2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

VSU, DSU PICK UP KEY GSC FOOTBALL CONFERENCE VICTORIES

Birmingham, AL—Valdosta State and Delta State notched Gulf South Conference league triumphs last week, while the Conference also went 2-0 against non-conference foes.

VSU handed **North Alabama** its first league setback of the season thanks to its second straight road win over a GSC foe. The Blazers grabbed a 24-0 lead in the third quarter before holding off a furious Lions' comeback en route to a 24-21 win in Florence.

DSU celebrated its first home victory of the season, scoring 20 points in the fourth quarter, securing a 33-24 triumph over **West Georgia**. The Statesmen entered the fourth quarter, trailing 17-13, but quarterback Trevor Wooden generated three touchdowns led by two rushing scores.

West Alabama faced its second straight non-conference foe at home on Saturday, easing past the College of Faith, 73-6. Future GSC member **Shorter** recorded its second home victory over a NAIA team in as many weeks, topping Ave Maria, 37-7.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden (JR, 6-2, 225, High Springs, FL).

Wooden captures his second consecutive award after leading the Statesmen to a 33-24, come-from-behind home victory over West Georgia. The junior sparked DSU to victory thanks to 20 fourth-quarter points. The High Springs, FL native completed 15-of-21 passes for 154 yards and one TD, while also running for 93 yards and three scores on 21 carries. He scored what proved to be the go-ahead touchdown scamper from 20 yards out just seven seconds into final frame and capped the contest via a one-yard score with 1:35 left to play.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State linebacker Chris Pope (JR, 6-1, 216, Jackson, GA).

Pope earned his second all-time honor, first this season, after spearheading VSU's defense in a 24-21 triumph at North Alabama. The junior racked up a game-high 11 total tackles, including a game-best eight solo stops. His eight solo tackles were the most for him in a game this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State punter/placekicker Daniel Andersen (SR, 6-0, 182, Meansville, GA).

Andersen collects his third career accolade dating back to 2010. The senior excelled at both placekicker and punter for the Blazers in their 24-21 road win over North Alabama. The Meansville, GA native kicked six punts for 249 yards (41.5 average) led by a 56-yarder and three punts downed inside the Lions' 20-yard line. Andersen did not stop there, nailing a 51-yard field goal which extended VSU's lead to 10-0 in the first quarter. The field goal was the longest in the GSC this season.

Three Conference games dominate this week's slate, starting with Thursday night's GSC-TV battle between **North Alabama** and **West Georgia** in Carrollton, GA. The game will be shown live by **CSS, Mediacom, TV-24** and **ESPN3** and on a tape-delay basis by **CoxSports** (Oct. 19 at Noon) and the **Alabama Cable Network** (Oct. 20 at 7:00 pm).

Two more league clashes continue on Saturday, led by the second television game when **West Alabama** hosts Homecoming and future GSC member **Shorter** at 3:30 pm. The game will be shown live by **CSS, Mediacom, TV-24** and **ESPN3, ESPN Game Plan** and on a tape-delay basis by CoxSports (Oct. 23 at Noon). Another Homecoming battle wraps up Saturday's slate as **Delta State** travels to **Valdosta State**.

West Georgia hosts its second GSC-TV telecast of the season when league rival **North Alabama** enters University Stadium on Thursday night.

UWG is 1-0 on TV this year after the Wolves topped Tusculum on September 8th, 38-29, while UNA performs in front of the camera for the first time this season. The Lions are 7-6 all-time in GSC-TV contests, while West Georgia stands at 4-9. North Alabama has history on its side, owning a 19-10 series lead thanks to seven consecutive victories. UNA also owns the edge on the road, going 9-for-15 in Carrollton behind five consecutive triumphs over UWG. The Lions are 2-0 away from Florence this year and UWG is 2-1 at home.

Statistical Standouts: North Alabama ranks first in scoring defense (16.1) and fourth in rushing offense (220.7), rushing defense (169.3), pass defense (189.1) and total defense (358.4). West Georgia is No. 3 in scoring offense (30.4) and No. 4 in pass offense (160.5) and total offense (366.0). The Wolves also lead Division II in fumble lost (0.00).

Freshman running back Lamonte Thompson ranks third in rushing (77.4) and tenth in total offense (77.4). **Quarterback Chris Alexander** is sixth in total offense (104.4) and sixth in passing (63.6) and tenth in rushing (40.9). **UWG signal caller Austin Trainor** places third in total offense (152.6) and passing (125.2). **Running back Seth Hinsley** lists fifth in rushing (58.5) and **wide out Bobby Burum** is No. 3 in receptions (3.67, tied) and receiving (56.0).

