play. Wunsch made two saves against Albright in a 4-0 victory. She then made four saves to hold Lebanon Valley scoreless in a 4-0 victory.

The sophomore recorded double-digit kills in all three matches for a 3.78 kills per set average and a .473 hitting percentage. Against Messiah she recorded 11 kills (with just one error) for a .526 hitting percentage. Against Ursinus, Weidemoyer recorded 12 kills (with just one error) for a .733 hitting percentage. In the final match against Dickinson, she recorded 11 kills. Weidemoyer recorded seven digs and five block assists during the week.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK -- Rob Wiacek (Misericordia / Sr., MF / Voorhees, N.J.) recorded a pair of game-winning goals to lead the Cougars to a 2-0 week. Wiacek scored the game's only goal on a penalty kick in a 1-0 win at Wilkes. At home against Fairleigh Dickinson-Florham, the senior again scored the game's only goal in a 1-0 victory. It is Wiacek's third-straight game-winner this season.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK -- Michelle Churchman (DeSales / Sr., GK / Wharton, N.J.) continued her tremendous play recording two more shutouts to give her eight for the season. Churchman, who is repeating as Freedom Defensive Player of the Week, set the single-season DeSales shutout record which was previous set in 2006 with seven. The senior made five saves in a 3-0 win over Delaware Valley and made five more saves in a 3-0 win over Eastern. DeSales has clinched a post season berth and can finish no worse than No. 2 in the Freedom Conference.

She recorded 43 assists and 12 digs in a 3-1 over No. 10 Juniata. Schlager then recorded a week-high 46 assists with 17 digs in a 3-1 win over Carnegie Mellon.

SWIMMER OF THE WEEK -- Ian Gaynor (Widener / So. / Donegal, Ireland) broke his own school and conference record in the 50-yard freestyle as part of a four-victory day. He won the 50-yard freestyle in 20.60 seconds to top his own mark set from the 2014 MAC Championships. Gaynor also won the 100-yard freestyle (46.62). He was a member of the winning 200-yard medley relay (1:39.97) and the 400-yard freestyle relay (3:14.98) teams. The Pride defeated Scranton 160-102.

SWIMMER OF THE WEEK -- Macawley Brown (King's / Sr. / Harding, Pa.) helped King's open its season with a pair of wins over Marywood (145-115) and Drew (114-82). Brown won six events and finished second in another over the two meets. Against Marywood she won four races including the 100-yard butterfly (1:01.4), the 100-yard freestyle (57.18), the 50-yard butterfly (28.24) and was part of the winning 200-yard medley relay team (1:58.7). Against Drew, the senior won the 100-yard butterfly in a time of 1:03.1 and again help the 200-yard medley relay team (1:59.2) to another win. She took second in the 50-yard freestyle (26.47).
