2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

UWA CLINCHES SHARE OF GSC FOOTBALL CROWN

Birmingham, AL—West Alabama headlined last week's three-game set of contests by clinching at least a share of the 2012 GSC Football Title.

UWA kicked off Saturday's action, spoiling **Delta State's** Homecoming via a 37-7 triumph in Cleveland, MS. The Tigers clinched a share of just their second GSC crown since then Livingston University shared the first-ever Conference sponsored football championship in 1971 with former member Troy State. West Alabama re-entered the AFCA Top 25 this week at No. 21.

For the second consecutive week, the league brought two GSC-TV Games of the Week to a nationwide television audience.

Valdosta State traveled to future in-state GSC member **Shorter** on Thursday night, collecting a 37-6 win at Barron Stadium in Rome, GA. VSU stretched its winning streak to five and enters this week's action ranked No. 24 in the AFCA poll.

West Georgia suffered its first GSC-TV setback of the season, falling at home to then No. 14 West Texas A&M, 52-28, in Game Six of the 2012 GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge. Visiting teams continued to dominate the GSC-LSC season series which is knotted at 3-3.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State quarterback **Cayden Cochran** (JR, 6-2, 188, Cashion, OK).

Cochran claims his second all-time honor and he is the third different VSU offensive winner this season after leading the Blazers to a 37-6 victory at Shorter in Thursday night's GSC-TV contest. The junior threw just three incomplete passes and accounted for three of four touchdowns as Valdosta State notched its fifth consecutive win. The Cashion, OK native completed 20-of-23 passes for 212 yards and two TDs, while also adding 15 yards and another score on the ground.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Alabama defensive end **Ridge Wilson** (SR, 6-4, 256, Louisville, KY).

Wilson earns his first-ever award and he is the third different UWA defender to win laurels this season. The senior spearheaded the Tigers' defense in a 37-7 win at Delta State, clinching at least a share of the GSC Title. The Louisville, KY native led the squad with 11 total tackles, behind seven solo stops, while also racking up 2.5 tackles for a loss of 12 yards and one sack for six yards.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Alabama punter **Jordan Ikner** (FR, 6-4, 230, Alabaster, AL).

Ikner posts his second accolade of the year after leading UWA's special teams unit against Delta State. The Alabaster, AL native booted four punts for 185 yards and a 46.2 average. The freshman also dropped two punts inside DSU's 20-yard line and he boomed a long of 57 yards.

Two GSC-TV Games of the Week and three GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge clashes highlight this week's GSC Football action.

No. 24 Valdosta State returns to the airwaves for the second week in a row, hosting Texas A&M-Kingsville in Thursday's GSC-TV contest. The first-ever matchup also marks the seventh GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge battle of the season. The Conferences have split the previous six games with four more matchups yet to be played. Thursday night's clash will be shown live by **CSS, Mediacom, TV-24** and **ESPN3** and on a tape-delay basis by **CoxSports** (Nov. 2 at Noon) and the **Alabama Cable Network** (Nov. 3 at 7:00 pm).

North Alabama headlines Saturday's four-game slate when the Lions host LSC foe Tarleton State along with the GSC-TV crew. The game will be shown live by **Mediacom**, the **Alabama Cable Network, TV-24, Alabama Cable Network, ESPN3** and **ESPN Game Plan** and on a tape-delay basis by **CoxSports** (Nov. 6 at Noon).

No. 21 West Alabama rounds out the trio of GSC-LSC face offs when the Tigers journey west to Abilene Christian on Saturday. **West Georgia** remains home for the second straight week, hosting future GSC in-state member Shorter. **Delta State** completes the weekend schedule, traveling north to GLVC leader Indianapolis.

Newly ranked **No. 24 Valdosta State** entertains the GSC-TV audience for the second Thursday in a row, hosting Lone Star Conference member Texas A&M-Kingsville.

VSU moved to 11-5 all-time in GSC-TV play after topping Shorter in Rome, GA last Thursday, 37-6. The Blazers have won five straight games and reentered the AFCA Top 25 poll this week. Valdosta State and Texas A&M-Kingsville face off for just the second time ever, following VSU's 21-12 home triumph over the Javelinas in the 2002 NCAA Playoff Semifinals. TAMKU locks horns with a GSC squad for the second time this season after North Alabama collected a 21-16 win in Kingsville on October 6. Overall, Valdosta State is 3-0 versus current LSC members, topping Angelo State in the 2012 Lone Star Football Festival and breezing past Tarleton State at home in 1993, 68-10. VSU is 3-1 at home this year, while the Javelinas are 2-2 on the road.

Statistical Standouts: Valdosta State is best in the GSC in scoring offense (41.9), total offense (477.9), pass offense (255.8) and pass efficiency (159.0). Texas A&M-Kingsville is tops in the LSC in pass efficiency defense (109.7) and third in scoring defense (23.4) and total defense (344.8).

