2011 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

DELTA STATE ADVANCES TO NCAA FOOTBALL REGIONAL TITLE GAME

Birmingham, AL—For the 12th straight year, Gulf South Conference Football advanced at least one team to the NCAA Division II Playoff Quarter-Finals.

The GSC was assured a Regional Finalist as **No. 1 seed Delta State** hosted league rival **No. 5 seed North Alabama** on Saturday. DSU moved on to its fifth NCAA Quarter-Final contest thanks to its second win of the season over the Lions, 42-14. The triumph was the Statesmen's 13th all-time post-season victory and was also the 94th win for the Gulf South Conference in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

The Statesmen seek to advance to their second consecutive Semi-Final, hosting to No. 3 seed North Greenville on Saturday, December 3rd. Kickoff time is set for 1:00 pm Central.

@ #1 SEED DELTA STATE 42, #5 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 14 (NCAA PLAYOFFS--SECOND ROUND)

For the second straight year, **No. 1 seed Delta State** (10-2) ended **No. 5 seed North Alabama's** (9-3) season in the NCAA Division II Playoffs behind a 42-14 home victory.

DSU rallied from a seven-point deficit in the second quarter by reeling off 35 unanswered points. The Statesmen hit pay dirt on the game's opening drive when **wide receiver Chance Dennis** hauled in a 60-yard touchdown pass just 58 seconds into the going. UNA tied matters on its first offensive possession thanks to **running back Antwan Ivey's** two-yard TD jaunt at 8:26 and then grabbed a 14-7 edge after **Jason Smith's** 84-yard TD reception with 39 seconds left in the quarter.

Delta State ruled the rest of the game, extending its 21-14 halftime lead behind 21 points in the second half. **Quarterback Micah Davis** sneaked-in a one-yard touchdown at 6:15 in the second quarter and **Jacob Sesma** followed with a three-yard scoring catch at 2:30.

DSU marched 90 yards in 11 plays to collect a 28-14 edge at 8:31 in the third stanza thanks to **wide receiver Avery Horn's** 20-yard TD grab. **Running back Richard Freelon** added a four-yard touchdown run at 5:05 and **running back Brant Botill** capped the scoring, rumbling 19 yards for a TD with 13:47 left to play.

Davis completed 17-of-24 passes for 214 yards and three touchdowns, while also adding 29 yards on the ground. Botill led all players with 67 yards on 10 carries and Dennis led the squad with four receptions for 88 yards. Delta State took a 3-2 lead over North Alabama in NCAA post-season matchups via its second win of the season over the Lions. DSU claimed its 13th NCAA Playoff victory in 18 contests and the win was also the 94th by the GSC in the post-season. [Box score](#)

GSC Champion and No. 1 Super Region Two seed Delta State (10-2) hosts its second straight NCAA Division II Playoff contest when No. 3 seed and DII Independent North Greenville (11-2) journeys east to Cleveland for a first-ever battle.

DSU enters familiar territory, while NGU makes its first-ever appearance in the National Quarter-Finals. The Statesmen seek to defend their Super Region Two crown, making their fifth all-time Quarter-Final appearance in seven post-season appearances. Overall, Delta State holds a 13-5 Playoff record and seeks to return to the Title Game after falling short in 2010. DSU won it all in 2000 and also made the Semi-finals in 2006.

North Greenville has put together the best season in school history en route to its first-ever NCAA appearance. NGU has won nine in a row led by last week's 58-32 road win over No. 2 seed Mars Hill. The Crusaders are 5-2 on the road this year, while Delta State puts its 6-0 home mark on the line.

Delta State leads the Conference in total offense (479.4), punting (36.6) and sacks against (1.08) and is also third in scoring offense (33.7), pass offense (293.8), pass efficiency (144.8) and rushing offense (185.9). Albany State is No. 1 in the nation in scoring defense (11.55) and is also tops in the SIAC in passing offense (210.36), pass efficiency (166.16), rushing defense (59.18) and total offense (370.82).

Statistical Standouts: Delta State leads the GSC and is eighth in the nation in total offense (471.2). DSU is also tops in the Conference in scoring offense (34.8), total defense (328.0), rushing defense (124.8), pass efficiency defense (113.5) and sacks (3.00). North Greenville places seventh in the nation in scoring offense (41.48) and eighth in rushing offense (258.8).

