## 2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

### UWA, UNA REMAIN TIED ATOP GSC LEAGUE STANDINGS

**Birmingham, AL**—In-state rivals **West Alabama** and **North Alabama** remained tied for first-place in GSC Football after the second week of league action.

No. 19 UWA (4-1, 2-0) posted its second straight victory over a Peach State foe, squeaking past **West Georgia** (2-2, 0-1) at home, 24-20. The Tigers trailed UWG on three occasions during the first half, but they outscored the Wolves in the second half, 7-3, en route to victory. **Running back Matt Willis** became *the school's all-time leading rusher*, exiting the night with 2,141 yards.

UNA (4-1, 2-0) celebrated Homecoming by spoiling future GSC member **Shorter's** (2-3, 0-1) first Conference-countable contest, 41-0. The Lions hit for the most points in a game this season led by 21 unanswered in the second quarter.

**Valdosta State** (3-2, 1-0) and **Delta State** (1-3, 0-1) rounded out last week's matchups, as each hosted non-conference tilts. VSU cruised to a 58-10 win over NAIA Edward Waters, rushing for 352 yards along with a *school-record tying seven touchdown runs*. DSU did not have the same good fortune as VSU, falling to Abilene Christian in Thursday night's GSC-TV Game of the Week, 34-28. The Statesmen out-gained ACU offensively, 498-320, but the hosts committed key turnovers on their own side of the field in the loss.

**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**North Alabama quarterback Chris Alexander** (JR, 6-0, 190, Lake Butler, LA).

Alexander is the first UNA Offensive honoree of the season, while also posting his first-ever award by leading the Lions to a 41-0 home triumph over Shorter. The junior completed 9-of-10 passes for 126 yards and one touchdown, while also running for another TD on one of his five carries. The Lake Butler, LA native scored what proved to be the game-winning touchdown via a four-yard run at 13:23 in the first frame and his 33-yard TD strike extended the lead to 21-0 with just 1:43 left in the first half.

**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama defensive back Malcolm Butler** (JR, 5-11, 180, Vicksburg, MS).

Butler is UWA's second straight Defensive honoree after duplicating last week's winner, Otha Foster, by nabbing three interceptions in a 24-20 home victory over West Georgia. The junior tyed the school-record for interceptions in a game and he also became just the 10th GSC player to accomplish the feat. The Vicksburg, MS native did not stop there, racking up five solo tackles and breaking up three more passes, headlined by a break up on fourth down which sealed the win at 1:04 in the fourth quarter.

**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**UWA punter Jordan Ikner** (FR, 6-4, 230, Alabaster, AL).

West Alabama provided the Special Teams honoree for the second week in a row after freshman punter Jordan Ikner led UWA's special teams unit against West Georgia. The Alabaster, AL native booted six punts for 293 yards and a 48.8 average. Ikner also dropped three punts inside UWG's 20-yard line and he boomed a career-long 61 yarder.

The 2012 GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge takes center stage with three inter-conference contests on this week's slate. Both leagues have tallied victories in the first two games of the series as Valdosta State topped Angelo State as part of the Lone Star Football Festival and Abilene Christian defeated Delta State in last Thursday's GSC-TV clash.

Leading the way this week is Thursday night's GSC-TV Game of the Week which pits No. 13 **Midwestern State** at **No. 18 West Alabama**. The game will be shown live by **CSS**, **Mediacom, TV-24** and **ESPN3** and on a tape-delay basis by **CoxSports** (Oct. 5 at Noon) and the **Alabama Cable Network** (Oct. 6 at 7:00 pm).

A pair of Peach State contests and two more GSC-LSC matchups headline Saturday's tilt. Homecoming hosts **West Georgia** locks horns with in-state rival **Valdosta State** in the 29th all-time meeting between the GSC rivals. Future GSC member **Shorter** returns home seeking to snap a two-game skid against in-state NAIA foe Point. **Delta State** and **North Alabama** each hit the road to test Lone Star Conference foes. **DSU** goes to Tarleton State, while **UNA** journeys to Texas A&M-Kingsville.

GSC-TV features a nationally ranked matchup for the first time this season when **No. 18 West Alabama** hosts No. 13 **Midwestern State** on Thursday night. The game is also part of the 2012 GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge which consists of 10 inter-conference games during the season.

UWA can even its all-time GSC-TV record which stands at 7-8. The Tigers have claimed three straight dating back to 2010 and went 2-0 in 2011. West Alabama and MSU lock horns for the first time ever and the Tigers are just 3-5 all-time versus Texas foes. UWA defeated LSC member Tarleton State at home a year ago, 42-35. West Alabama is 2-0 at home this season, while the Mustangs are 2-1 away from their home stable.

**Statistical Standouts:** West Alabama leads the GSC in total defense (254.6), rushing defense (114.0), pass defense (140.6) and pass efficiency defense (82.2). Conversely, **Midwestern State** is tops in the LSC in scoring offense (42.3), total offense (496.3) and rushing offense (314.3).

