2011 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

DELTA STATE WRAPS UP 2011 GSC FOOTBALL TITLE

Birmingham, AL—The 2011 Gulf South Conference Football Champion was crowned one week before the end of the regular season as **No. 1 Delta State** clinched its sixth all-time Crown.

DSU (9-1, 3-0) could not have picked a better weekend to wrap up the Title, thrilling its Homecoming faithful with a 36-34 triumph over then **No. 18 West Alabama** (7-3, 2-2). The Statesmen led by 29 points early in the third quarter before UWA mounted a furious comeback, cutting its deficit to two points with 1:35 left to play. The Tigers' two-point effort fell short and the Delta State defense batted down a Hail Mary pass as time expired, preserving the win.

DSU has won at least a share of four of the last five Conference Championships and **Head Coach Ron Roberts** became just the second coach in league history to lead a school to four GSC Titles (Jim Fuller, Jacksonville State, 1977-82). The Statesmen can wrap up the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Regional Playoffs with a win at **West Georgia** this Saturday. West Alabama completes its regular season by hosting Division I-FCS foe Georgia State.

North Alabama (7-2, 1-2) picked up its first Conference triumph of the year, easing past **West Georgia** (5-4, 1-2) at home, 28-3. UNA's win opened the door for Delta State's Title by handing UWG its second league loss of the season. The Lions' defense set the tone, holding the Wolves to 194 total yards and 81 yards through the air. North Alabama and **Valdosta State** face off in Valdosta this Saturday in a game that could determine each team's NCAA Playoff destinies.

2011 GSC FOOTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

WEEK 12

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama quarterback Lee Chapple (SR, 6-1, 190, Alpharetta, GA).

Chapple collects his second award of the season, third of his career, after guiding the Lions to their first Conference win of the season at home over West Georgia, 28-3. The senior completed 17-of-31 passes for a 55.8 percentage, while throwing for 189 yards and three touchdowns. The Alpharetta, GA native provided all the points UNA needed at 1:26 in the first quarter via a 10-yard TD pass to Jason Smith. He followed with two more coring strikes in the second frame, including a 25-yarder and a two-yarder as time expired in the first half.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama linebacker Tommie Westbrook (SR, 6-2, 235, Chicago, IL).

Westbrook is the second UNA linebacker to win honors this season, leading a Lions' defense which held UWG to three points and 194 yards of total offense. The senior racked up a team-high 10 tackles led by six solo stops. The Chicago, IL native was also involved in two of North Alabama's seven tackles for loss, recording 1.5 for a loss of four yards.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State punter Andrew Jones (JR, 6-0, 185, Corinth, MS).

Jones earns his second laurel in three weeks leading Delta State's punt and kickoff squads in a 36-34 Homecoming victory over No. 18 West Alabama. The junior helped to hold UWA to minus-six punt return yards, booming five balls for 222 yards and a 44.4 average. The Corinth, MS native placed three punts inside the Tigers' 20-yard line and his longest kick went for 56 yards. He also connected on six kickoffs for 332 yards (55.3 average).

@ #1 DELTA STATE 36, #18 WEST ALABAMA 34 (HOMECOMING)

No. 1 Delta State (9-1, 3-0) clinched its fourth GSC Title in five seasons, outlasting **No. 18 West Alabama** (7-3, 2-2) in Homecoming action, 36-34.

DSU dominated the first 40 minutes of the game, building a 36-7 lead early in the third quarter. The Statesmen opened the game by scoring 30 unanswered points in the first half. Delta State was awarded two points just 1:48 into the game when **UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell** was flagged for intentional grounding in the Tigers' own end zone.

DSU wide receiver Bill Franks posted an eight-yard rushing touchdown at 10:50 in the first quarter and **quarterback Micah Davis** added an eight-yard TD run of his own at 3:42. **Wide out Chance Dennis** opened the second stanza with a six-yard scoring reception just 58 seconds into the quarter, while **Dwight Tillman** returned an interception 40 yards for a touchdown at 11:15. West Alabama closed out the first half with its first points of the game via **running back Matt Willis'** two-yard jaunt with 7:06 remaining.

DSU pushed its advantage to 36-7 at 11:03 in the third quarter, but UWA's offense caught fire from there. Willis ran for a one-yard TD at 7:46 in the third frame and followed with another one-yarder at 14:02 in the fourth quarter. Caldwell made the score 36-28 at 11:50 after a 27-yard scoring run before **running back Don Smith** brought the Tigers within two points via an 18-yard run with 1:35 left to play. West Alabama attempted to tie the score on the two-point try, but Caldwell's shovel pass was knocked down.

Davis completed 27-of-39 passes for 272 yards and two touchdowns, while **Lavon Downs** caught seven passes for a game-high 77 yards. Willis ran for a game-best 101 yards and three scores on 30 carries in a losing effort. Delta State ran its winning streak at home versus UWA to five and is now 34-20-3 all-time. [Box score](#)

@ #17 NORTH ALABAMA 28, WEST GEORGIA 3

No. 17 North Alabama (7-2, 1-2) notched its first GSC victory of the season, using 21 unanswered points to cruise past **West Georgia** (5-4, 1-2) at home, 28-3.

UNA posted the lone score in the first quarter when **Jason Smith** hauled-in a 10-yard touchdown pass at 1:26. UWG pulled within four points just nine seconds into the second frame via **Davis Brackett's** 21-yard field goal, only to see the Lions close the half with two more TDs. **Wide out Mo Miliam** caught a 25-yard score at 14:33 and **wide receiver Tristan Purifoy** grabbed a two-yard touchdown with just two ticks on the clock. **North Alabama running back Chris Coffey** provided the lone score in the second half, plowing-in a one-yard TD at 5:31 in the third stanza.

UNA signal caller Lee Chapple completed 17-of-31 passes for 189 yards and three touchdowns, while Miliam led all players with eight receptions for 108 yards. **Running back Wes Holland** racked up a game-best 154 yards on 27 carries. The Lions ran their winning streak versus West Georgia to seven and are 10-4-0 at home in the series. [Box score](#)