Harlon Hill Trophy Finalists quarterback Micah Davis leads the Statesmen's offense. Davis ranks 11th nationally, first in the Conference, in total offense (285.8) and second in the GSC in passing (269.2) and passing touchdowns (22). DSU features three players in the GSC's Top 10 rushing list: **Brandon Lucas** (fifth, 58.0), **Brant Botill** (ninth, 43.4) and **Richard Freelon** (43.3). **Wide receiver Chance Dennis** is tops in touchdown catches (seven), third in receptions (5.5) and fourth in receiving (70.9).

GSC IN NCAA DIVISION II PLAYOFFS

A total of 19 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 94 wins during that span along with a .623 winning percentage (94-57). In fact, of the last 24 national champions, 10* have come from the GSC, seven from the North Central Conference, three from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (16) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). *--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.

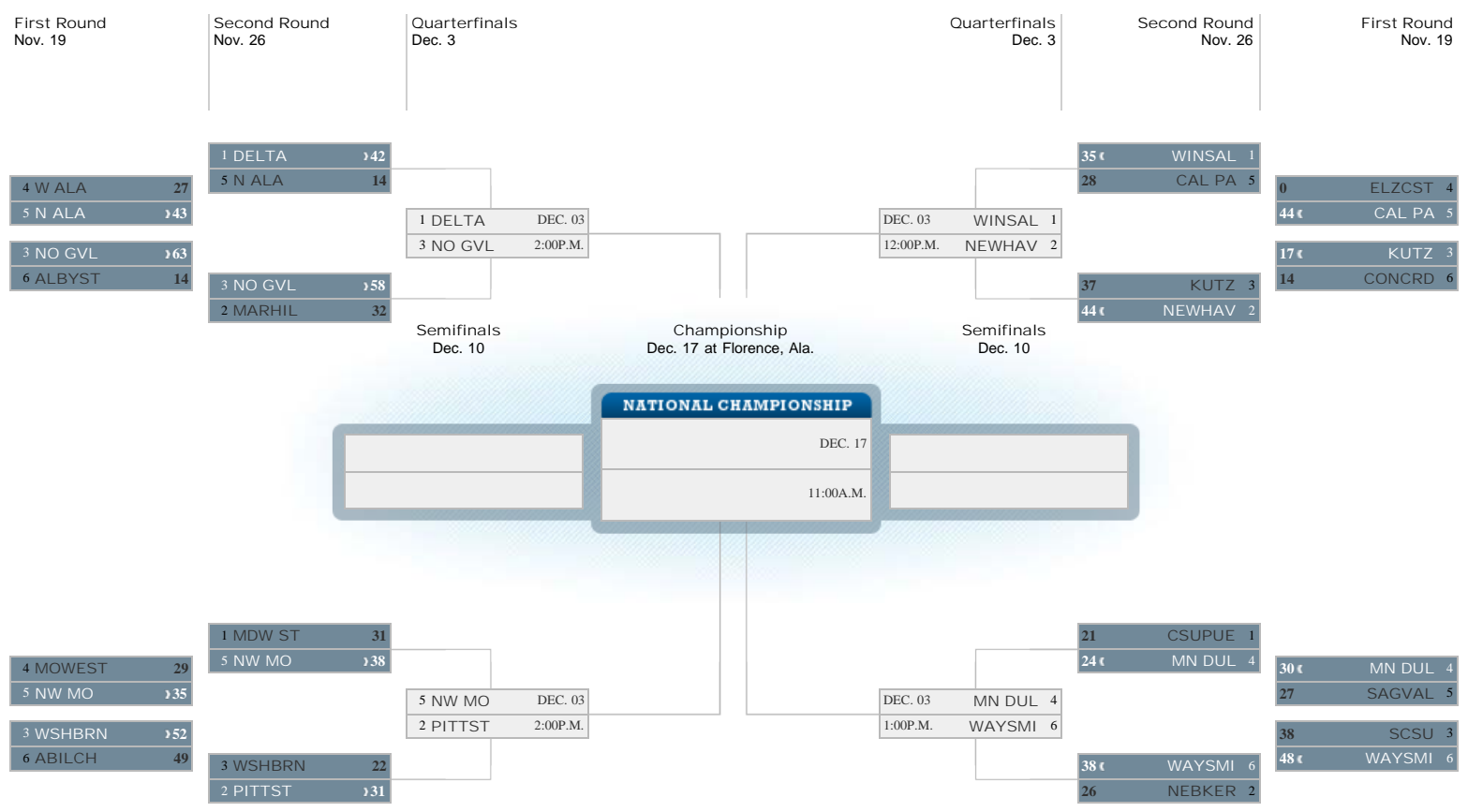