VSU wide receiver Gerald Ford is No. 1 in receiving (96.1), receptions (5.9) and touchdown catches (10). Teammate Seantavious Jones is second in touchdown catches (nine) and receiving (62.6). **Freshman running backs Cedric O'Neal** and **Austin Scott** are No. 1 (87.6) and No. 2 (80.8) in rushing, respectively. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** is second in passing (188.2) and total offense (218.8). TAMKU quarterback Nate Poppell places fifth in the LSC in passing (200.8) and seventh in total offense (200.5).

North Alabama returns to the gridiron after a bye-week, seeking to perverse its perfect record against Lone Star Conference foes when Tarleton State travels to Florence in Saturday's GSC-TV telecast.

While UNA and TSU have never meet in any sport ever, the Lions have a built a 6-0 all-time mark against LSC football opponents. North Alabama's most recent LSC triumph came on October 6, 2012 when it collected a 21-16 victory at Texas A&M-Kingsville. UNA has also claimed 22 of its last 23 regular season games against non-GSC schools. North Alabama is 7-7 all-time in GSC-TV contests and seeks to rebound from a 38-23 setback at West Georgia in its last meeting on October 18. The Lions complete their season at in-state rival West Alabama in GSC-TV action next Thursday. North Alabama is 2-2 at Braly Stadium this season, while Tarleton State is 2-2 on the road.

Statistical Standouts: North Alabama ranks second in the GSC in scoring defense (18.9) and pass defense (196.6). Tarleton State places second in the LSC in rushing defense (128.9) and pass offense (259.0).

UNA freshman running back Lamonte Thompson ranks third in rushing (70.6), while **freshman quarterback Luke Wingo** is sixth in passing (78.1) and seventh in total offense (102.9). TSU signal caller Aaron Douglas ranks third in the LSC in passing (225.6) and total offense (240.3).

Future member **Shorter** battles an in-state GSC foe for the second week in a row when **West Georgia** defends University Stadium for the second straight week.

Although just 55 miles separates the Peach State schools, they face off on the gridiron for the first time ever. UWG is in search of its second consecutive GSC triumph after defeating North Alabama at home on October 18. SU seeks its first-ever countable GSC victory after going 0-2 previously this year, including a 37-6 home setback versus Valdosta State and a 41-0 shutout by host North Alabama. UWG is 3-2 at home this year, while SU is 2-3 on the road.

Statistical Standouts: West Georgia is No. 3 in the GSC in scoring offense (30.9), rushing offense (212.2) and No. 1 in Division II in fumbles lost (1.00). Shorter enters Saturday, averaging 19.8 points per game and 352.8 yards offense, while allowing 333.6 yards per game.

UWG signal caller Austin Trainor places fourth in total offense (1112.0) and fifth in passing (92.9), while Dallas Dickey is tied for first in rushing touchdowns (nine) and is also eighth in passing (57.8) and total offense (99.2) and 10th in rushing (41.5). **Running back Seth Hinsley** ranks fifth in rushing (65.6) and teammate **David Bailey** is sixth (61.0). **SU quarterback Eric Dodson** is averaging 53.4 rushing yards and 81.0 passing yards. **Running back Bradley Moon** has compiled a team-high 808 yards on 154 attempts.

UWA has revenge on its mind after falling to now No. 10 Midwestern State at home on October 4th, 42-27. The Tigers are just 3-6 all-time versus Texas foes with their last win over a LSC opponent coming a year ago over Tarleton State, 42-35. The matchup marks the second-to-last game of the 10-game GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge. West Alabama is 3-1 away from home this season, while ACU is 2-2 at home.

Statistical Standouts: UWA leads the GSC in scoring defense (16.3), total defense (242.6), rushing offense (233.8), rushing defense (138.1), pass defense (104.4) and pass efficiency defense (72.9). ACU is second in the LSC in pass efficiency (136.8) and third in scoring offense (30.6) and pass offense (258.9).

UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell places third in the league in passing (132.3) and total offense (143.0) and fourth in pass efficiency (148.4). **Back-up signal caller Gary Johnston** is tied for first in rushing touchdowns (nine) and seventh in rushing (58.4). **Ryne Smith** currently holds the NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (23) and he is also No. 2 in the nation in field goals (1.75).

Delta State logs its third 500-plus mile road trip of the season, traveling north to face GLVC league leader Indianapolis.

Despite its distance challenges, the Statesmen have compiled a 2-1 road record this season, while IU is 4-0 at home and has claimed seven consecutive victories dating back to September 15th. DSU needs two wins to close out the season at .500 and avoid its first losing season since 2002. The Greyhounds will be just the second opponent from the Hoosier State in Delta State's history with DSU falling at Evansville in 1950.

Statistical Standouts: DSU is second in the GSC in pass offense (196.6) and third in total offense (392.9), rushing defense (163.8) and pass efficiency (126.8). IU is tops in the GLVC in scoring offense (39.9), scoring defense (16.8), total defense (272.6), rushing offense (212.9) and pass defense (145.2).

Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden leads the Conference in total offense (190.0) and passing (257.9) and is fourth in rushing (67.9). His top target is **Levon Downs** (No. 3 in receptions, 3.8; No. 5 in receiving, 48.0). **Freshman running back Rondaus Truesdale** places ninth in rushing (47.5).

