## 2011 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

### DSU, UWA EARN GSC FOOTBALL LEAGUE TRIUMPHS

**Birmingham, AL**—The Gulf South Conference brought each of last week's football league matchups before television audiences as **Delta State** and **West Alabama** collected victories.

UWA opened the week, traveling to West Georgia in Thursday night's GSC-TV telecast. The Tigers were featured in GSC-TV play for the first time this season, hitting for 28 second-half points in a 35-23 triumph. The win was enough to propel **West Alabama** back into the AFCA Top 25 at No. 23.

UWA returns to the airwaves this Thursday night when it hosts in-state rival, **No. 5 North Alabama** in the GSC-TV Game of the Week. The game will be shown live by CSS, MediaCom, TV-24, WHCQ-TV Cleveland and **ESPN3** and will be tape delayed by CoxSports and the Alabama Cable Network. *Please note that ESPN3 viewership will be subject to blackout in CSS markets.*

**No. 1 Delta State** battled a Top 10 GSC rival in front of a television audience for the second week in a row, scoring the go-ahead touchdown with 40 seconds left in a 36-33 win over then **No. 10 Valdosta State**. The Statesmen put together an 18-play, 92-yard scoring drive capped by **running back Brant Botill's** three-yard TD run. Delta State takes this week off before hosting Homecoming versus West Alabama on November 15th.

**WEEK 10**

**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama running back Matt Willis** (JR, 5-8, 205, Collins, MS).

Willis earns his second award this year and is UWA's third overall honoree of the season after leading the Tigers to a 35-23 victory at West Georgia. The junior amassed a game-high 127 yards on 37 carries for a 3.4 per carry average and two touchdowns. The Collins, MS native tied the score, 7-7, at 8:57 in the first quarter via a four-yard run and then gave West Alabama a 14-13 edge at 9:51 in the third frame on a one-yard jaunt. Willis became just the second UWA player to rush for over 1,000 yards in a season. His 37 attempts were the fourth-most in a game in GSC history and he ran 100-yard game rushing streak to six.

**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Delta State defensive back Brett Butler** (SR, 6-0, 185, Modesto, CA)

Butler collects his first-ever accolade and is the second Statesmen defender to take home honors this season after DSU clipped No. 10 Valdosta State at home, 36-33. The senior notched six total tackles behind a team-high tying five solo stops, but he made his biggest contribution in pass coverage. The Modesto, CA native stepped in front of a VSU pass and returned it 65 yards for a touchdown with six seconds left in the third quarter. His TD was the Statesmen's only points of the quarter and closed the deficit to 27-23.

**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Delta State punter Andrew Jones** (JR, 6-0, 185, Corinth, MS).

Jones records his first career laurel and is DSU's first Special Teams winner of 2011. The junior booted five punts for 240 yards and a 48.0 punt average, while also dropping two inside Valdosta State's 20-yard line. The Corinth, MS native did not stop there, playing a key part in Delta State's game-winning drive late in the fourth quarter when he executed a fourth-and-two fake punt by rushing five yards for a first down.

The final scheduled GSC-TV Game of the Week for 2011 headlines this week's two-game Gulf South Conference Football schedule.

The GSC-TV crew travels to Livingston, AL for the first time this season when **No. 23 West Alabama** hosts rival **No. 5 North Alabama** on Thursday night. The league brings one of its most historic rivalries to the airwaves for the first time ever as the squads face off for the 64th time. The game will be shown live by CSS, MediaCom, WHCQ Cleveland, TV-24 and **ESPN3** (Blacked out in CSS markets) and shown on tape-delay on CoxSports (Thurs., 11 pm) and the Alabama Cable Network (Sat., 2 pm). Saturday features another important in-state rivalry when **No. 17 Valdosta State** hosts **West Georgia** in the 28th annual "Battle for the Peach Basket." Both squads seek to rebound from Conference setbacks a week ago.

**No. 23 West Alabama** (6-2, 1-1) hosts its first GSC-TV Game of the Week of the season when league rival **No. 5 North Alabama** (6-1, 0-1) enters Tigers Stadium on Thursday.

UWA takes the field hot off last Thursday's GSC-TV victory at West Georgia, which evened the Tigers' all-time GSC-TV record to 7-7. UNA hits the airwaves for the third time this season, splitting its two previous matchups en route to a 7-5 overall GSC-TV record.

The rivals battle in Livingston for the first time since 2008 when North Alabama earned a 41-9 triumph. The teams have traded wins the past two seasons with West Alabama outlasting the Lions in four overtimes in 2008, 31-28, and UNA claiming a 24-23 win a year ago. North Alabama leads the all-time series, 47-15-1, behind five victories in the last six contests. UNA is 17-9-1 all-time in Livingston via two straight wins in 2006 and 2008, while UWA posted wins in 2002 and 2004.

**Statistical Standouts:** North Alabama is No. 1 in the GSC in scoring offense (34.3), scoring defense (17.4), pass offense (305.6) and pass efficiency (146.4). West Alabama is tops in rushing offense (234.9) and second in pass defense (196.8), scoring defense (18.2) and total defense (338.6). **UWA running back Matthew Willis** is first in rushing (128.1) and rushing touchdowns (eight) and second in all purpose yards (145.2). **Wide receiver Gerald Worsham** is first in TD catches (tied, six) and kick returns (27.8) and places second in receptions (6.0) and third in receiving (74.9). **Freshman quarterback Kyle Caldwell** is No. 1 in pass efficiency (147.1) and fifth in passing (129.8). **UNA signal caller Lee Chapple** ranks second in passing (275.9), pass efficiency (140.7) and total offense (274.6). **Wide receiver Mo Miliam** leads the GSC in receptions (6.7) and receiving (79.7).

