2011 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

UWG UPSETS DSU, GSC LANDS THREE IN NCAA PLAYOFF FIELD

Birmingham, AL—The 2011 Gulf South Conference Football season came to an exciting end last weekend with all three contests decided by a touchdown or less.

Leading the way was **West Georgia** (6-4, 2-2) which closed its campaign by shocking then **No. 1 Delta State** (9-2, 3-1) in Carrollton, 39-35. UWG handed DSU its first league and Division II setback by piling up 15 unanswered points in the fourth quarter. **Running back James Kennebrew** iced the win, scoring the go-ahead, one-yard TD with 1:32 left to play. The Statesmen lived to fight another day, securing the No. 1 NCAA Super Region Two seed despite the loss.

No. 13 North Alabama (8-2, 2-2) joined DSU in the NCAA Playoff field thanks to a 30-23 win at **Valdosta State** (6-4, 1-3). UNA rallied from a seven-point deficit in the fourth quarter via 14 unanswered points in the final 8:08. **Running back Wes Holland** put the game away, capping a 12-play, 79-yard drive with a 16-yard scoring catch with 57 ticks on the clock.

West Alabama (8-3, 2-2) stepped out league action, hosting a 30-23 upset of Division I-FCS Georgia State, 30-23. **UWA running back Matt Willis** set three school records in the victory and ran for the game-winning, four-yard score with 2:12 left to play. Willis stands as the Tigers' season leader in rushing (1,408), total touchdowns (16) and rushing TDs (15). The good news continued for UWA on Sunday when the Tigers were selected for the NCAA Playoffs.

West Alabama hosts North Alabama this Saturday in the First Round of the NCAA Division II Football Playoffs at 12:00 pm (Central). The UWA/UNA winner advances to the Second Round and travels to No. 1 seed Delta State on November 26.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia quarterback Emmanuel Taylor (JR, 5-10, 180, Blakely, GA).

Taylor is UWG's first Offensive honoree since 2007 after he helped lead the Wolves to a 39-35 home upset over No. 1 Delta State. The junior guided West Georgia to the victory thanks to 15 unanswered points in the fourth quarter. Taylor played a direct part in four of five touchdowns on the day and combined for 355 total yards. The Blakely, GA native completed 16-of-32 passes for 258 yards and two TDs, while also running for team-high 97 yards and two scores on 25 carries. Taylor pulled the Wolves within three points at 9:06 in the fourth quarter thanks to a one-yard run and a two-point pass. He then oversaw the game-winning drive which culminated in the go-ahead TD at 1:32.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama linebacker Marcus Downtin (SR, 6-2, 226, Upper Marlboro, MD).

Downtin takes home his second honor of the season, spearheading UNA's defense in a 30-23 road triumph over Valdosta State. The senior racked up a team-best 10 total tackles behind a game-high eight solo stops. He also added two tackles for a loss of 11 yards, forced one fumble and added one quarterback hurry. The Upper Marlboro, MD native's final sack came early in the fourth quarter and knocked VSU's starting quarterback out of the game which hampered the Blazers' offense the rest of the way.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UNA return specialist Tristan Purifoy (SR, 6-0, 185, Hanceville, AL).

Purifoy earns UNA's third Special Teams laurel this season. The senior added four total returns for 104 yards led by three kickoff returns for 86 yards. The Hanceville, AL native's biggest impact came when he blocked a Valdosta State punt which was returned for the game-tying score with 8:08 remaining in the contest.

2011 GSC FOOTBALL WEEK AHEAD/NCAA PLAYOFF PREVIEW Week 13

For the sixth time in seven seasons, the Gulf South Conference placed three teams in the NCAA Division II Football Playoffs.

The selections also marked the 10th overall time that the GSC advanced three teams into the post-season and the ninth consecutive season in which the league sent at least two teams. The Conference posted multiple participants for the 22nd time and has been represented in the post-season in 36 of the last 37 years, missing out in 1976.

Leading the GSC contingent in the six-team Super Region Two field is **No. 1 seed Delta State** (9-2) which also earned a First Round Bye. **No. 4 seed West Alabama** (8-3) and **No. 5 seed North Alabama** (8-2) round out the contingent and square off in Livingston on Saturday in one of the two First Round contests. DSU is off this weekend and hosts the UWA/UNA winner on November 26th.

