2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

UWG, UWA CLAIM GSC-TV FOOTBALL VICTORIES

Birmingham, AL—The first of three straight two-game weeks of GSC-TV action started last week with **West Georgia** and **West Alabama** securing home triumphs.

UWG kicked off the week on Thursday night by earning its second GSC-TV win this season. The Wolves halted a seven-game losing skid versus **North Alabama**, 38-23, while also notching their first Conference victory of the season.

UWA hosted its second televised clash of the season, celebrating its Homecoming by easing past future league member **Shorter**, 49-7, in SU's first-ever GSC-TV contest. The Tigers distanced themselves from the Hawks in the second half, outscoring the visitors 35-0.

Valdosta State and **Delta State** thrilled VSU's Homecoming crowd by combining for the most points in a GSC contest since 2009. The rivals combined for 1,079 total yards led by 624 by VSU en route to a 59-41 Blazers' triumph.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State wide receiver Seantavious Jones

(JR, 6-4, 193, Tucker, GA).

Jones earns his first-ever award and he is VSU's second wide receiver to claim laurels this season after a standout effort in VSU's 59-41 home victory over Delta State. The junior set career-highs with nine receptions for 210 yards and four touchdowns. Those totals were also the most by any GSC player this season and his four TD grabs were the most by a GSC receiver since 2009. The Tucker, GA native opened the scoring against DSU by hauling in a 74-yard strike at 13:41 in the first quarter. He followed with three more touchdown grabs from 14, 20 and 33 yards, respectively.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia defensive back Donovan Jackson

(JR, 6-2, 175, Miami Gardens, FL).

Jackson records his first career honor and is the second UWG defender to post accolades this season. The junior spearheaded the Wolves' defense in Thursday night's 38-23 GSC-TV win at home over North Alabama, racking up six total tackles. The Miami Gardens, FL native did not stop there, nabbing two interceptions including one for a touchdown, while also breaking up one pass. Jackson stretched UWG's lead to 38-23 in the fourth quarter, stepping in front of a pass and returning it 48 yards for a score with 9:16 left to play.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State punter/placekicker Daniel Andersen

(SR, 6-0, 182, Meansville, GA).

Andersen collects his second consecutive award, fourth of this career, after excelling at both placekicker and punter for the Blazers in their 59-41 home win over Delta State. The Meansville, GA averaged 47.3 yards per punt, booming three kicks for 142 yards headlined by a 53 yarder and one in-side DSU's 20-yard line. Andersen also accounted for 11 points as a placekicker connecting on his lone field goal attempt and going eight-for-eight on point-after kicks. He gave Valdosta State a 10-7 edge in the first quarter, booting a 49-yard field goal with 4:48 on the clock.

This week's three-game slate is also headlined by two league battles and the restart of the 10-game, GSC-LSC First-And-Ten Challenge schedule.

Thursday night's GSC-TV contest features a first-ever meeting between Peach State foes **Valdosta State** and **Shorter**. Future GSC member Shorter hosts its first countable league contest at Barron Stadium in Rome, GA. The game will be shown live by **CSS, Mediacom, TV-24** and **ESPN3** and on a tape-delay basis by **CoxSports** (Oct. 26 at Noon) and the **Alabama Cable Network** (Oct. 27 at 7:00 pm).

West Georgia hosts its second straight GSC-TV telecast on Saturday when No. 14 West Texas A&M enters University Stadium in Game Six of the GSC-LSC First-And-Ten Challenge. The game will be shown live by **CSS, Mediacom, TV-24, ACN, ESPN3** and **ESPN Game Plan** and on a tape-delay basis by CoxSports (Oct. 30 at Noon). **Delta State** celebrates Homecoming on Saturday, entertaining **West Alabama** as the Tigers seek at least a share of the league title with a victory.

Future league member **Shorter** performs in front of a GSC-TV audience for the second week in a row, but this week the Hawks host their first-ever GSC contest when Peach State foe **Valdosta State** travels to Rome, GA.

Even though the squad's reside in the same state, they will lock horns for the first time ever. SU is in search of its first-ever countable GSC Conference victory, while VSU seeks to build on its four-game winning streak and back-to-back league triumphs. The Blazers need a victory to keep their hopes for at least a share of the league crown alive, entering one game behind first place West Alabama. Both squads have fallen to UWA including Shorter's 49-7 setback in Livingston in last Thursday's GSC-TV game. Valdosta State makes its first GSC-TV appearance this year and they are 10-6 all-time in GSC-TV clashes.

Statistical Standouts: Valdosta State is best in the Conference in scoring offense (42.5), total offense (493.2), rushing offense (233.0), rushing defense (139.2), pass offense (260.2) and pass efficiency (157.1). Shorter enters Thursday, averaging 21.5 points per game and 362.2 yards offense, while allowing 330.9 yards per game.

