2010 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

DELTA STATE SET TO HOST NCAA FOOTBALL PLAYOFF SEMIFINAL

Birmingham, AL—For the eighth time in nine seasons, the Gulf South Conference advanced a squad to the NCAA Division II Football Playoff Semi-Finals.

GSC Champion and Super Region 2 No. 2 seed Delta State (10-3) moved on to its first final four since 2006, upsetting No. 1 seed Albany State this past Saturday, 28-7. DSU stormed back from an early 7-0 deficit to hand ASU its first loss of the season thanks to 21 second-half points. The Statesmen advanced to their third overall NCAA Semi-Final round dating back to 2000. The GSC has now placed a team in the Semi-Finals 27 times since 1975 and seeks to place a team in the Title game for the 16th overall time.

Next up for Delta State is Super Region 1 Champion Shepherd University (12-1). DSU defends Parker Field at McCool Stadium this Saturday at 1:00 pm Central in a game that will be televised by CBS College Sports (check your local listings for availability). The DSU/SU winner will move to the Championship Game versus the victor of the Northwest Missouri State at Minnesota Duluth contest. The NCAA Title Game will be held at Braly Municipal Stadium in Florence, AL and will be televised on ESPN2 at 10:00 a.m.

#2 SEED DELTA STATE 28, @ #1 SEED ALBANY STATE 7 (NCAA QUARTER-FINALS)

GSC Tri-Champion Champion and No. 2 seed Delta State reeled off 28 unanswered points en route to a 28-7 upset at No. 1 seed Albany State in the NCAA Super Region 2 Title game. DSU advanced to the its first NCAA DII Semi-Final since 2006 by handing ASU its first loss of the season.

The Golden Rams thrilled their home crowd, grabbing a 7-0 lead on the game's opening possession. The Statesmen's defense set up the game-tying score, returning an interception to ASU's 23-yard line followed by wide receiver LJ Castille's 12-yard touchdown grab at 4:33 in the first frame.

The score remained tied heading into halftime, but Delta State took advantage of Albany State turnovers to reel-off 21 points in the second half. Running back Trevar Deed ran in the go-ahead TD at 13:18 in third frame and then added a six-yard scoring catch at 5:12. Running back Brandon Lucas capped the scoring at 8:03 in the final stanza, running for a 12-yard TD.

Lucas led all players with 80 yards on the ground on nine carries, while Deed added 74 total yards and two touchdowns. Quarterback Micah Davis completed 20-of-27 passes for a game-high 186 yards. Delta State handed the SIAC Champions their first loss of the season in the first-ever meeting between the two schools. **Box score**

Super Region 2 Champion Delta State seeks to move on to the NCAA Division II Title Game for just the second time in school history when it hosts Super Region 1 Champion Shepherd this Saturday.

No. 2 seed DSU took home the regional title this past weekend, upsetting No. 1 seed Albany State, 28-7. SU is the surprise of the NCAA Playoff field this season, claiming its regional crown as a No. 4 seed after topping Mercyhurst on the road, 49-14. Shepherd is the first-ever West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference member to make the Semi-Finals and its 12 overall victories are the most in school and conference history.

The Statesmen made it to the final four for the third overall time. Delta State hosted a Semi-Final battle in 2000, topping North Dakota State, 34-16, en route to its first-ever NCAA Title. DSU advance to the Semi-Finals in 2006, suffering a 49-30 loss at Grand Valley State. The Statesmen are the first GSC team to host a Semi-Final clash since North Alabama in 2005 (25-24 loss to Northwest Missouri State). DSU is 11-4 all-time in its six post-season berths.

Delta State leads the GSC in total offense (469.3) and punting (37.8) and is also third in scoring offense (33.2), pass offense (286.0), pass efficiency (144.7) and rushing offense (183.3). Shepherd is No. 1 in the WVIAC in scoring defense (21.00), rushing defense (83.8) and interceptions (five).

DSU quarterback Micah Davis ranks second in the GSC in passing touchdowns (28) and pass efficiency (145.2), third in passing (281.6) and fourth in total offense (295.8). **Running back Trevar Deed** is tied for first with 11 rushing TDs and is third in rushing (76.7). **Brandon Lucas** also has 11 rushing scores and is seventh in rushing (57.0). **Wide out Chance Dennis** is eighth in receiving (59.2), while **LJ Castille** is second with 10 TD catches. Maurice Moore is second in all purpose yards (132.8). SU running back Tommy Addison is second in the WVIAC in rushing (125.4). Quarterback Kevin Clancy is fourth in passing (212.8) and total offense (207.8).

GSC IN NCAA DIVISION II PLAYOFFS

A total of 19 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 91 wins during that span along with a .628 winning percentage (91-54). In fact, of the last 23 national champions, 10* have come from the GSC, seven from the North Central Conference, three from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (15) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). *--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.