A total of 19 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 92 wins during that span along with a .626 winning percentage (92-55). In fact, of the last 24 national champions, 10* have come from the GSC, seven from the North Central Conference, three from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (16) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). *--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.

In-state GSC rivals **West Alabama** and **North Alabama** rematch at Tiger Stadium for second time this season and the 65th overall time.

Then No. 23 UWA upset No. 5 UNA in the October 27 regular-season matchup, 31-26, in front of a GSC-TV Game of the Week audience. North Alabama could not fight back from an early 14-point hole as the Tigers kept their scoring pace throughout the game. A late touchdown pass to Chris Coffey with 1:32 remaining brought the Lions within five points, but UWA recovered the onside kick and the hosts ran out the clock from there.

North Alabama leads the all-time series, 47-16-1, and is 17-10-1 in Livingston. The last three games have been decided by five or less points, including UNA's 31-28 four-overtime win in 2009 and UWA's 24-23 edge in 2010.

West Alabama advanced to its second NCAA Playoff field in three years and third all-time. UWA is 2-2 in post-season action after going 1-1 in each of its previous appearances. The Tigers are 1-1 versus the NCAA Playoff field this season with their loss coming at Delta State.

North Alabama kicks off NCAA Playoff action versus a fellow GSC rival for the fifth consecutive year, going 4-0 in those matchups. The Lions make their 17th all-time playoff appearance, seventh straight, while building a 28-13 record. UNA is a three-time NCAA Champion, claiming three straight crowns from 1993-95. North Alabama has advanced to the Finals four times and the Semi-Finals nine times. UNA is 1-2 against the NCAA field this season with its lone win coming against Super Region Four No. 6 seed Abilene Christian, 23-17. The Lions also lost at home in overtime to Delta State,

Statistical Standouts: West Alabama leads the GSC in rushing offense (226.7) and is second in scoring defense (21.0), total defense (362.1), rushing defense (137.5) and pass efficiency (131.6). North Alabama is No. 1 in the GSC in scoring defense (17.9), pass offense (297.2), pass efficiency (144.2) and pass defense efficiency (111.9).

UWA running back Matthew Willis is first in rushing (128.0), scoring (8.7) and rushing touchdowns (15). **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** and **running back Don Smith** also rank ninth (37.6) and 10th (33.3) in rushing, respectively. Caldwell is also second in pass efficiency (136.8), third in passing (145.7) and fourth in total offense (183.2). **Wide receiver Gerald Worsham** places second in receptions (5.9) and receiving (70.5), while **Ken May** is tops in TD catches (tied, seven) and fifth in receiving (56.2). **UNA quarterback Lee Chapple** ranks first in pass efficiency (140.6) and passing (276.4) and second in total offense (273.7). **Wide receiver Mo Miliam** heads the GSC in receptions (6.4) and receiving (79.4) and **Tristan Purifoy** is fourth in receiving (69.0) and receptions (4.3).

@ WEST GEORGIA 39, #1 DELTA STATE 35

West Georgia (6-4, 2-2) made school history, earning its first-ever win over a national number one squad, rallying to shock **Delta State** (9-2, 3-1) at home, 39-35.

The rivals traded punches throughout the game. UWG grabbed a 10-0 lead early in the second quarter thanks to **Davis Brackett's** 31-yard field goal at 2:40 in the first quarter and **Bobby Burum's** 19-yard touchdown catch at 10:40 in the second frame. DSU jumped ahead, 14-10, behind **quarterback Micah Davis'** 12-yard scoring scamper and **running back Brandon Lucas'** 50-yard TD run. The Wolves collected a 17-14 halftime edge after **quarterback Emmanuel Taylor's** one-yard touchdown run with 1:54 on the clock.

West Georgia upped its edge to 24-14 at 12:46 in the third quarter after **wide out Arkeem French** hauled-in a 30-yard touchdown grab. Delta State answered by closing the quarter with 21 points. **Running back Avery Horn** ran in a one-yard TD at 12:14, followed by Davis' three-yard rushing score and Lucas' 42-yarder with two ticks on the clock.