**West Alabama running back Matt Willis** places first in the Conference in rushing (110.4), rushing touchdowns (four) and all purpose yards (133.0). **Ryne Smith** currently *holds the NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (20) and he is also No. 1 in the nation in field goals (2.40)*. **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** is third in passing (139.0) and fourth in total offense (148.8). **Back up signal caller Gary Johnston** is eighth in rushing (52.2). **MSU running back Keidrick Jackson** is No. 1 in the LSC in rushing (82.7) and scoring (12.0).

Peach State GSC rivals **West Georgia** and **Valdosta State** clash in Carrollton for the second consecutive season.

Both squads seek to notch their first league victory of the season and UWG hopes to celebrate its Homecoming with its second straight win over VSU. The Wolves put the brakes on a five-game skid against the Blazers a year ago in thrilling fashion, 23-20, when wide receiver V.J. Hunt caught the game-winning touchdown with just five seconds remaining. Valdosta State owns a 19-9-0 all-time edge and is 10-3 in Carrollton dating back to 1985. West Georgia is 2-0 at University Stadium this year, while VSU is 1-1 on the road.

**Statistical Standouts:** Valdosta State is tops in the Conference in scoring offense (43.0), total offense (478.4), pass offense (244.8) and pass efficiency (144.7), while West Georgia ranks second in those same categories (scoring offense, 37.5; total offense, 41.2; pass offense, 203.8; pass efficiency, 125.2).

**VSU wide receiver Gerald Ford** is No. 1 in receiving (111.5), receptions (6.2), touchdown catches (seven) and scoring (10.5). **Freshman running backs Austin Scott** and **Cedric O'Neal** and place second (82.8) and third (80.8) in rushing, respectively. **VSU quarterbacks Cayden Cochran** (167.5) and **Graham Craig** (131.4) are third and sixth, respectively, in total offense. **UWG signal caller Austin Trainor** places second in passing (150.0) and total offense (184.5), while teammate **Dallas Dickey** ranks first in pass efficiency (194.6). **Running back Seth Hinsley** lists fourth in rushing (74.0) and **wide out Bobby Burum** is No. 3 in receptions (4.2) and receiving (71.2).

**Delta State** hits the road for just the second time this season, facing its second Lone Star Conference foe in as many weeks when the Statesmen journey west to Tarleton State.

DSU fell at home to Abilene Christian in GSC-TV action last Thursday, 34-28, while TSU also seeks to rebound from a setback last week. The matchup also marks one of two GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge battles on Saturday. The school's face off for the first time ever, but Delta State is 2-4 against current LSC members. GSC member West Alabama topped the Texans at home a year ago, 42-35.

**Statistical Standouts:** Delta State is second in the GSC in total defense (279.5), rushing defense (123.0), pass defense (156.5) and pass defense efficiency (105.9). The Statesmen also lead the nation in kickoff returns (32.4). **Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden** is tops in the Conference in total offense (262.2) and passing (191.0) and sixth in rushing (71.2). His top targets are **Levon Downs** (No. 2 in receptions, 5.2; No. 4 in receiving, 57.0) and **Kevin Jackson** (No. 2 in receiving, 81.2; No. 4 in receptions, 3.8).

The squad's match up for the fifth time, but Saturday's clash marks the first since 1997. UNA is a perfect 4-0 against the Javelinas, including a 24-7 triumph in Kingsville in 1996. The remaining four contests took place in Florence, including the first two in the NCAA Playoffs. North Alabama won in 1993, 27-25, and in 1994, 16-10, before closing the series in 1997, 17-12. UNA has won three straight decisions, while TAMUK has lost three in a row. The Lions are 2-0 on the road in 2012, while the Javelinas are 1-1 in Javelina Stadium. North Alabama also puts its 5-0 record against Lone Star Conference members on the line.

**Statistical Standouts:** North Alabama ranks first in the GSC in scoring defense (14.6) and rushing offense (255.6). **Freshman running back Lamonte Thompson** is fifth in rushing (72.0) and **quarterback Chris Alexander** is fifth in total offense (135.4) and sixth in passing (78.8).

SU has dropped its last two contests, including last week's GSC opener at North Alabama. Before that, the Hawks nearly upset Division I-FCS Charleston Southern at home, 23-20. Point University is winless so far this season with one of the losses coming at West Georgia, 55-3.

**@ #19 WEST ALABAMA 24, WEST GEORGIA 20**

**No. 19 West Alabama** (4-1, 2-0) used an efficient rushing attack and four interceptions to clip **West Georgia** (2-2, 0-1) at home, 24-20.

UWG's defense opened the scoring at 9:23 in the first quarter when **Donovan Jackson** returned a fumble 35 yards for a touchdown. **UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell** knotted the score, thanks to a seven-yard TD run at 3:07, only to see Wolves' **place-kicker Davis Brackett's** boot a 20-yard field goal at 12:33 in the second stanza. The rivals traded rushing scores midway through the quarter after **Tigers' running back Matt Willis** galloped for a four-yarder at 9:54 and **West Georgia's Quan Jones** followed with a nine-yarder at 7:01. West Alabama tied matters heading into the locker room behind **Ryne Smith's** 25-yard field goal with one second on the clock.