VSU wide receiver Gerald Ford is No. 1 in receiving (100.4), receptions (5.7). Ford and teammate **Seantavious Jones** are tied for first in touchdown catches (nine) and Jones also ranks second in receiving (66.9) and fifth in receptions (3.4). **Freshman running backs Austin Scott** and **Cedric O'Neal** are No. 1 (91.9) and No. 2 (87.3) in rushing, respectively. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** is second in passing (184.9) and total offense (217.6). **SU quarterback Eric Dodson** is averaging 62.5 rushing yards and 87.9 passing yards. **Running back Bradley Moon** has compiled a team-high 692 yards on 133 attempts.

The GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge kicks back up this weekend when **West Georgia** hosts No. 14 West Texas A&M in front of a GSC-TV audience.

Saturday marks the sixth contest of the 10-game set of matchups between Gulf South Conference and Lone Star Conference teams. The GSC enters with a 3-2 edge, but both of LSC's previous victories came in GSC-TV action. Delta State fell to Abilene Christian on September 27, 34-28, and Midwestern State topped West Alabama on October 4, 42-27. Since then, the GSC has captured two straight meetings after DSU and North Alabama each won on the road on October 6. UWG is 4-9 all-time in GSC-TV play and 2-0 this season behind a 38-29 home victory over Tusculum in the Game Two on September 8 and a 38-23 home win over North Alabama last Thursday.

Statistical Standouts: West Georgia is No. 3 in the GSC in scoring offense (31.3) and rushing offense (221.0) and No. 1 in Division II in fumbles lost (0.00). West Texas A&M ranks tops in the LSC in scoring defense (15.9), total offense (472.0), rushing defense (128.9), pass offense (345.6) and pass efficiency (163.6).

UWG signal caller Austin Trainor places fourth in total offense (130.5) and fifth in passing (107.7), while **Dallas Dickey** is eighth in passing (50.0) and 10th in total offense (89.4). **Running back Seth Hinsley** ranks fifth in rushing (66.6) and teammate **David Bailey** is sixth (59.7). WTAMU signal caller Dustin Vaughn is No. 1 in the LSC in passing (317.9) and total offense (322.1).

West Alabama controls its own destiny entering Cleveland, MS with a chance to clinch at least a share of the GSC Title in **Delta State's** Homecoming game.

The rivals face off at McCool Stadium for the third straight season after DSU collected a 41-37 win in 2010 and a 36-34 triumph in 2011. History is also on the Statesmen's side, holding a 34-20-3 all-time advantage thanks to eight victories in the last nine meetings. UWA's last win in Cleveland came in 2002 and the Tigers trail the series at DSU, 24-8-1. West Alabama is 2-1 on the road this year, while Delta State is 1-3 on Parker Field.

Statistical Standouts: UWA leads the GSC in scoring defense (17.5), total defense (247.4), pass defense (106.0) and pass efficiency defense (76.0). DSU is second in total offense (419.9) and pass offense (211.6) and third in total defense (351.0), rushing defense (149.9) and pass defense (201.1).

UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell places third in the league in passing (127.6) and total offense (137.4) and fourth in pass efficiency (143.8). Back-up signal caller **Gary Johnston** ranks second in rushing TDs (seven) and seventh in rushing (54.5). **Ryne Smith** currently holds the NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (22) and he is also No. 2 in the nation in field goals (1.75).

Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden leads the Conference in total offense (283.7) and passing (211.6) and is third in rushing (72.1). His top targets are **Levon Downs** (No. 2 in receptions, 4.3; No. 4 in receiving, 54.9) and **Kevin Jackson** (No. 3 in receiving, 62.7; No. 4 in receptions, 3.4).

@ WEST GEORGIA 38, NORTH ALABAMA 23 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)

West Georgia (3-4, 1-3) put the brakes on a four-game losing skid while also claiming its first league triumph of the year via a 38-23 home win over **North Alabama** (5-3, 2-2) in Thursday night's edition of the GSC-TV Game of the Week.

The squads traded punches throughout the first half until UNA grabbed a 20-17 lead heading into the locker room. **Quarterback Luke Wingo** scored on the game's first possession, giving the Lions a 7-0 edge via a one-yard touchdown run at 9:35 in the first quarter. **UWG quarterback Dallas Dickey** tied matters with a TD run of his own, finding pay dirt from 21 yards out at 5:39.

North Alabama responded on **wide receiver Lee Mayhall's** 30-yard scoring catch just 12 seconds into the second stanza, only to see **West Georgia running back Seth Hinsley** run for an eight-yard touchdown at 10:52. **UNA's Taylor Pontius** booted a 41-yard field goal at 6:55 and **UWG's Davis Brackett** kicked a 35 yarder at 1:36. Pontius was not done, giving the Lions a three-point halftime lead by connecting on a 24-yard field goal with one second on the clock.

