2011 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

UNA TOPS UWA IN NCAA PLAYOFFS, PLAYS AT DSU THIS WEEKEND

Birmingham, AL—For the second week in a row, a pair of Gulf South Conference rivals will face off in the NCAA Division II Football Playoffs.

No. 5 seed North Alabama (9-2) advanced to the Second Round of the Super Region Two bracket this past Saturday, claiming a 43-27 victory at No. 4 seed and league rival **West Alabama**.

The win was sweet revenge for UNA which fell at UWA during the regular season. Next up for the Lions is a trip to Cleveland, MS to face Conference rival and **No. 1 seed Delta State** (9-2) this Saturday. The rivals matchup in the post-season for the second year in a row after DSU topped North Alabama at home in last year's Second Round, 47-24. Kickoff time for this year's post-season clash is set for 1:00 pm (Central). The UNA/DSU victor moves on to the Super Regional 2 Title Game versus the winner of the North Greenville/Wingate contest.

#5 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 47, @ #4 SEED WEST ALABAMA 23 (NCAA PLAYOFFS—FIRST ROUND)

No. 5 seed North Alabama (9-2) earned revenge for its regular season loss at **West Alabama** (8-4) by topping No. 4 seed UWA in Livingston in the First Round of the NCAA Division II Football Playoffs, 43-27.

UNA's offense led the way, rolling up 472 total yards and scoring on all but three of its possessions. North Alabama jumped out to a 12-0 lead less than five minutes into the first quarter. **Running back Chris Coffey** capped a 61-yard drive with a one-yard scoring run at 12:11, but the Lions missed the point-after kick. UNA's special teams added to the lead when **Janoris Jenkins** returned a punt 92 yards for a TD with 10:15, only to see the point-after attempt blocked. Jenkins' return was the third longest in GSC history and the longest ever in the UNA record books.

West Alabama put together a 10-play, 69-yard drive, pulling within 12-7 thanks to **running back Matt Willis'** three-yard TD jaunt. The Lions stretched their lead to 15-7 thanks to a 37-yard field goal at 2:31, but UWA closed the deficit to 15-14 via a two-yard TD run by Willis with 13:51 left in the first half. North Alabama ruled the rest of the second frame, reeling off 21 unanswered points. Coffey ran for an eight-yard touchdown at 8:24, followed by **Tristan Purifoy's** five-yard scoring catch at 4:14 and **Cameron Wade's** eight-yard reception with 20 ticks on the clock. The Tigers stopped the bleeding as time expired thanks to **Ryne Smith's** 41-yard field goal.

UWA ate up nearly eight minutes on the first drive of the second half, but settled for a 20-yard field goal by Smith at 7:52. **UNA running back Wes Holland** gave the Lions a 43-20 edge with 32 seconds remaining in the third stanza, but Willis answered on a one-yard TD run with 12:11 left to play. Neither team lit the scoreboard the rest of the way, marking the seventh straight season that UNA opened the post-season with a victory.

North Alabama quarterback Lee Chapple completed 27-of-33 passes for 320 yards and two touchdowns. **Wide receiver Daniel Almon** led all players with 104 receiving yards on eight catches. UWA's Willis gained a game-best 156 yards and three TDs on 33 carries in a losing effort. Next up for North Alabama is a rematch with No. 1 seed Delta State in Cleveland, MS in next Saturday's Second Round. Kickoff is set for 12:00 pm Central Time. [Box score](#)

GSC rivals clash in the NCAA Playoffs for the second week in a row when GSC Champion and **No. 1 seed Delta State** plays **No. 5 seed North Alabama** for the second time this season. DSU outlasted UNA in Florence, 30-24, in overtime in the GSC-TV Game of the Week matchup on October 13th.

The foes are no strangers to post-season matchups as they have faced off in the NCAA Playoffs fifth times in last six seasons. The teams have split the four post-season battles led by the Statesmen's 47-24 home win on the way to last year's NCAA Title Game appearance. The Lions earned a 34-24 playoff victory in Cleveland in 2008 and a 20-17 home triumph in 2007. Delta State posted a 27-10 victory at UNA in 2006.

North Alabama leads the overall series, 30-23-1, but Delta State has claimed the last two contests. Before DSU's streak, UNA reeled off three in a row and has also won seven of the last 11. The Statesmen hold a slim 14-13-1 all-time edge at home over the Lions dating back to a 12-0 win in the first series meeting in 1960.

Delta State earned a First Round bye, returning to the post-season for the fifth time in the past six years. DSU hosts its second straight NCAA Playoff game since advancing to the 2010 NCAA Title Game via a 29-17 win over Shepherd a year ago. The Statesmen have fared well at home in playoff openers, topping Shaw in 2007, 45-7, and Tusculum in 2008, 27-19. DSU is 12-5 in its six previous NCAA Playoff appearances and has advanced to three Semi-Finals, two Finals and claimed the 2000 NCAA Title. They are 3-2 versus GSC foes in NCAA Playoff action.

North Alabama upped its post-season record to 29-13 a week ago via a 47-23 win over West Alabama. UNA qualified for its 17th all-time appearance and is a three-time NCAA Champion, claiming three straight crowns from 1993-95. The Lions have advanced to the Finals four times and the Semi-Finals nine times. They are 9-5 versus GSC foes in NCAA Playoff action.