West Alabama hosts its second straight GSC telecast, welcoming future member **Shorter** to Tiger Stadium in the sixth GSC-TV game of the season and its 2012 Homecoming.

UWA seeks to rebound for a loss in the October 4th telecast, which it surrendered to Lone Star Conference foe Midwestern State, 42-27. The Tigers are 7-9 in GSC-TV games, while Shorter hits the airwaves for the first time ever. The squads have met once previously when West Alabama defeated Shorter, 37-7, on neutral ground in Demopolis, AL.

Statistical Standouts: West Alabama leads the GSC in rushing offense (237.4), rushing defense (138.4), pass defense (114.6) and total defense (253.0). Shorter enters Saturday averaging 23.6 points per game and 384.3 yards offense, while allowing 318.3 yards per game.

UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell places third in the league in pass efficiency (137.9), fourth in total offense (127.9) and fifth in passing (118.4). **Back-up signal caller Gary Johnston** is tied for sixth in rushing (53.1) along with running back Danny Hobbs. **Ryne Smith** currently holds the NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (22) and he is also No. 1 in the nation in field goals (2.33). **SU quarterback Eric Dodson** is averaging 67.9 rushing yards and 93.9 passing yards. **Running back Bradley Moon** has compiled a team-high 661 yards on 120 attempts.

Valdosta State seeks to successfully cap its Homecoming when rival **Delta State** comes to Valdosta.

DSU has history on its side when it steps on the field at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium, owning an 18-12-1 all-time lead thanks to six straight triumphs dating back to 2006. The Statesmen have also made themselves at home at VSU, going 9-for-14 led by three straight wins. Valdosta State has won three in a row, while Delta State has claimed back-to-back wins. The Statesmen are 2-0 away from Cleveland and the Blazers are 2-1 at home in 2012.

Statistical Standouts: Valdosta State is best in the Conference in scoring offense (40.1), pass offense (238.6) and total offense (474.6). Delta State is second in rushing defense (139.5), pass offense (190.2), total offense (414.0), pass defense (166.0) and total defense (305.5).

Delta State quarterback **Trevor Wooden** leads the league in total offense (267.7) and passing (190.2) and is second in rushing (77.5). His top targets are **Levon Downs** (No. 2 in receptions, 4.5; No. 4 in receiving, 52.2) and **Kevin Jackson** (No. 2 in receiving, 71.2; No. 3 in receptions, 3.67). **VSU** wide receiver **Gerald Ford** is No. 1 in receiving (101.7), receptions (5.7) and touch-down catches (nine). **Quarterback Graham Craig** is tops in pass efficiency (171.1), while **Cayden Cochran** is second in passing (147.0) and total offense (180.2). **Freshman running back Austin Scott** is No. 1 in rushing (91.9) and **freshman Cedric O'Neal** is fourth (75.2).

VALDOSTA STATE 24, @ NORTH ALABAMA 21

Valdosta State (5-2, 2-1) scored on its opening possession and did not trail the rest of the way, snapping **North Alabama's** (5-2, 2-1) four-game winning streak, 24-21.

VSU struck quickly in its first offensive possession when **wide receiver Gerald Ford** collected an 81-yard touchdown pass at 12:54. **Daniel Andersen** followed with a career-long, 51-yard field goal at 1:48 in the first frame and **quarterback Cayden Cochran** stretched the score to 17-0 before halftime after a one-yard TD sneak at 3:05 in the second quarter.

The Blazers' offense picked up where they left off in the third quarter when **wide out Seantavious Jones** grabbed a 71-yard touchdown just 37 seconds into the going. UNA did not give up, scoring the game's final 21 points. **Running back Lamonte Thompson** sprinted for a seven-yard TD at 7:07 in the third quarter. **Jason Smith's** nine-yard touchdown reception cut the deficit to 10 at 8:25 in the final frame and **quarterback Luke Wingo** added an eight-yard TD scamper with 3:56 left to play. Valdosta State's offense converted on a key third-and-five situation on the following possession, cinching the result for the Blazers.

Cochran completed 16-of-28 passes for 236 yards and two TDs, while Ford caught six balls for a game-high 134 yards. VSU put the brakes on a two-game skid against North Alabama thanks to its second win in a row in Florence. [Box score](#)

@ DELTA STATE 33, WEST GEORGIA 24

Delta State (3-3, 1-1) collected its first home and GSC victories of the season, outscoring **West Georgia** (2-4, 0-3) in the fourth quarter, 20-7, on its way to a 33-24 victory.