UWG took control in the second half led by a pair of one-yard touchdown sneaks by Dickey at the 11-minute mark and 2:06 in the third quarter. Pontius cut the Lions' deficit to 31-23 with 45 ticks remaining in the quarter, but UWG's defense held the UNA out of the end zone in the fourth frame and **defensive back Donovan Jackson** tallied the final score by returning an interception 48 yards for a touchdown at 9:16.

West Georgia running back David Bailey and Hinsley each ran for over 100 yards, led by 118 yards from Bailey and 115 from Hinsley. Dickey compiled 111 total yards and three touchdowns led by 73 yards on the ground. UWG snapped a seven-game losing streak against UNA behind its first home victory in the series since 2001. @ VALDOSTA STATE 59, DELTA STATE 41 (HOMECOMING)

Valdosta State (6-2, 3-1) and **Delta State** (3-4, 1-2) provided Homecoming fireworks for the VSU faithful as the teams combined for 1,079 yards and 100 points in the Blazers' 59-41 win over DSU.

The rivals played in the highest scoring GSC game since 2009 led by a 51-point first half. Valdosta State drew first blood on its opening drive when **wide receiver Seantavious Jones** collected a 74-yard bomb at 13:41, but Delta State struck back just 11 seconds later when **wide out Patrick Bethley** was on the receiving end of a 75-yard touchdown. **VSU placekicker Daniel Andersen** nailed a 49-yard field goal at 4:48, only to see DSU grab a 14-10 lead after Bethley's 59-yard TD grab at 3:07.

The Blazers surged ahead by posting 21 unanswered points as **wide receiver Regginald Lewis** caught a 58-yard score at 1:29 in the first quarter and Jones recorded back-to-back TD catches at 10:18 (14 yards) and 5:54 (20 yards) in the second stanza. The Statesmen halted VSU's scoring streak at 1:32 thanks to **running back Brant Botill's** one-yard plunge.

The Blazers held a 38-20 advantage at 11:41 in the third quarter, but Delta State used a 21-point streak of its own to take a 41-38 lead with 4:42 left in the quarter. **Erick Clayton** caught a 70-yard touchdown at 10:42, **quarterback Trevor Wooden** ran for a nine-yard TD and **wide receiver Lavon Downs** hauled-in a 32-yard score at 4:42. Valdosta State dominated the rest of the contest with its second 21-point run of the contest. Jones was on the receiving end of a 33-yard touchdown at 2:37 in the third and **running back Cedric O'Neal** posted rushing TDs of one and six yards in the final frame.

Cochran completed 25-of-36 passes for 412 yards and five TDs, while Jones caught nine balls for 210 yards and four scores. O'Neal led all rushers with 160 yards on 33 attempts. DSU's Wooden accounted for 380 total yards and had a hand in five touchdowns in a losing effort. VSU snapped a six-game losing streak versus DSU behind its first home win over the Statesmen since 2004. [Box score](#)

@ WEST ALABAMA 49, SHORTER 7 (HOMECOMING; GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)

West Alabama (6-2, 3-0) hosted the second GSC-TV telecast of the week, using 35 second-half points en route to a 49-7 victory over future GSC member **Shorter** (4-4, 0-2).

Neither team lit the scoreboard in the first quarter but **defensive back Otha Foster** gave UWA a 7-0 lead just 42 seconds into the second frame when he returned a fumble 41 yards for a touchdown. **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** stretched the advantage to 14-0 behind a 12-yard scoring run, only to see SU cut its deficit in half right before intermission via **quarterback Eric Dodson's** one-yard rush with 36 ticks on the clock.

West Alabama dominated the second half, pitching a shutout while scoring 35 points. **Quarterback Gary Johnston** ran for an eight-yard touchdown at 13:56 in third quarter and followed with a 36-yarder at 10:04. **Malik Lofton** returned a punt 74 yards for a TD at 4:07 and the Tigers pushed across two more scores in the final 15 minutes.

Caldwell completed 7-of-13 passes for 192 yards and one touchdown, while Johnston ran for a team-high 64 yards and three scores. West Alabama stretched its all-time lead against Shorter to 2-0 and upped its home record this season to 4-1. [Box score](#)

Valdosta State's Quin Roberson tied the GSC record for longest punt return in a game, reeling off a 94-yard touchdown return versus FORTH Valley State. Arkansas-Monticello's Jywin Ceasar also returned a 94-yarder for a TD in 2010.

North Alabama's Michael Schuster tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game, hitting 5-of-6 attempts in UNA's 39-0 win over Kentucky Christian.

West Alabama's Ryne Smith set the NCAA and GSC record for consecutive field goals after going 4-for-4 on September 22 at Valdosta State. Smith has booted 22 straight field goals since October 2011, snapping the previous NCAA mark of 17 and the GSC record of 15 (SAU's Jason Williams in 1998).