Statistical Standouts: Delta State leads the league in scoring offense (34.1), total offense (471.7), total defense (330.7), rushing defense (132.1), pass defense (198.6) and sacks (3.00). North Alabama is No. 1 in scoring defense (18.7), pass efficiency (147.3) and pass defense efficiency (112.4).

A pair of Harlon Hill Trophy Finalists lead each team's offense. **DSU quarterback Micah Davis** is the reigning GSC Offensive Player of the Year and ranks first in the Conference in total offense (288.5) and second in passing (272.1) and passing touchdowns (19). **UNA signal caller Lee Chapple** is tops in passing (280.4), passing touchdowns (23) and pass efficiency (144.1) and also places second in total offense (279.7).

DSU running back Brandon Lucas is second in all purpose yards (150.5) and third in rushing (59.2). Teammate **Richard Freelon** is eighth in rushing (43.5), while **wide receiver Chance Dennis** is third in receptions (5.6) and fourth in receiving (69.4). **Defensive lineman Robbie Mayers** is the GSC sack leader (5.5), while **Dominic Davenport** is tied for tops in interceptions (four). **UNA running back Wes Holland** ranks sixth in rushing (52.9), while **wide out Tristan Purifoy** is third in receiving (69.5) and fourth in receptions (4.5).

GSC IN NCAA DIVISION II PLAYOFFS

A total of 19 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 93 wins during that span along with a .624 winning percentage (93-56). In fact, of the last 24 national champions, 10* have come from the GSC, seven from the North Central Conference, three from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (16) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). *--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.

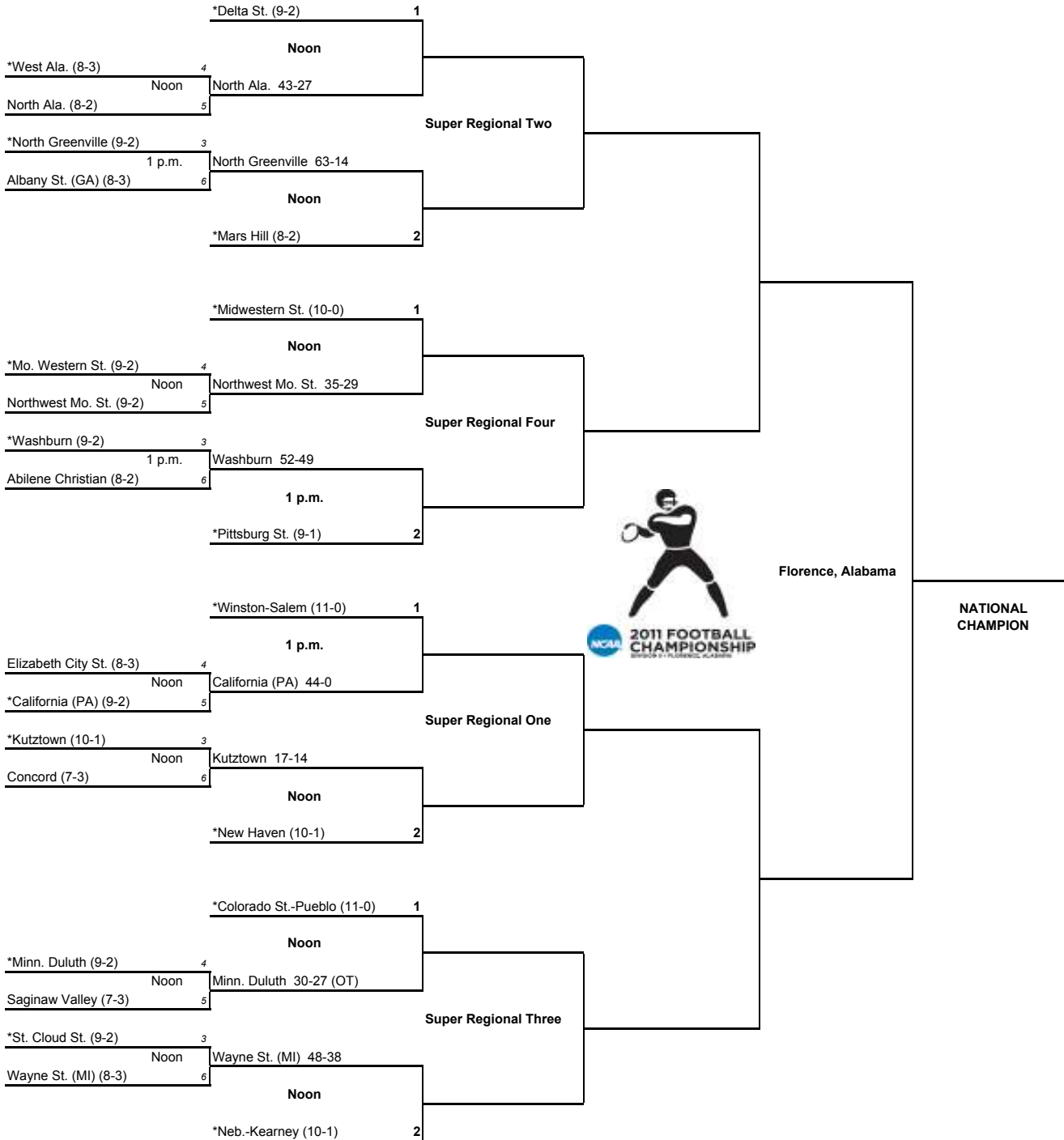
