## 2011 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

### UWA, UWG RECORD GSC FOOTBALL UPSETS

**Birmingham, AL**—TThe upset bug bit the Gulf South Conference last week as **West Alabama** and **West Georgia** each shocked their respective nationally ranked opponents.

The 2011 GSC-TV Game of the Week schedule finished on a high note on Thursday when UWA recorded a 31-26 upset over in-state rival **No. 5 North Alabama**. The Tigers collected their second win in three matchups versus UNA and moved themselves into position to claim a share of their first GSC Crown since 1971. West Alabama travels to first-place, **No. 1 Delta State** on Saturday.

UWG journeyed to in-state rival **No. 17 Valdosta State** seeking its first win in six games versus VSU. The Wolves put the brakes on the skid, thanks to a 16-play, 66-yard game-winning drive which culminated in **wide receiver V.J. Hunt's** touchdown catch with five seconds remaining. West Georgia returns to the road this Saturday when it battles **North Alabama**.

# 2011 GSC FOOTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**WEEK 11**

**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama wide receiver Ken May** (SR, 5-9, 180, Northport, AL).

May is the second consecutive UWA Offensive winner after he helped lead the Tigers to a 31-26 home upset of No. 5 North Alabama. The senior grabbed three passes for a career-high 121 yards and a 40.3 average along with one touchdown catch. The Northport, AL native's longest reception of the night came on a 68-yard scoring strike which extended UWA's lead to 14-0 with 3:04 left in the first quarter.

**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Georgia linebacker Will Jones** (SR, 6-1, 205, Leesburg, GA).

Jones earns UWG's first defensive accolade of the season after spearheading the Wolves' defense in a 23-20 road upset over No. 17 Valdosta State. The senior racked up a team-high tying nine total tackles behind five solo stops. The Leesburg, GA native also recorded one sack for a 12-yard loss that pushed VSU out of field goal range in the second quarter.

**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**UWG punter/placekicker Davis Brackett** (JR, 5-9, 172, Marietta, GA).

Brackett collects his second award in three weeks by leading West Georgia's special teams unit against Valdosta State. The junior accounted for four total points, going 1-for-2 on field goals and 1-for-2 on point-after kicks. He booted a 31-yard field goal with no time left in the first half, extending UWG's lead to 16-7. The Marietta, GA native did not stop there, booming three punts for 121 yards and a 40.3 average. All three of Brackett's punts were downed inside the 20-yard line headlined by two that were placed at the VSU one-yard line.

GSC Football brings two Saturday matchups to the table this week with a share of the Conference Title up for grabs in Cleveland, MS.

**No. 1 Delta State** hosts Homecoming festivities and **No. 18 West Alabama** with the winner securing at least a share of the 2011 Title. DSU is 2-0 in league action, while UWA is 2-1 and plays its final Conference contest of the year. The Statesmen can lock up a share of its six overall GSC Crown, while the Tigers seek just their second Title, first since 1971.

**No. 17 North Alabama** and **West Georgia** complete Saturday's action in Florence, AL. UNA is in search of its first GSC victory of the season, while UWG enters Braly Municipal Stadium hot off its upset at Valdosta State. VSU is idle this week before hosting North Alabama next Saturday.

Homecoming host **No. 1 Delta State** and **No. 18 West Alabama** face off for the 57th time with GSC Title hopes on the line. DSU enters of its bye-week as the defending GSC Champion after winning a three-way share of the crown in 2010. UWA seeks to return to the winner's circle for the first time since claiming a two-way share of the first-ever GSC Title in 1971. The Statesmen own a 33-20-3 all-time series lead after taking seven of the last eight contests. The rivals have alternated victories the past two seasons with Delta State winning in Cleveland in 2010 (41-37) and West Alabama claiming a home win in 2009 (34-14). DSU has posted four in a row at home versus UWA dating back to 2005.

**Statistical Standouts:** Delta State tops the GSC in scoring offense (33.8), total offense (481.6), total defense (313.8), rushing defense (117.1), pass defense (196.7) and sacks (3.22). West Alabama is tops in rushing offense (224.7) and scoring defense (19.1) and second in total defense (313.8), rushing defense (139.3) and pass efficiency (144.1). **DSU quarterback Micah Davis** is No. 1 in total offense (300.3) and passing touchdowns (17) and No. 2 in passing (286.1). **Wide receiver Chance Dennis** is second in receiving (78.2) and receptions (5.9). **Running back Brandon Lucas** is sixth in rushing (44.4), second in kick returns (23.0) and third in all purpose yards (140.5), while **Richard Freelon** ranks seventh in rushing (42.8). **UWA running back Matthew Willis** is first in rushing (128.2), scoring (7.3) and rushing touchdowns (10) and second in all purpose yards (147.0). **Wide receiver Ken May** is tops in TD catches (seven), while **Gerald Worsham** is best in kick returns (29.4) and third in receptions (5.6). **Freshman quarterback Kyle Caldwell** is No. 1 in pass efficiency (159.4) and fourth in passing (141.1).