DSU ran out to a 13-0 advantage after a five-yard touchdown run by **quarterback Trevor Wooden** at 4:58 in the first quarter and **Justin McArthur's** 13-yard TD scamper at 12:07 in the second frame. UWG cut its deficit to 13-7 before halftime thanks to quarterback Dallas Dickey's seven-yard score at 5:54.

The Wolves dominated the third quarter, grabbing a 17-13 lead after **Davis Brackett's** 48-yard field goal at 11:05 and **running back David Bailey's** 29-yard touchdown run at 3:35. Delta State took control for good during the final 15 minutes hitting for 13 straight points. Wooden ran for a 20-yard TD just seven seconds into the fourth quarter and **wide receiver Kevin Jackson** hauled in a 14-yard scoring strike at 6:31. West Georgia pulled within two points when Bailey ran for a four-yard touchdown at 3:21, but Wooden closed the door for good after a one-yard scoring sneak at 1:35.

Wooden accounted for 247 yards of total offense, completing 15-of-21 passes for 154 yards and adding 93 yards on the ground on a game-high 21 carries. **Running back Brant Botill** added a team-high 101 yards on just 12 carries, while **Lavon Downs** led all players with 41 yards receiving. Delta State ran its all-time edge against UWG to 18-8. [Box score](#)

VALDOSTA STATE 42, @ WEST GEORGIA 7 (HOMECOMING)

Valdosta State (4-2, 1-1) picked up its first GSC win in grand fashion, blowing past in-state rival **West Georgia** (2-3, 0-2) at UWG's Homecoming, 42-7.

Neither team lit the scoreboard in the first quarter, only to see VSU reel-off 42 unanswered points. The Blazers' caught fire in the second frame, scoring 21 points starting with **wide receiver Gerald Ford's** six-yard touchdown grab at 14:19. **Wide out Seantavious Jones** collected a six-yard TD pass at 2:24, while **running back Austin Scott** ran for a 27-yarder at 1:18.

Scott accounted for the first two Valdosta State scores in the third quarter, finding the end zone from two yards out at 10:58 and adding a six-yarder at 5:12. **Quin Roberson** closed out the Blazers' streak with 11:57 left to play when he grabbed a 10-yard score. UWG was able to deny the shutout when **Quan Jones** crossed the goal line at 2:11.

Scott ran for a career-high 132 yards on 18 carries, while also catching one ball for nine yards. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** completed 12-of-19 passes for 141 yards and added 65 yards on the ground on 10 attempts. The triumph was VSU's 20th all-time against UWG in 29 contests. [Box score](#)

@ WEST ALABAMA 73, COLLEGE OF FAITH 6

West Alabama's (5-2) offense scored early and often, while the defense racked up 17 tackles for loss in a 73-6 home triumph over the College of Faith.

UWA took a 59-0 lead into the locker room after rolling up 38 points in the first quarter and 21 more in the second thanks to eight touchdowns and two safeties. The Tigers needed just 19 seconds to post the first points of the contest when **Gary Johnston** ran for a 55-yard touchdown at 14:41. West Alabama stretched its shutout to 66-0 until the final four minutes of the game and closed out the scoring with **Authur Brackett's** 18-yard scoring catch with 59 ticks on the clock.

Johnston ran for a game-high 80 yards on two carries and also completed 5-for-5 passes for 88 yards and a touchdown. West Alabama scored its most points in a game since 2006 and was just seven points from the school record (80). [Box score](#)

@ SHORTER 37, AVE MARIA 7

Future GSC member **Shorter** earned its second straight home victory over a NIAA opponent, topping Ave Maria, 37-7. SU stretched its 23-0 halftime lead to as many as 30 points in the third quarter and never looked back. **Quarterback Eric Dodson** ran for a career-high 147 yards and scored two of his three touchdowns on the Hawks' first two drives. Overall, SU ran for 404 yards, while holding Ave Maria to -6 yards as a team. [Box score](#)

2012 GSC RECORD BREAKERS

Valdosta State's Quin Roberson tied the GSC record for longest punt return in a game, reeling off a 94-yard touchdown return versus Forth Valley State. Arkansas-Monticello's Jywin Ceasar also returned a 94-yarder for a TD in 2010.

North Alabama's Michael Schuster tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game, hitting 5-of-6 attempts in UNA's 39-0 win over Kentucky Christian.

West Alabama's Ryne Smith set the NCAA and GSC record for consecutive field goals after going 4-for-4 on September 22 at Valdosta State. Smith has booted 22 straight field goals since October 2011, snapping the previous NCAA mark of 17 and the GSC record of 15 (SAU's Jason Williams in 1998).

GSC-LSC FIRST AND TEN CHALLENGE