Taylor ran for a one-yard touchdown and followed with a two-point pass, closing UWG's deficit to three with 9:06 left to play and **running back James Kennebrew** shut the door on 4th-and-goal via a one-yard TD at 1:32. The Statesmen did not give up, driving to the UWG seven-yard line, but they could not post the go-ahead touchdown.

Taylor accounted for 355 total yards behind a team-high 97 yards rushing and a game-high 258 yards passing on 16-of-32 attempts. Burum led all players with six receptions for 95 yards. DSU's Lucas ran for a game-best 233 yards on 19 carries in a losing effort. West Georgia put the brakes on a seven-game skid versus Delta State and moved its record versus Top 25 teams this season to 2-1. [Box score](#)

#13 NORTH ALABAMA 30, @ VALDOSTA STATE 23

No. 13 North Alabama (8-2, 2-2) secured a spot in the NCAA Playoffs by rallying from 14-point deficit in the fourth quarter to upend **Valdosta State** (6-4, 2-2) on the road, 30-23.

Both squads were playing for their post-season lives, setting the stage for another classic matchup between the traditional GSC rivals. UNA lit the scoreboard first at 2:30 in the first quarter behind **Jason Smith's** four-yard touchdown reception. **VSU's Matt Pierce** returned the ensuing kickoff 96 yards for a TD, but the Lions blocked and returned the extra-point for two points.

The Blazers grabbed a 13-9 edge at 3:41 in the second frame via **Cameo Holloway's** 19-yard scoring catch. **North Alabama running back Chris Coffey** answered with a one-yard touchdown run with 46 seconds remaining in the first half, but Valdosta State took advantage of a short kickoff by taking a 20-16 lead with three ticks left on **Griffin Roelle's** 33-yard TD grab.

Daniel Andersen provided the lone points of the third quarter, nailing a 26-yard field goal with 11 seconds left in the frame. UNA's block team struck again with 8:08 left in the game when **Tristan Purifoy** blocked a VSU punt and **Robbie Burdine** returned it 22 yards for a TD. The Lions moved ahead for good with just 57 seconds left to play via **running back Wes Holland's** hauled-in a 16-yard scoring pass.

North Alabama quarterback Lee Chapple completed 26-of-38 passes for 247 yards and two TDs. **Wide receiver Cameron Wade** recorded game-highs in catches (six) and yards (62), while **running back Antwan Ivey** led the squad with 73 yards rushing. UNA upped its all-time series lead to 20-14-0 thanks to its fifth win in the last six meetings. [Box score](#)

@ WEST ALABAMA 30, GEORGIA STATE 23

West Alabama (8-3, 2-2) never trailed visiting NCAA Division I-FCS Georgia State, but the Tigers need a touchdown with 2:12 left to preserve a 30-23 upset.

UWA sprinted to a 10-0 lead in the first quarter thanks to **Ryne Smith's** career-long 45-yard field goal on the Tigers' opening drive and **Curt Amacker's** 22-yard touchdown grab at 4:32. GSU answered with a touchdown at the two-minute mark, but West Alabama responded just 41 seconds into the second frame via an 11-yard scoring scamper by **running back Matt Willis**. The Bobcats pulled within three at 12:11, but UWA took a six-point edge into the locker room after Smith's 40-yard field goal with 16 ticks on the clock.

Georgia State posted the lone points of the third frame by blocking a UWA punt that traveled out of the Tigers' end zone. Smith's 23-yard field goal gave West Alabama a 23-16 lead at 13:10 in the fourth quarter, only to see GSU tie the score on a touchdown at 9:02. UWA mounted a nine-play, 86-yard game-winning drive which culminated in Willis' go-ahead four-yard TD run at 2:12.

Willis racked up 171 yards on 33 carries, setting three school records: single-season rushing (1,408), total touchdowns (16) and touchdown runs (15). **Wide receiver Gerald Worsham** tied a game-high with eight catches for 67 yards. The win evened UWA's record versus Division I-FCS opponents this season to 1-1 and preserved the Tigers' perfect home mark this season (6-0).