**No. 17 Valdosta State** and **West Georgia** face off in Valdosta on Saturday with each squad seeking to bounce back from league losses last week.

VSU has history on its side, claiming the past five matchups and 10 of the last 11 meetings. UWG returns to the site of its last win in the series when the Wolves upset the No. 2 ranked Blazers in 2005, 29-15. Valdosta State holds a 19-8-0 overall edge, including a 10-3-0 lead in home meetings.

**Statistical Standouts:** Valdosta State is first in the GSC in punting (40.0), while West Georgia is No. 1 in the nation punt return average (43.8). VSU is also tops in sacks against (1.00) and second in rushing defense (135.6) and interceptions (12). UWG is third in the league in rushing offense (180.3) and pass defense (219.3). West Georgia **placekicker Davis Brackett** is No. 1 in scoring (7.3), while **placekicker Daniel Andersen** is No. 2 (6.8). **VSU running back David Bailey** is second in rushing (64.5). **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** ranks sixth in passing (102.6) and seventh in total offense (114.3). **UWG running back James Kennebrew** (51.7) and **quarterback Emmanuel Taylor** (fifth, 51.4) are fourth and fifth in rushing, respectively. **Wide out Denarius Appling** is top in punt returns (43.8) and all purpose yards (161.6).

**WEST ALABAMA 35, @ WEST GEORGIA 23 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV TELECAST)**

**West Alabama** (6-2, 1-1) scored 28 points in the second half to top **West Georgia** (4-3, 0-1) on road in Thursday night's GSC-TV Game of the Week.

UWG reached into its bag of tricks to light the scoreboard first when **wide out Denarius Appling** reeled-in an option pass from **wide receiver V.J. Hunt** and ran 86-yards for a touchdown at 12:07 in the opening quarter. UWA answered on its next offensive possession, driving 47 yards in eight plays capped by **running back Matt Willis'** four-yard TD jaunt.

The Wolves' defense held the Tigers scoreless in the second stanza and West Georgia took a 13-7 lead into halftime thanks to field goals from 43 and 31 yards by **Davis Brackett**.

West Alabama posted its first lead of the game on the first possession of the second half behind a one-yard scoring plunge by Willis at 9:51. UWG regained a 16-14 advantage at 5:43 thanks to Brackett's 35-yard field goal, only to see UWA post 14 unanswered points. **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** ran for an eight-yard touchdown with 1:42 left in the third frame and **wide receiver Ken May** hauled in a 45-yard scoring strike at 11:12 in the final quarter.

The Wolves did not give up, making the score 28-23 with 4:56 left to play via **Bobby Brum's** 65-yard touchdown reception, but West Alabama put together a game-clinching, 4:50 drive capped by a 23-yard TD catch by May with one tick on the clock.

Willis led all rushers with 127 yards on 37 carries, while May added three receptions for 101 yards. Caldwell completed 11-of-14 passes for 206 yards and added 67 yards on the ground. UWG's Appling combined for 287 yards by posting game-highs in catches (six), receiving yards (168) and kickoff return yards (119). West Alabama evened its overall GSC-TV record to 7-7 and pulled within one game of the all-time series against West Georgia, 18-17-0. UWA also put the brakes on an eight-game skid in Carrollton dating back to 1994. [Box score](#)

**@ #1 DELTA STATE 36, #10 VALDOSTA STATE 33 (GSC-TV TELECAST)**

**No. 1 Delta State** (8-1, 2-0) used a 92-play game-winning drive to rally past **No. 10 Valdosta State** (6-2, 1-1) in Saturday's GSC-TV contest, 36-33.

DSU dominated the early going, sprinting to a 13-0 lead in the first quarter. The Statesmen needed just 40 seconds to hit pay dirt when **wide receiver Lavon Downs** hauled-in a 62-yard touchdown pass at 14:20, but the point-after attempt fell short. **Quarterback Micah Davis** upped the advantage to 13-0 via a three-yard scoring scamper at 11:34.

VSU answered in the top half of the second frame, grabbing a 14-13 edge behind **wide out Seantavious Jones'** 28-yard TD catch at 14:21 and **Tevin Davis'** 21-yard fumble recovery for a score at 9:46. Delta State entered the locker room with a 16-14 lead thanks to **Matt Dean's** 23-yard field goal with 4:18 remaining in the first half.

Valdosta State's halftime adjustments paid off to start the second half as **quarterback Cayden Cochran** posted back-to-back touchdown runs. Cochran made the score 20-16 at 11:33 via a 27-yarder, but a two-point conversion pass failed. Next, he stretched the Blazers' lead to 27-16 from five yards out at 4:07 in the third frame.

DSU capped the third quarter with a defensive touchdown of its own when **defensive back Brett Butler** returned an interception 65 yards for a score with just six seconds on the clock. **Mark Vukadinovic's** nine-yard TD catch gave the Statesmen a 29-27 advantage with 9:54 left to play, but the extra-point kick failed. Valdosta State settled for a 33-29 lead at 7:37 as Tory Braswell's one-yard rushing touchdown was followed by a missed two-point pass, setting the stage for DSU's go-ahead drive. **Running back Brant Botill** pounded-in the game-winner from three yards out with just 40 seconds left to play. **Punter Andrew Jones** extended the drive by gaining five yards on a fake punt on fourth-and-two yards.

**DSU wide receiver Chance Dennis** led all players with eight catches for 118 yards. Davis completed 22-of-36 passes for 212 yards and one TD, while also rushing for another score. **Valdosta State running back Theseus Jackson** ran for a game-best 177 yards on 17 carries in a losing effort. The Statesmen earned their six consecutive victory over Valdosta State. [Box score](#)