WEST ALABAMA 37, @ DELTA STATE 7 (HOMECOMING)

West Alabama (7-2, 4-0) clinched a share of its first GSC Title since 1971, spoiling **Delta State's** (3-5, 1-3) Homecoming on Saturday, 37-7.

UWA rang up 459 yards of total offense, while the Tigers' defense forced six DSU turnovers. West Alabama posted the lone score in the first quarter when **running back Danny Hobbs** capped a 14-play, 83-yard drive with a four-yard touchdown run at 3:34. Delta State knotted the score just four seconds into the second frame after **quarterback Trevor Wooden** sneaked-in a two-yard TD.

UWA dominated the rest of the game, holding a 24-7 halftime lead before adding 13 more points in the second half. **Dakota Daniel** notched the go-ahead score on a 21-yard touchdown grab at 11:52 in the second quarter, followed by **Ryne Smith's** 26-yard field goal at 6:07. **Chad Toocheck** closed out the first half by hauling-in a 13-yard scoring strike with 22 ticks on the clock.

Hobbs racked up 151 total yards, catching four balls for a game-high 80 yards, while adding 71 yards and two touchdowns on 11 rush attempts. **Back-up quarterback Gary Johnston** led all rushers with 90 yards on 17 carries, while **starter Kyle Caldwell** completed 11-of-18 passes for 170 yards and two TDs. Smith extended his *NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (23)*. West Alabama snapped a two-game skid versus DSU and earned its first win in Cleveland since 2002. **Box score**

VALDOSTA STATE 37, @ SHORTER 6 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)

Valdosta State (7-2, 4-1) and in-state future GSC rival **Shorter** (4-5, 0-3) each performed in front of a GSC-TV audience on Thursday night. VSU exploded for 17 points in the first quarter on its way to a 37-6 victory over the Hawks in the first-ever meeting between the schools.

SU drove into scoring position on the game's opening drive, only to miss a 40-yard field goal attempt. The Blazers did not make the same mistake, taking a 3-0 lead at 5:25 in the opening quarter thanks to **Daniel Andersen's** 38-yard field goal. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** ran for a one-yard touchdown at 1:28, while **Dominique Wheeler** returned a fumble 17 yards for a score just 15 seconds later. Valdosta State closed out the first half scoring when **wide receiver Gerald Ford** grabbed an eight-yard pass at 8:10 in the second stanza.

VSU stretched its advantage to 31-0 at 10:46 in the third quarter via **wide out Regginald Lewis' 17-yard** touchdown catch, but Shorter countered with **running back Kirk Wilson's** five-yard TD run at 5:52. **Blazers' running back Cedric O'Neal** galloped for a four-yard TD at 4:02 and neither team scored the rest of the game.

Cochran had a hand in three VSU touchdowns, completing 20-of-23 passes for 212 and two scores and running for 15 yards and another TD. O'Neal paced the team with 90 yards on eight carries, while Ford caught seven passes for 66 yards. The Blazers upped their winning streak to five in their last Conference contest of 2012. **Box score**

#14 WEST TEXAS A&M 52, @ WEST GEORGIA 28 (GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)

West Georgia (3-5) hosted its third GSC-TV telecast of the season, falling for the first time under the lights to Lone Star Conference leader No. 14 West Texas A&M (8-1), 52-28. The matchup also marked Game Six of the 10-game 2012 GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge which is tied at 3-3.

The squads traded punches during the first 17 minutes of action. UWG hit pay dirt on its first possession when **running back David Bailey** caught a two-yard touchdown at 8:38 in the first quarter, but WTAMU countered on a 62-yard TD pass at 7:31. Bailey struck again, running-in a three-yard TD at 2:24, only to see the Buffaloes tie the score just 1:49 into the second frame. West Texas A&M took over from there, hitting for 24 more straight points en route to a 31-14 halftime edge.

The Wolves were able to pull within 10 points towards the end of the third quarter, but WTAMU outscored UWG in the fourth quarter, 14-0. **West Georgia quarterback Dallas Dickey** ran for a three-yard score at 6:57 in the third stanza and **Joey Eliezer** hauled-in a 33-yard touchdown at 1:21.

Dickey accounted for 168 yards, completing 7-of-10 passes for 112 yards and two touchdowns and running for 56 yards and one TD. Bailey ran for a team-high 70 yards on a game-high 17 attempts. UWG moved to 2-1 in GSC-TV contest this season after winning its first two matchups earlier this year. **Box score**

Valdosta State's Quin Roberson tied the GSC record for longest punt return in a game, reeling off a 94-yard touchdown return versus FORTH Valley State. Arkansas-Monticello's Jywin Ceasar also returned a 94-yarder for a TD in 2010.

North Alabama's Michael Schuster tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game, hitting 5-of-6 attempts in UNA's 39-0 win over Kentucky Christian.

West Alabama's Ryne Smith set the NCAA and GSC record for consecutive field goals after going 4-for-4 on September 22 at Valdosta State. Smith has booted 23 straight field goals since October 2011, snapping the previous NCAA mark of 17 and the GSC record of 15 (SAU's Jason Williams in 1998).