Defense ruled the second half as the squad's combined for just 10 points. **Quan Fletcher** gave West Alabama a 24-17 edge at 3:46 in the third frame, and UWG pulled within four points via Brackett's 31-yard field goal. The Wolves drove to midfield on their final offensive possession, but UWA sealed the win with a pass breakup on fourth down.

Willis was held to 86 yards on 12 carries, but the total was enough to make him the all-time leading rusher in West Alabama history (2,141 yards). Smith stretched his *consecutive field goal mark to a NCAA Record 20* dating back to October, 2011. West Alabama won its third in a row over West Georgia, fifth in the last seven meetings. **@ NORTH ALABAMA 41, SHORTER 0 (HOMECOMING)**

**North Alabama** (4-1, 2-0) pitched its second shutout in three games, blanking future GSC member **Shorter** (2-3, 0-1) in Homecoming action, 41-0.

Neither team lit the scoreboard in the first quarter, but UNA hit for 21 points in the second quarter. **Quarterback Chris Alexander** ran four yards for what proved to be the game-winning touchdown at 13:23. **Luke Wingo** added a three-year scoring run at 3:58 and **Melvin Harris** collected a 33-yard TD pass with 1:43 left in the first half.

The Lions' dominance continued in the second 30 minutes, thanks to three more touchdown scampers. Lamar Smith ran-in a seven-yard TD at 7:59 in the third stanza, followed by Wingo's one-yard jaunt at 4:28. **Diamond Simmons** closed the scoring, reeling of an 80-yard TD run with just 2:35 left to play.

North Alabama rolled up 436 yards of total offense, led by Alexander who completed 9-of-10 passes for 126 yards. Simmons rank for a game-best 123 yards on seven carries, while Wingo contributed 47 yards on 15 attempts. [Box score](#)

**@ VALDOSTA STATE 58, EDWARD WATERS 10**

**Valdosta State** (3-2) rolled up 352 yards rushing en route to a 58-10 home blowout of NAIA Edward Waters.

VSU crossed the goal line on the game's opening possession when **running back Cedric O'Neal** ran for a five-yard touchdown at 11:31. EWC pulled within four points after a field goal at the five-minute mark, but the Blazers took over from there, compiling 17 unanswered points.

**Quarterback Cayden Cochran** sneaked-in a one-yard TD with 2:17 left and **Reginald Lewis** added a 21-yard scoring rush as time expired in the first frame. Edward Waters made the score, 24-10, with 4:51 remaining in the first half, but the Blazers answered before halftime thanks to **Seantavious Jones'** 12-yard touchdown reception at 1:36. Valdosta State kept its foot on the throttle in the second half, outscoring the Tigers, 27-0.

VSU tied a school record with seven rushing touchdowns and scored its most points in a game since tallying 70 points against EWC in 2009. Cochran combined for 243 total yards and three touchdowns, including 70 yards rushing. **Running back Austin Scott** led all players with 97 yards on 10 carries and O'Neal added 71 yards on 10 attempts. **@ DELTA STATE 34, ABILENE CHRISTIAN 28 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)**

**Delta State** (1-3) fell to 0-3 at home this season after surrendering a 34-28 decision to Lone Star Conference member Abilene Christian (3-2) in the GSC-TV Game of the Week. The matchup also marked Game Two of the 10-game, GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge.

ACU took a 10-0 lead in the first five minutes of action by taking advantage of a pair of DSU turnovers, but the Statesmen claimed a 14-10 edge at 12:18 in the second quarters. **Running back Brant Botill** pounded-in a two-yard TD at 13:46, while **Kevin Jackson** hauled-in a 57-yard scoring strike at 12:18. The squads traded touchdowns at 7:41 and 6:51, but Abilene Christian led at the break, 24-21.

An ACU field goal at 9:29 in the third quarter advance the lead to 27-21, only to see Delta State grab a one-point edge when **Reed Faulkner** caught a 17-yard score at 5:40. The Wildcats retook a six-point lead just six seconds into the final frame and the Statesmen could not record the go-ahead touchdown on their final possession which ended at the ACU 12-yard line.

**DSU quarterback Trevor Wooden** completed 14-of-25 passes for 260 yards and also led all rushers with 88 yards on 18 carries. Jackson caught five passes for a game-best 131 yards. The loss marked the Statesmen's third straight at home for the first time since 1997. [Box score](#)

**2012 GSC RECORD BREAKERS**

**Valdosta State's Quin Roberson** tied the GSC record for longest punt return in a game, reeling off a 94-yard touchdown return versus Forth Valley State. Arkansas-Monticello's Jywin Ceasar also returned a 94-yarder for a TD in 2010.

**North Alabama's Michael Schuster** tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game, hitting 5-of-6 attempts in UNA's 39-0 win over Kentucky Christian.

**West Alabama's Ryne Smith** set the NCAA and GSC record for consecutive field goals after going 4-for-4 on September 22 at Valdosta State. Smith has booted 20 straight field goals since October 2011, snapping the previous NCAA mark of 17 and the GSC record of 15 (SAU's Jason Williams in 1998).