**No. 17 North Alabama** hosts **West Georgia** with its back against the wall in a matchup against squads headed in opposite directions.

UNA is winless in the GSC play after dropping its last two contests, while UWG has built its best overall win-loss record since 2005 capped by last week's road upset over Valdosta State. The Lions have history on their side on Saturday thanks to an 18-10-0 series lead and a six-game winning streak. The Wolves return to the site of their last triumph in the series when they topped UNA in Florence in 2004, 38-21. North Alabama is 9-4-0 at home in the series.

**Statistical Standouts:** North Alabama is No. 1 in the GSC in pass offense (317.0) and pass efficiency (146.9) and No. 2 in scoring offense (33.8), scoring defense (19.1) and total offense (435.6). UWG is second in the league in rushing offense (190.0) and pass defense (207.9) and leads the nation in punt returns (43.8). **UNA quarterback Lee Chapple** ranks tops in passing (291.0) and second pass efficiency (143.6) and total offense (290.0). **Wide receiver Mo Miliam** heads the GSC in receptions (7.0) and receiving (85.8) and **Tristan Purifoy** is third in receiving (75.1) and fourth in receptions (4.4). **UWG running back James Kennebrew** (65.0) and **quarterback Emmanuel Taylor** (53.6) are second and fourth in rushing, respectively. **Wide out Denarius Appling** is tops in punt returns (43.8) and all purpose yards (160.9).

**@ #23 WEST ALABAMA 31, #5 NORTH ALABAMA 26 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)**

**No. 23 West Alabama** (7-2, 2-1) upset **No. 5 North Alabama** (6-2, 0-2), 31-26, at Tiger Stadium in the Thursday night's GSC-TV Live Game of the Week.

**UWA running back Matthew Willis** rushed for 111 yards and three touchdowns and **quarterback Kyle Caldwell** threw for 209 yards and two touchdowns as **UNA counterpart Lee Chappell** threw for 397 yards and two touchdowns. North Alabama could not fight back from an early 14-point hole as the Tigers kept the scoring pace throughout the game. A late touchdown pass to **Chris Coffey** with 1:32 remaining brought the Lions within five points, but Willis recovered the onside kick and the Tigers ran out the clock.

West Alabama took the lead early in the first quarter. After being forced to punt, UWA forced a turnover and regained possession at the UNA 32. On the ensuing play, Caldwell connected with Willis for a touchdown pass that put the Tigers ahead, 7-0. A roughing the kicker call that helped UWA possession would turn to gold. Two plays later, **wide out Ken May** makes a spectacular play, fighting off a pass interference call and spinning off a defender for a 68-yard touchdown reception to push the advantage to 14-0 with just more than three minutes left in the first quarter.

West Alabama led 17-3 at halftime but North Alabama came out of the locker room on fire. UNA sandwiched a 34-yard touchdown run by Willis with an 11-yard scoring pass from Chapple to **wide receiver Cameron Wade** and an 8-yard run by Coffey to cut the deficit to 24-19 in the third quarter. But following a great 37-yard catch by May to the UNA 1, Willis punched it in to push the lead to 31-19 early in the fourth quarter.

The victory was West Alabama's second in the last three matchups versus North Alabama and put the Tigers in position to claim a share of its first GSC Title since 1971 with a win at Delta State next Saturday.

**WEST GEORGIA 23, @ #17 VALDOSTA STATE 20 (HOMECOMING)**

**West Georgia** (5-3, 1-1) mounted a 16-play, 66-yard game-winning drive, spoiling **No. 17 Valdosta State's** (6-3, 1-2) Homecoming, 23-20, with the go-ahead touchdown with five seconds left to play.

VSU opened the scoring by finding the end zone on its first offensive possession when **quarterback Cayden Cochran** ran for a five-yard TD at 9:01 in the first quarter. UWG dominated the second frame, posting 16 unanswered points. **Wide receiver V.J. Hunt** hauled-in an 18-yard TD at 11:35, but the Wolves missed the extra-point kick. West Georgia hit for 10 points in the final 16 seconds. **Wide out Denarius Appling** caught a 59-yard score with 16 ticks left and the Blazers fumbled the ensuing kickoff which the Wolves turned into three points via **Davis Burkett's** field goal as time expired.

Valdosta State provided the first six points in the second half, thanks to a pair of field goals by **Daniel Andersen**. Andersen posted the lone points in the third frame on a 40-yard field goal and he added a 30-yarder at 9:48 in the four quarter. VSU claimed a 20-16 lead with 5:40 left to play after **wide out Seantavious Jones** capped a 99-yard drive via a 21-yard touchdown catch. **Quarterback Emmanuel Taylor** led UWG to its game-winning, 66-yard march when he tossed an 11-yard TD pass to Hunt with just five seconds on the clock.

**West Georgia running back James Kennebrew** led the team with 145 yards on 27 carries, while Taylor combined for 171 yards and three touchdowns. UWG earned its first road victory since 2006 and snapped VSU's five-game winning streak in the series. The Wolves' five wins are also the most since 2005. [Box score](#)
